



## Pattern Collection: Accessory



### **Pinnacle Hat**

### **SIZES**

Adult Small (Medium, Large)

Shown in Medium size

### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

**Brim Circumference:** 16¾ (19¼, 21½)"  
unstretched; stretches to approx. 21¾  
(24¼, 26½)"

**Length:** 10"

### **MATERIALS**

**Wisdom Yarns Angora Lace** (60%  
superwash fine merino, 30% nylon, 10%  
angora; 100g/462 yds)

- 211 Peacoat (MC) – 1 skein
- 208 Misty Green (CC1) – 1 skein
- 205 Thistle (CC2) – 1 skein

**Needle:** US Size 3 (3.25 mm) 16" circ, and  
set of DPNS *or size needed to obtain gauge*  
US Size 1 (2.25 mm) 16" circ

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch marker

### **GAUGE**

30 sts x 34 rnds = 4" in stranded patt using  
larger ndl

**Save time, check your gauge.**

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## PATTERN NOTES

This beautiful hat features mesmerizing colorwork using an interesting color combination. Each repeat of color points upward, eventually coming together at the crown and creating a star motif. The color repeats are easy to memorize and addictive to knit – it may be knit at a fine gauge, but we're sure you'll knit it up in no time at all!

Worked in the round from the bottom up, only two colors are carried at once. For your convenience the stitch patterns are both written and charted.

## STITCH GUIDE

### K1, P1 Rib

*(even number of sts)*

**Rnd 1:** \* K1, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

### Pinnacle

*(multiple of 6 sts)*

**Rnds 1-2:** \* CC1 k1, MC k3, CC1 k1, MC k1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 3:** \* CC1 k5, MC k1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 4:** \* MC k1, CC1 k3, MC k2; rep from \* to end.

**Rnds 5-6:** \* MC k2, CC1 k1, MC k3; rep from \* to end.

**Rnds 7-8:** \* CC2 k1, MC k3, CC2 k1, MC k1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 9:** \* CC2 k5, CC1 k1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 10:** \* CC1 k1, CC2 k3, CC1 k2; rep from \* to end.

**Rnds 11-12:** \* CC1 k2, CC2 k1, CC1 k3; rep from \* to end.

**Rnds 13-14:** \* MC k1, CC1 k3, MC k1, CC1 k1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 15:** \* MC k5, CC2 k1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 16:** \* CC2 k1, MC k3, CC2 k2; rep from \* to end.

**Rnds 17-18:** \* CC2 k2, MC k1, CC2 k3; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnds 1-18 for patt.

## Crown Shaping

*(multiple of 18 sts)*

**Rnd 1:** \* CC2 ssk, MC k1, [CC2 k5, MC k1] 2 times, CC2 k1, k2tog; rep from \* to end – 2 sts dec'd, 16 sts rem each rep.

**Rnd 2:** \* CC2 k2, [MC k1, CC2 k4] 2 times, MC k1, CC2 k3; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 3:** \* CC2 ssk, k1, [MC k1, CC2 k3] 2 times, MC k1, CC2 k2, k2tog; rep from \* to end – 2 sts dec'd, 14 sts rem each rep.

**Rnd 4:** \* CC2 k3, MC k1, CC2 k5, MC k1, CC2 k4; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 5:** \* CC2 ssk, k2, [MC k1, CC2 k3] 2 times, MC k2tog; rep from \* to end – 2 sts dec'd, 12 sts rem each rep.

**Rnd 6:** \* MC k1, CC2 k3, MC k1, CC2 k1, MC k1, CC2 k3, MC k1, CC2 k1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 7:** \* MC ssk, [CC2 k3, MC k1] 2 times, CC2 k2tog; rep from \* to end – 2 sts dec'd, 10 sts rem each rep.

**Rnd 8:** \* CC2 k1, MC k1, CC2 k5, MC k1, CC2 k2; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 9:** \* CC2 ssk, MC k1, CC2 k3, MC k1, CC2 k1, k2tog – 2 sts dec'd, 8 sts rem each rep.

**Rnd 10:** \* CC2 k2, MC k1, CC2 k1, MC k1, CC2 k3; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 11:** \* CC2 ssk, k1, MC k1, CC2 k2, CC2 k2tog; rep from \* to end – 2 sts dec'd, 6 sts rem each rep. Break MC, cont in CC2 only.

**Even Rnds 12-16:** Knit to end.

**Rnd 13:** \* Ssk, k2, k2tog; rep from \* to end – 2 sts dec'd, 4 sts rem each rep.

**Rnd 15:** \* Ssk, k2tog; rep from \* to end – 2 sts dec'd, 2 sts rem each rep.



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## HAT

### Brim

With smaller 16" circ and MC, cast on 102 (120, 138) sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

Work in K1, P1 Rib until piece meas 1¾" from cast-on edge.

**Increase Rnd:** K2, [m1, k5 (0, 6)] 3 (0, 9) times, [m1, k4 (5, 5)] 17 (23, 5) times, [m1, k5 (0, 6)] 3 (0, 9) times, m1, k2 (3, 3) – 24 sts inc'd, 126 (144, 162) sts. Change to larger circ ndl.

### Hat Body

Work Rnds 1-18 of Pinnacle patt 3 times – patt will be repeated 21 (24, 27) times across each rnd. Break CC1, cont with MC and CC2 only.

### Shape Crown

*Note: When there are too few sts to fit comfortably on circ ndl, change to dpns.*

Work Rnds 1-16 of Crown Shaping patt – 14 (16, 18) sts rem. Patt will be repeated 7 (8, 9) times across each rnd.

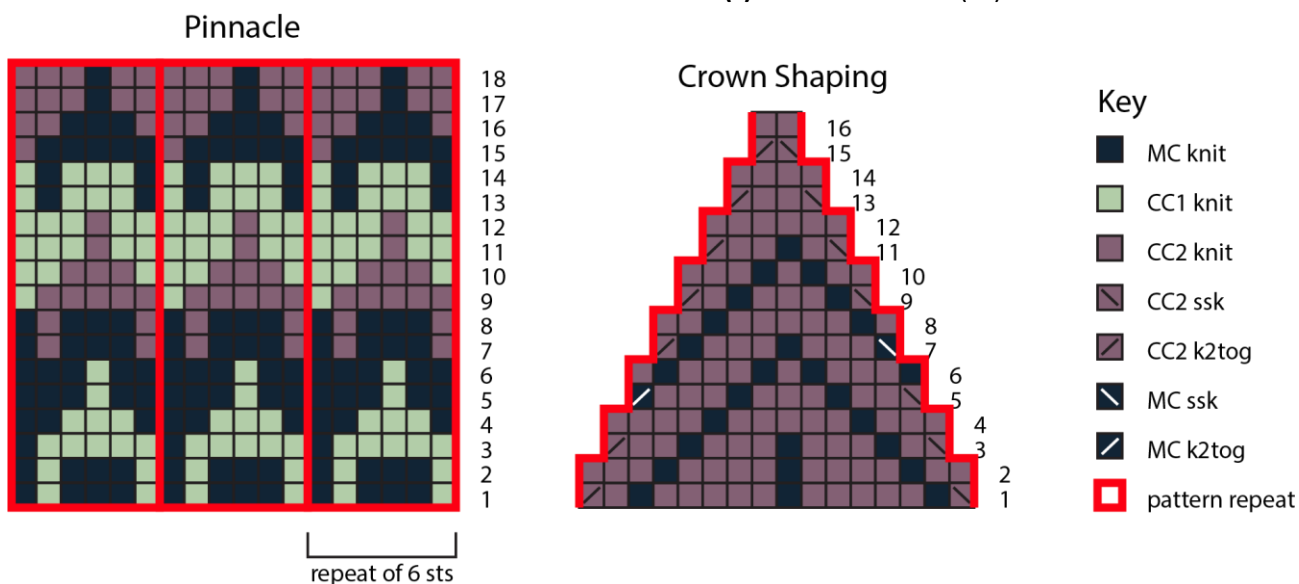
**Next Rnd:** With CC2, \* K2tog; rep from \* to end – 7 (8, 9) sts dec'd, 7 (8, 9) sts rem. Break yarn leaving 8" tail. Pass tail through rem live sts, pull taut, fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block to finished measurements.

## Abbreviations

<b>CC</b>	contrast color
<b>circ</b>	circular
<b>cont</b>	continue
<b>dec('d)</b>	decrease(d)
<b>dpn(s)</b>	double pointed needle(s)
<b>est'd</b>	established
<b>inc('d)</b>	increase(d)
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
<b>m1</b>	insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st inc'd)
<b>MC</b>	main color
<b>meas</b>	measures
<b>ndl</b>	needle
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>patt</b>	pattern
<b>pm</b>	place marker
<b>rem</b>	remain(ing)
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>rnd</b>	round
<b>ssk</b>	slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)



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
