





Ribbon Mitts

SIZES

Adult Small (Medium, Large) Shown in Adult Medium Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 6¼ (7½, 9)" Length: 8½"

MATERIALS

Fibra Natura *Kingston Tweed* (50% wool, 25% alpaca, 25% mixed fiber; 50g/194 yds)

• 107 Quartz – 2 skeins

Hook: US Size E-4 (3.5 mm) or size

needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

19 sts x 23 rnds = 4" in waistcoat-hdc **Save time check your gauge.**

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

Lightweight, delicate, and with a thoughtful bowdetail along the wrists, the Ribbon Mitts are the perfect autumn accessory. Dress them up or down, they're sure to go along with everything in your wardrobe.

These mitts are worked continuously in the round with no slip stitch. A stitch marker is placed at the beginning of each round to denote where each round begins.

STITCH GUIDE

Half Double Waistcoat Stitch (waistcoat-hdc)

For purposes of this pattern, the waistcoat stitch is a half double crochet stitch worked into the center of the posts of a stitch rather than the usual top 2 lps.

Foundation Single Crochet (fsc)

Ch 2, insert hk in 2nd ch from hk, yo, pull up lp, yo, draw through 1 lp (first chain made), yo, draw through 2 lps on hk (first fsc made), * insert hk under 2 lps of chain just made, yo, pull up lp, yo, draw through 1 lp (chain made), yo, draw through 2 lps on hk (Fsc made); rep from * for indicated number of foundation sts.

Foundation Half Double Crochet (fhdc)

Ch 2, yo, insert hk into first ch, yo, pull up lp, yo, draw through 1 lp on hk, (first chain made), yo, draw through 3 lps on hk (first fhdc made), * insert hk under 2 lps of fhdc just made, yo, pull up a lp, yo, draw through 1 lp, yo, draw through 3 lps on hk (fhdc made); rep from * for indicated number of foundation sts.

First Linked Half Double Crochet (first linked-hdc)

Pull lp on hk up to slightly taller than normal, ch 1, insert hk into bottom bump of first ch from hk, yo, draw up lp (2 lps on hk), insert hk into first st of row, yo, draw up lp (3 lps on hk), yo, draw through 2 lps

RIGHT MITT

Rnd 1: Fsc 30 (35, 43), join with slip stitch in first sc to form ring -30 (35, 43) sc.



Rnd 2: First-linked hdc in the same st, pm to denote bor, hdc in each sc around, ending with sl st to first hdc of rnd.

Rnd 3: Working the waistcoat-hdc (see Stitch Guide), first-linked hdc in same st as sl st, hdc in post of next stitch and in each post of next 16 (21, 29) hdc, ch 7, sk next 7 hdc, waistcoat-hdc in last 6 hdc.

Rnd 4: Hdc in post of first hdc of rnd and in each post of next 16 (21, 29) hdc, ch 7, sk ch-7 sp, hdc in post of last 6 hdc.

Rnd 5: Hdc in post of first hdc of rnd and in each post of next 16 (21, 29) hdc, ch 7, sk ch-7 sp, hdc in post of last 6 hdc.

Rnd 6: Hdc in post of first hdc of rnd and in each post of next 16 (21, 29) hdc, ch 7, sk ch-7 sp, hdc in post of last 6 hdc.

Rnd 7: Hdc in post of first hdc of rnd and in each post of next 16 (21, 29) hdc, ch 3, sl st over 3 ch7, ch 3, hdc in post of last 6 hdc.

Rnds 8-15: Rep Rnds 4-7, 2 more times.

Rnd 16: Hdc in post of first hdc of rnd and in each post of next 16 (21, 29) hdc, ch 7, sk Bow space, hdc in post of last 6 hdc.

Rnd 17: Hdc in post of first hdc of rnd and in each post of next 16 (21, 29) hdc, hdc in each of 7 ch sts, hdc in post of last 6 hdc.

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Rnds 18-30: Hdc in post of each hdc around.

Rnd 31: Hdc in post of next 5 hdc, 10 fhdc, sk next 5 hdc, hdc in post of next hdc (Thumb Hole created) hdc in post of each hdc around.

Rnd 32: Hdc in post of each of next 5 hdc, hdc in each post next 10 fhdc, hdc in post of each hdc around.

Rnds 33-48: Hdc in post of each hdc around.

Rnd 49: Ch 1, sc in each of next 10 hdc, [sc2tog] 2 times, sc in each hdc around – 2 sts dec'd, 28 (33, 41) sc. Fasten off.

Thumb Hole

Rnd 1: Join yarn to Thumb Hole with sl st, hdc in post of first hdc and in each hdc around. Fasten off.

LEFT MITT

Rnd 1: Fsc 30 (35, 43), join with slip stitch in first sc to form ring -30 (35, 43) sc.

Rnd 2: First-linked hdc in the same st, pm to denote bor, hdc in each sc around, ending with sl st to first hdc of rnd.

Rnd 3: Working the waistcoat-hdc (Stitch Guide), first-linked hdc in same st as sl st, hdc in post of next stitch and in each post of next 5 hdc, ch 7, sk next 7 hdc, waistcoat-hdc in last 17 (22, 30) hdc.

Rnd 4: Hdc in post of first hdc of rnd and in each post of next 5 hdc, ch 7, sk ch-7 sp, hdc in post of last 17 (22, 30) hdc.

Rnd 5: Hdc in post of first hdc of rnd and in each post of next 5 hdc, ch 7, sk ch-7 sp, hdc in post of last 17 (22, 30) hdc.

Rnd 6: Hdc in post of first hdc of rnd and in each post of next 5 hdc, ch 7, sk ch-7 sp, hdc in post of last 17 (22, 30) hdc.

Rnd 7: Hdc in post of first hdc of rnd and in each post of next 5 hdc, ch 3, sl st over 3 ch7, ch 3, hdc in post of last 17 (22, 30) hdc.

Rnds 8-15: Rep Rnds 4-7, 2 more times.

Rnd 16: Hdc in post of first hdc of rnd and in each post of next 5 hdc, ch 7, sk Bow space, hdc in post of last 17 (22, 30) hdc.

Rnd 17: Hdc in post of first hdc of rnd and in each post of next 5 hdc, hdc in each of 7 ch sts, hdc in post of last 17 (22, 30) hdc.

Rnds 18-30: Hdc in post of each hdc around.

Rnd 31: Hdc in post of each hdc around until reach last 10 hdc, 10 fhdc, sk next 5 hdc, hdc in post of next hdc (Thumb Hole created), hdc in post of last 4 hdc.

Rnd 32: Hdc in post of each hdc around until reach fhdc chain, hdc in post of each 10 fhdc, hdc in post of each hdc around.

Rnds 33-48: Hdc in post of each hdc around.

Rnd 49: Ch 1, sc in each of next 10 hdc, [sc2tog] 2 times, sc in each hdc around – 2 sts dec'd, 28 (33, 41) sc. Fasten off.

Thumb Hole

Rnd 1: Join yarn to Thumb Hole with sl st, hdc in post of first hdc and in each hdc around. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.
