DIFFICULTY Basic

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS Circumference: 34" Height: 13"

# MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Penna (50% baby suri alpaca, 28% extrafine merino, 22% nylon; 25g/186 yds) Pink Version

- 111 Whisper (A) 1 ball
- 112 Rose Kiss (B) 1 ball
- 113 Raspberry Tart (C) 1 ball

## **Yellow Version**

- 106 Eggshell (A) 1 ball
- 107 Custard (B) 1 ball
- 109 Manuka (C) 1 ball

## **Purple Version**

- 104 Lavendula (A) 1 ball
- 105 Mulberry (B) 1 ball
- 115 Dusk (C) 1 ball

**Needle:** US Size 8 (5 mm) 16-24" circular *or size needed to obtain gauge* **Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

16 sts x 26 rnds = 4" in Seed st

## **PATTERN NOTES**

A simple pleasure, the Plume Cowl is featherweight, lush, and features a beautiful color gradient. This is a perfect project for beginners.

This cowl is knit in the round from the bottom up.

# **STITCH GUIDE**

### Seed

(even number of sts) **Rnd 1:** \* K1, p1; rep from \* to end. **Rnd 2:** \* P1, k1; rep from \* to end. Rep Rnds 1-2 for patt.

## COWL

With A, cast on 124 sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist. Work in Seed patt until piece meas 4½" from cast-on edge, ending with Rnd 2 of patt. Break color A, change to color B. Work in Seed patt until piece meas 9" from cast-on edge, ending with Rnd 2 of patt. Break color B, change to color C. Work in Seed patt until piece meas 13" from cast-on edge, ending with Rnd 2 of patt. Bind off all sts in patt.

#### FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.
