SKILL

Knitting

DIFFICULTY

Easy

SIZES

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 36½"

Length: 30½"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Uptown Bamboo DK*
(80% anti-pilling acrylic, 20% bamboo;
100g/284 yds)

- 524 Lemongrass - 4 skeins

Needle: US Size 6 (4 mm) 24-32" circular
(to accommodate large number of sts)
or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

GAUGE

21 sts x 29 rows = 4" in Triangles patt

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

An old favorite, revisited in our new, soft Uptown Bamboo DK yarn! Simple knit-purl patterning creates a fabric featuring alternating triangles in this reversible blanket. This is a perfect cover for babies and small children alike, but it works great as a lap blanket, too.

The Purls & Triangles Blanket is knit flat in one piece from the bottom up.

STITCH GUIDE

Triangles

(multiple of 16 sts, plus 1)

Row 1 (RS): * K8, p1, k7; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2 (WS): P1, * p7, k1, p8; rep from * to end.

Row 3: * K7, p3, k6; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 4: P1, * p6, k3, p7; rep from * to end.

Row 5: * K6, p5, k5; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 6: P1, * p5, k5, p6; rep from * to end.

Row 7: * K5, p7, k4; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 8: P1, * p4, k7, p5; rep from * to end.

Row 9: * K4, p9, k3; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 10: P1, * p3, k9, p4; rep from * to end.

Row 11: * K3, p11, k2; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 12: P1, * p2, k11, p3; rep from * to end.

Row 13: * K2, p13, k1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 14: P1, * p1, k13, p2; rep from * to end.

Row 15: * K1, p15; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 16: P1, * k15, p1; rep from * to end.

Rep Rows 1-16 for patt.

Seed

(multiple of 2 sts plus 1)

Row 1 (RS): * K1, p1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2 (WS): K1, * p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

PATTERN BEGINS

BLANKET

Cast on 155 sts.

Lower Border

Work in Seed patt for 6 rows, or until piece meas approx. $\frac{3}{4}$ " from cast-on edge, ending with a WS Row.

Main Blanket

Note: You may wish to place markers between each pattern repeat to help you stay on track.

Row 1 (RS): Cont in Seed patt over 5 sts, pm, work Row 1 of Triangles patt to last 5 sts, pm, cont in Seed patt to end. Patt will be repeated 9 times across each row.



Row 2 (WS): Cont as est'd to m, sl m, work next row of Triangles patt to m, sl m, cont as est'd to end.

Cont in patt as est'd through Row 16 of Triangles patt, then rep Rows 1-16 of Triangles patt, 15 more times. Piece meas approx. $35\frac{3}{4}$ " from cast-on edge.

Upper Border

Note: Remove markers as you come to them.

Work in Seed patt for 6 rows, or until piece meas approx. $36\frac{1}{2}$ " from cast-on edge. Bind off all sts in patt.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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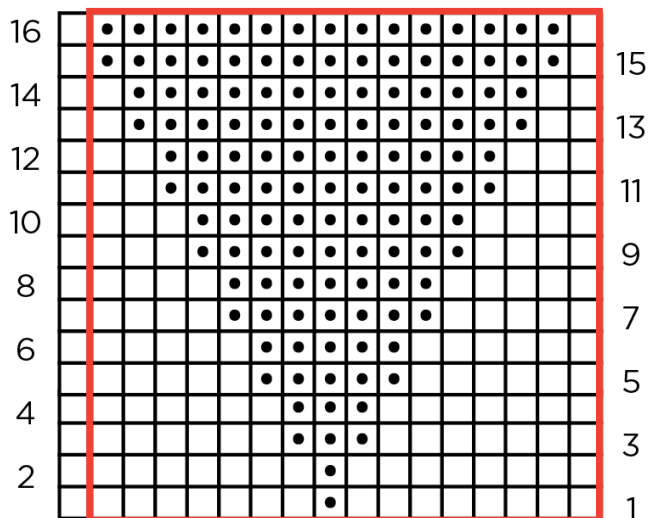

Triangles



Key

- pattern repeat
- knit on RS, purl on WS
- purl on RS, knit on WS

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
