Knitting

##### DIFFICULTY

Easy

##### SIZES

Beret

Adult Small (Medium, Large)

*Shown in Adult Small size.*

##### Shrug

Small/Medium (Large/Extra Large, 2X/3X)

*Shown in Small/Medium size.*

##### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Beret

Brim Circumference: 18 (20, 22)"

##### Shrug

Neck Circumference: 24 (26 $\frac{1}{4}$ , 28 $\frac{1}{2}$ )"

Length: 16"

##### MATERIALS

Rico Design Fashion Alpaca Superfine Heavens (63% alpaca, 37% polyamide; 50g/153 yds)

- 002 Forest – 3 balls

**Needle:** US Size 10 (6 mm) 16" and 24" circular, and set of DPNs (or your preferred ndl for knitting small circumferences) or size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, crochet hook, stitch markers.

## GAUGE

16 sts X 20 rows = 4" in Stockinette St (St st)

Save time, check your gauge.

## PATTERN NOTES

The Ravishing Set brings you a classic silhouette in the softest of yarns. Perfect for those days when you need a little bit of cozy warmth to keep the chill at bay while keeping things polished.

The beret is knit from the bottom up, beginning with a provisional cast-on that is later unpicked and bound off using the I-cord method. Circular increases are used to create a classic beret shape.

The shrug also begins with a provisional cast-on that is later unpicked and bound off with an I-Cord using the I-Cord method. It is knit in the round from the top down and then separated at the neck and knit flat with a built in I-Cord edge and finally bound off using the I-Cord method.

### Crochet Provisional Cast-on

With waste yarn and crochet hook, make a ch approximately 10 chs longer than the number of sts to be cast on. With working yarn and knitting needle, pick up and knit sts through the bottom bump of each ch.

### I-Cord Bind-Off

Cast on 3 sts to first st on left ndl using knitted cast-on. \* K2, k2tog tbl (1 st bound off), slip these 3 sts back to left ndl; rep from \* until all sts have been bound off. Bind off rem 3 I-Cord sts.

## PATTERN BEGINS

### BERET

Cast-on 72 (80, 88) sts using the Crochet Provisional Method and knit 1 row. PM and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

### Brim

Knit in St st until piece meas approx. 1" from cast-on edge.

### Body

**Set-up Rnd:** \* K9 (10, 11) sts, m1, pm; rep from \* to end of rnd - 8 sts inc'd, 80 (88, 96) sts.

### Even Rnd:

**Inc Rnd:** \* Knit to m, m1, sl m; rep from \* to end - 8 sts inc'd, 88 (96, 104) sts.

Rep Inc Rnd every other rnd, 4 more times - 32 sts inc'd, 120 (128, 136) sts.

Cont. working in St st until piece meas approx. 5" from cast-on edge.

### Crown Shaping

**Dec Rnd:** \* Knit to 2 sts bef m, ssk, sl m; rep from \* to end of rnd - 8 sts dec'd, 112 (120, 128) sts rem.

### Even Rnd:

Rep Dec Rnd every other rnd, 12 (13, 14) more times - 96 (104, 112) sts dec'd, 16 sts rem.

**Next Rnd:** \* K2tog, remove m; rep from \* to end of rnd - 8 sts dec'd, 8 sts rem.

Break yarn, leaving an 8" tail, weave through remaining sts and pull taut to close.

## FINISHING

Carefully unravel crochet chain, placing resulting live sts onto ndls. Bind off all sts using the I-Cord method.

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

## SHRUG

Cast-on 96 (105, 114) sts using the Crochet Provisional Method and knit 1 row. PM and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

### Even Section

Work in St st until piece meas approx. 8" from cast-on edge.

### Increase Section

Remove bor m, you will now begin to work flat, back and forth in rows.

**Set-up Row 1 (RS):** K3, \* k9, m1, pm; rep from \* to last 3 sts, sl 3 wyif - 10 (11, 12) sts inc'd, 106 (116, 126) sts.

**Set-up Row 2 (WS):** K3, purl to last 3 sts, sl 3 wyif.

**Row 1:** Knit to last 3 sts, sl 3 wyif.

**WS Rows 2-8:** Rep Row 2.

**RS Rows 3-5:** Rep Row 1.

**Row 7 (Inc Row):** \* Knit to m, m1, sl m; rep from \* to last 3 sts, sl 3 wyif - 10 (11, 12) sts inc'd, 116 (127, 138) sts.

Rep Rows 1-8, 2 more times - 20 (22, 24) sts inc'd, 136 (149, 162) sts.

Cont working even as est'd until piece meas approx. 16" from cast-on edge.

Bind off using I-cord method.

## FINISHING

Carefully unravel crochet chain, placing resulting live sts onto ndls. Bind off all sts using the I-Cord method.

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

*	indicates a repeat section
approx	approximately
ch	chain
cont	continue
dec('d)	decrease(d)
dpn(s)	double pointed needle(s)
est'd	established
inc('d)	increase(d)
k	knit
kfb	knit into front and back of next st (1 st inc'd)
m1	insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st inc'd)
meas	measures
ndl	needle
p	purl
pm	place marker
rep	repeat
rnd(s)	round(s)
RS	right side
sl	slip
ssk	slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
St st	Stockinette stitch (knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows; in the rnd, knit every rnd)
st(s)	stitch(es)
WS	wrong side
wyif	with yarn held in front
