DIFFICULTY

Easy

SIZES

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width (along widest edge): 31¾"

Length: 72½"

MATERIALS

[Universal Yarn Easel](#) (75% superwash wool, 25% nylon; 100g/437 yds)

- 106 Quiet Time – 1 skein

Needle: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 24-40" circular *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

GAUGE

17 sts x 25 rows = 4" in Stockinette stitch (St st)

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

Eclectic, self-patterning Easel looks amazing in the simplest stitch patterns, and the Pointillism Shawl demonstrates that so well. The shawl gets its name from the kaleidoscope of colors and patterning, created by our cool, creative Easel yarn. Lightweight and drapey, you'll love how easy it is to make a statement out of such a simple pattern!

This shawl is worked on the bias. It begins at the tip and increases to the widest edge. It features a garter stitch border along all edges but is primarily stockinette stitch. It makes the most out of a single skein of sock yarn. You can make this shawl larger or smaller very easily, as it is a two-row repeat. Simply work until you reach about ½" less than your desired length, making sure you allow yourself enough yarn to work the garter stitch border.

PATTERN BEGINS

SHAWL

Starting Tip

Cast on 2 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, kfb - 1 st inc'd, 3 sts.

Row 2 (WS): Knit.

Row 3: K2, kfb - 1 st inc'd, 4 sts.

Row 4: Knit.

Row 5: K3, kfb - 1 st inc'd, 5 sts.

Row 6: K2, p1, k2.

Row 7: K4, kfb - 1 st inc'd, 6 sts.

Row 8: K2, p2, k2.

Main Shawl

Row 1 (RS): K2, pm, k2tog, yo, pm, k2.

Row 2 (WS): K2, sl m, yo, purl to m, sl m, k2 - 1 st inc'd, 7 sts.

Row 3: K2, sl m, k2tog, knit to m, yo, sl m, k2.

Row 4: K2, sl m, yo, purl to m, sl m, k2 - 1 st inc'd, 8 sts.

Rep Rows 3-4, 124 more times - 124 sts inc'd, 132 sts.

Border

Row 1 (RS): K2, sl m, k2tog, knit to m, yo, sl m, k2.

Row 2 (WS): K2, sl m, yo, knit to end - 1 st inc'd, 133 sts.

Rep Rows 1-2, 2 more times - 2 sts inc'd, 135 sts.

Loosely bind off all sts kwise.



FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

garter st	knit every row
inc('d)	increase(d)
k	knit
k2tog	knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
kfb	knit into front and back of next st (1 st inc'd)
kwise	knitwise
m	marker
p	purl
pm	place marker
rep	repeat
RS	right side
sl	slip
St st	Stockinette stitch (knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows; in the rnd, knit every rnd)
st(s)	stitch(es)
WS	wrong side
yo	yarn over

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
