SIZES

Extra Small (Small, Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, 3X, 4X)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: 32 (36¾, 40¾, 44½, 48½, 52¼, 56¼, 60¼)"

Length: 22 (22½, 23, 23¾, 24¼, 24¾, 25½,

25%)"

MATERIALS

Rozetti Yarns *Alaska* (44% acrylic, 26% polyamide, 15% alpaca, 15% superwash fine merino wool; 50g/246 yds)

• 907 Silver Moon (MC) – 4 (4, 4, 5, 5, 5, 6, 6) balls

Universal Yarn Finn (50% acrylic, 25% superwash merino, 25% alpaca; 50g/230 yds)

• 112 Jade (CC) – 1 (1, 1, 1, 1, 2, 2, 2) ball(s)

Needles: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) straight, 16" circular and set of DPNs *or size needed to obtain gauge*

US Size 6 (4 mm) straight *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, removable markers, stitch holders or smooth waste yarn

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GAUGE

16.5 sts x 26 rows = 4" in Stockinette stitch (St st) using larger ndl

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

The Ridgeline Pullover is the perfect sweater for lounging at home on rainy weekends – but you'll never want to take it off. Knit in Alaska and Finn, this sweater is lightweight without compromising warmth. Both yarns combine a variety of fibers that give the sweater a soft halo.

This sweater is knit flat from the bottom-up. It features drop-shoulders and an A-line silhouette. The hems feature two-color ribbing and the sweater is finished with an I-cord edging.

I-Cord Bind-Off

Cast on 3 sts to first st on left ndl using knitted cast-on. * K2, k2tog tbl (1 st bound-off), slip these 3 sts back to left ndl; rep from * until all sts have been bound-off. Bind off rem 3 I-Cord sts.

Sloped Bind-off: On the row before the bind-off row, slip the last stitch of the row pwise wyib. On the bind-off row, sl 2, pass the second slipped st over the first slipped st, bind off rem sts as usual.

SWEATER

Front

Hem

With smaller ndl, MC and CC, and using the two-color long-tail method, cast on 80 (90, 98, 106, 114, 122, 130, 138) sts. Work in Two Color Rib for 1¾", ending with a WS row. Break CC.

Body

Switch to larger ndl.

Row 1 (RS): With MC, knit to end.

Row 2 (WS): Purl to end.

Note: Read through entire section before proceeding. Body shaping occurs at the same time as Stripe section.

Dec Row: K1, ssk, cont as est'd to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 2 sts dec'd, 78 (88, 96, 104, 112, 120, 128, 136) sts rem.

Work a Dec Row every 14 rows 4 (4, 4, 5, 5, 5, 5) more times, then work a Dec Row every 10 rows 1 (1, 1, 0, 0, 0, 0, 0) times – 68 (78, 86, 94, 102, 110, 118, 126) sts rem.

At the same time, when Front meas 5% (5%, 5%, 5%, 5%, 5%, 5%, 5%, 5%, 5%, 5%)" from cast-on edge, join CC and beg working Rows 1-8 of Stripe patt. Cont as est'd, working Stripe patt 11 times. After 11^{th} Stripe is complete, break CC and cont in MC and St st. Work even until piece meas approx 15% (15%, 15%, 16, 16, 16, 16%, 16%)".

Armholes

Place removeable markers on each side to denote armholes.

Next Row (RS): Knit to end. Next Row (WS): Purl to end.

Cont as est'd until Front meas 3% (4%, 4%, 5%, 5%, 6%, 6%, 7%)" from Armhole markers, ending with a WS row.

Shape Front Neck

Note: Use the Sloped Bind-Off method during Front Neck shaping.

Setup Row (RS): K30 (34, 38, 41, 45, 48, 52, 55) Left Front sts, join a new ball of yarn and bind off 8 (10, 10, 12, 12, 14, 14, 16) sts, k30 (34, 38, 41, 45, 48, 52, 55) Right Front sts. Place Left Front sts on holder.

Right Front

Next Row (WS): Purl to end.

Next Row (RS): Bind off 5 sts, knit to end 25 (29, 33, 36, 40, 43, 47, 50) sts rem.

Next Row: Purl to end.

Dec Row (RS): K1, ssk, knit to end – 1 st dec'd, 24 (28, 32, 35, 39, 42, 46, 49) sts rem.

Work a Dec Row every RS Row, one more time – 1 st dec'd, 23 (27, 31, 34, 38, 41, 45, 48) sts rem. **Dec Row (WS):** Purl to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1 – 1 st dec'd, 22 (26, 30, 33, 37, 40, 44, 47) sts rem. Rep Dec Row every row, 5 more times – 5 sts dec'd, 17 (21, 25, 28, 32, 35, 39, 42) sts rem. Cont as est'd, if necessary, until Right Front meas 6¼ (6¾, 7¼, 7¾, 8¼, 8¾, 9¼, 9¾)" from Armhole m. Place Right Front sts on holder.

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Left Front

Return 30 (34, 38, 41, 45, 48, 52, 55) Left Front sts to nd.

Next Row (WS): Bind off 5 sts, purl to end - 25 (29, 33, 36, 40, 43, 47, 50) sts rem.

Dec Row (RS): Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 1 st dec'd, 24 (28, 32, 35, 39, 42, 46, 49) sts rem.

Even Row: Purl end.

Work a Dec Row every RS Row, one more time – 1 st dec'd, 24 (27, 31, 34, 38, 41, 45, 48) sts rem. **Dec Row (WS):** P1, ssp, purl to end – 1 st dec'd, 23 (26, 30, 33, 37, 40, 44, 47) sts rem. Rep Dec Row every row, 5 more times – 5 sts dec'd, 17 (21, 25, 28, 32, 35, 39, 42) sts rem. Cont as est'd, if necessary, until Right Front meas 6¼ (6¾, 7¼, 7¾, 8¼, 8¾, 9¼, 9¾)" from Armhole m. Place Right Front sts on holder.

Back

Work as for Front to Armholes.

Armholes

Place removeable markers on each side to denote armholes.

Next Row (RS): Knit to end.

Next Row (WS): K1, purl to last 2 sts, k1. Cont as est'd until Back meas $4\frac{3}{4}$ ($5\frac{4}{4}$, $5\frac{3}{4}$, $6\frac{3}{4}$, $7\frac{4}{4}$, $7\frac{3}{4}$, $8\frac{4}{4}$)" from Armhole markers, ending with a WS row.

Shape Back Neck

Note: Use the Sloped Bind-Off method during Back Neck shaping.

Setup Row (RS): K20 (24, 28, 31, 35, 38, 42, 45) Right Back sts, bind off 28 (30, 30, 32, 32, 34, 34, 36) Back Neck sts, k20 (24, 28, 31, 35, 38, 42, 45) Left Back sts. Place 20 (24, 28, 31, 35, 38, 42, 45) Right Back sts on holder.

Left Back

Row 1 (WS): Purl to end.

Row 2 (RS): Bind off 2 sts, knit to end – 18 (22, 26, 29, 33, 36, 40, 43) sts rem.

Row 3: Purl to end.

Row 4: Bind off 1 st, knit to end -17 (21, 26, 28, 32, 35, 39, 43) sts rem. Cont even in St st, if necessary, until Left Back meas $6\frac{1}{4}$ ($6\frac{3}{4}$, $7\frac{1}{4}$, $7\frac{3}{4}$, $8\frac{1}{4}$, $9\frac{1}{4}$, $9\frac{1}{4}$, $9\frac{1}{4}$)" from Armhole m. Place Left Back sts on holder.

Right Back

Row 1 (WS): Bind off 2 sts, knit to end – 18 (22, 26, 29, 33, 36, 40, 43) sts rem.

Row 2 (RS): Knit to end.

Row 3: Bind off 1 st, knit to end -17 (21, 26, 28, 32, 35, 39, 43) sts rem. Cont even in St st, if necessary, until Left Back meas 6% (6%, 7%, 7%, 8%, 8%, 9%, 9%)" from Armhole m. Place Left Back sts on holder.

Sleeve

Cuff

With smaller ndl, MC and CC, and using the two-color long-tail method, cast on 30 (32, 32, 34, 34, 36, 36, 38) sts.

Work in Two Color Rib for 1¾", ending with a WS row. Break CC.

Main Sleeve

Switch to larger ndl.

Row 1 (RS): With MC, knit to end.

Row 2 (WS): K1, Purl to end.

Inc Row: K1, m1R, cont as est'd to last st, m1L, k1 – 2 sts inc'd, 32 (34, 34, 36, 36, 38, 38, 40) sts.

Even Row: Cont as est'd to end.

Work an Inc Row every 8 (8, 6, 6, 4, 4, 4, 4) rows 7 (11, 5, 8, 0, 2, 7, 6) more time(s), then work an Inc Row every 10 (10, 8, 8, 6, 6, 6, 6) rows 4 (1, 9, 7, 18, 17, 14, 15) time(s) – 54 (58, 62, 66, 72, 76, 80, 82) sts.

At the same time, when Sleeve meas 5 (5, 5, 5%, 5%, 5%, 5%, 5%, 5%, 5%)" from cast-on edge, join CC and beg working Rows 1-8 Stripe Patt. Cont as est'd until Rows 1-8 of Stripe patt has been completed 11 times. Break CC.

With MC, cont even in St st. Cont as est'd until Sleeve meas 18% (18%, 19, 19%, 19%, 19%, 20, 20%)" from cast-on edge. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Block pieces to finished measurements. Return Left Front and Left Back sts to ndl. With WS facing, bind off all sts using the 3-ndl method. Return Right Front and Right back sts to ndl. With WS facing, bind off all sts using the 3-ndl method. Sew Sleeves to body. Sew sides.

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With CC and RS facing, beg at left shoulder, pick up and knit 36 (38, 38, 40, 40, 42, 42, 44) sts along Back Neck, 12 sts along Right Front Neck edge, 8 (10, 10, 12, 12, 14, 14, 16) sts along Front Neck edge, and 12 sts along Left Front Neck Edge – 70 (74, 74, 78, 78, 82, 82, 86) sts. Bind off all sts using the I-cord method. Seam ends of I-cord tog.


