Right Turn Shawl

SIZE

One

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Wingspan: 52"

Depth in Center: 26"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Bamboo Pop* (50% bamboo, 50% cotton; 100g/292 yds)

- 306 Grape Dots (MC) – 2 skeins
- 116 Royal (CC1) – 1 skein
- 120 Graphite (CC2) – 1 skein

Needle: US Size 4 (3.5 mm) 40" circular (to accommodate large number of sts) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: 2 Stitch markers, tapestry needle, blocking wires and pins

GAUGE

22 sts x 44 rows = 4" in garter st

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat.

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PATTERN NOTES

This graphic shawl is knit in one piece from the top down. With so many colors in the Bamboo Pop palette including solids, multis, and dots, you'll have a blast choosing just the right shades for your project.

In the striped section, color changes are achieved with slipped stitches, meaning only one color per row is used. Slip all stitches purlwise with yarn held to the WS of the work.

I-Cord

* K3, slide sts to other end of ndl and place in left hand; rep from *.

I-Cord Bind-Off

Cast on 3 sts to first st on left ndl using knitted cast-on. * K2, k2tog tbl (1 st bound-off), slip these 3 sts back to left ndl; rep from * until all sts have been bound-off.

SHAWL

With MC, cast on 3 sts.

Set-up row (WS): Kfb, pm, p1, pm, kfb – 5 sts.

MC Garter Section 1

Row 1 (RS): [K1, m1] 2 times, sl m, k1, sl m, [m1, k1] 2 times – 4 sts inc'd, 9 sts.

Row 2 (WS): Knit to m, sl m, p1, sl m, knit to end.

Row 3: K1, m1, knit to m, m1, sl m, k1, sl m, m1, knit to last st, m1, k1 – 4 sts inc'd, 13 sts.

Row 4: Knit to m, sl m, p1, sl m, knit to end.

Rep Rows 3-4, 21 more times – 97 sts.

With CC1, rep Rows 3 & 4, 1 time – 4 sts inc'd, 101 sts. Break CC1.

Slip Stitch Stripe Section 1

Note: Each row will be worked two times – once with MC, and a second time with CC2. At the end of every CC2 row, slide sts to the other end of the ndl in order to work the MC row.

Row 1 CC2 (RS): With CC2, k1, m1, sl 1, [k1, sl 1] to m, m1, sl m, k1, sl m, m1, [sl 1, k1] to last 2 sts, sl 1, m1, k1 – 4 sts inc'd, 105 sts.

Row 1 MC (RS): With MC, sl 2, [k1, sl 1] to m, sl m, sl 1, sl m, sl 1, [k1, sl 1] to last st, sl 1.

Row 2 CC2 (WS): With CC2, P1, [k1, sl 1] to 1 st bef m, k1, sl m, p1, sl m, k1, [sl 1, k1] to last st, p1.

Row 2 MC (WS): With MC, sl 2, p1, [sl 1, p1] to 1 st bef m, sl 1, sl m, sl 1, sl m, sl 1, [p1, sl 1] to last st, sl 1.

Row 3 CC2 (RS): With CC2, sl 1, [k1, sl 1] to 1 st bef m, k1, sl m, sl 1, sl m, k1, [sl 1, k1] to last st, sl 1.

Row 3 MC (RS): With MC, k1, m1, [sl 1, k1] to 1 st bef m, sl 1, m1, sl m, k1, sl m, m1, sl 1, [k1, sl 1] to last st, m1, k1 – 4 sts inc'd, 109 sts.

Row 4 CC2 (WS): With CC2, sl 2, [k1, sl 1] to m, sl m, sl 1, sl m, [sl 1, k1] to last 2 sts, sl 2.

Row 4 MC (WS): With MC p2, [sl 1, p1] to m, sl m, p1, sl m, [p1, sl 1] to last 2 sts, p2.

Rep last 8 rows of sequence (4 CC2 rows/4 MC rows), 11 more times, then rep first 4 rows of sequence (2 CC2 rows / 2 MC rows), 1 more time – 92 sts inc'd, 201 sts. Break CC2.

MC Garter Section 2

Row 1 (RS): With CC1, k1, m1, knit to m, m1, sl m, k1, sl m, m1, knit to last st, m1, k1 – 4 sts inc'd, 205 sts.

Row 2 (WS): With CC1, knit to m, sl m, p1, sl m, knit to end.

Break CC1.

With MC, rep Rows 1 & 2, 12 more times – 48 sts inc'd, 253 sts.

Garter Stripe Section

Row 1 (RS): With CC1, k1, m1, knit to m, m1, sl m, k1, sl m, m1, knit to last st, m1, k1 – 4 sts inc'd, 257 sts.

Row 2 (WS): With CC1, knit to m, sl m, p1, sl m, knit to end.

Rows 3 & 4: With MC, rep Rows 1 & 2 – 4 sts inc'd, 261 sts.

Rows 5 & 6: With CC1, rep Rows 1 & 2 – 4 sts inc'd, 265 sts.

Rows 7 & 8: With MC, rep Rows 1 & 2 – 4 sts inc'd, 269 sts.

Rows 9 & 10: With CC1, rep Rows 1 & 2 – 4 sts inc'd, 273 sts.

Break CC1.

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MC Garter Section 3

Row 1 (RS): With MC, k1, m1, knit to m, m1, sl m, k1, sl m, m1, knit to last st, m1, k1 – 4 sts inc'd, 277 sts.

Row 2 (WS): With MC, knit to m, sl m, p1, sl m, knit to end.

Rep Rows 1 & 2, 11 more times – 44 sts inc'd, 321 sts.

With CC1, rep Rows 1 & 2, 1 time – 4 sts inc'd, 325 sts.

Slip Stitch Stripe Section 2

Work the 8 rows of Stripe Sequence from Slip Stitch Stripe Section 1, 13 times, then rep the first 4 rows of Sequence, 1 more time – 108 sts inc'd, 433 sts. Break MC, do not break CC2.

Final Stripe

Row 1 (RS): With CC1, k1, m1, knit to m, m1, sl m, k1, sl m, m1, knit to last st, m1, k1 – 4 sts inc'd, 437 sts.

Row 2 (WS): With CC1, knit to m, sl m, p1, sl m, knit to end. Break CC1.

Edging

Rnd 1: With CC2, knit to m, sl m, k1, sl m, knit to end, pm; working along long top edge of piece, pick up and knit 444 sts (approx. 1 st for every other row), join to work in the rnd.

Note: Take care not to bind off too loosely or too tightly. Stitches and rows should still retain some stretch.

Rnd 2: Using the I-Cord method, bind off all sts to m, remove m, work 1 row of I-Cord without joining, bind off center st, remove m, work 1 row of I-Cord without joining, bind off all sts to m, work 2 rows of I-Cord without joining (corner turned), bind off all sts to end of rnd, work 1 row of I-Cord without joining (corner turned), bind off rem 3 I-Cord sts.

FINISHING

Sew ends of I-Cord tog. Weave in ends. Run blocking wires along all edges of shawl. Pin to blocking board, stretching as much as possible. Steam or wet block.

Abbreviations

approx	approximately
CC	contrast color
garter st	knit every row
inc('d)	increase(d)
k	knit
kfb	knit into front and back of next st (1 st inc'd)
m	marker
m1	insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st inc'd)
MC	main color
p	purl
pm	place marker
pwise	purlwise
rem	remain(ing)
rep	repeat
RS	right side
sl	slip
st(s)	stitch(es)
tbl	through the back loop(s)
WS	wrong side
wyib	with yarn held in back
wyif	with yarn held in front

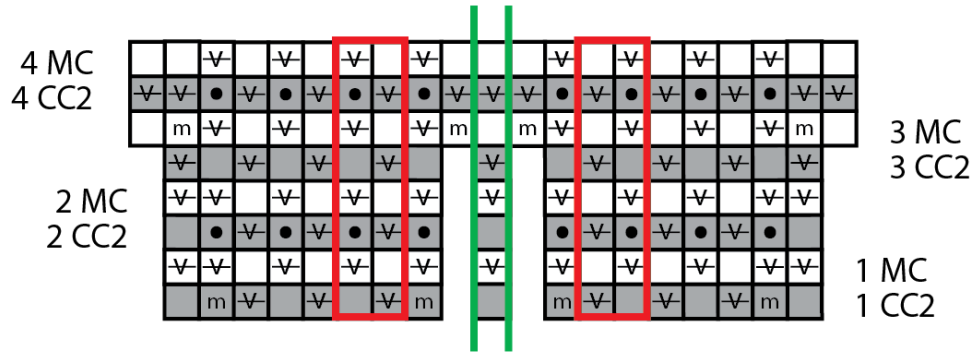
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Slip Stitch Stripe Section



Key

- MC - knit on RS, purl on WS
- CC2 - knit on RS, purl on WS
- CC2 - knit on WS
- m MC - m1
- m CC2 - m1
- v MC - sl 1 pwise wyib, wyif on WS
- v CC2 - sl 1 pwise wyib on RS, wyif on WS
- pattern repeat
- marker placement

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
