



Pattern Collection: Accessories



Rising Tide Scarf

SIZES

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 10"

Length: 77" (excluding fringe)

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Major (100% acrylic; 200g/328 yds)

- 125 Bluebird (MC) – 1 skein
- 120 Lagoon (CC) – 1 skein

Needles: US Size 10½ (6.5 mm) straight
or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, US Size K-10½ (6.5 mm) crochet hook (for attaching fringe)

GAUGE

14 sts x 24 rows = 4" in Diagonals Slip st
Save time, check your gauge.

Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat!

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STITCH GUIDE

Right Diagonals Slip Stitch (MC)

(multiple 6+3 sts)

Row 1 (RS): K3, * sl 3, k3; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS): P4, * sl 3, p3; rep from * to last 5 sts, sl 3, p2.

Row 3: K1, * sl 3, k3; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 4: P6, * sl 3, p3; rep from * to last 3 sts, p3.

Row 5: K5, * sl 3, k3; rep from * to last 4 sts, sl 3, k1.

Row 6: P2, * sl 3, p3; rep from * to last st, p1.

Work Rows 1-6 in MC.

Left Diagonals Slip Stitch (CC)

(multiple 6+3 sts)

Row 1 (RS): K3, *sl 3, k3; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS): P2, * sl 3, p3; rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 3: K5, * sl 3, k3; rep from * to last 2 sts, sl 3, k1.

Row 4: P6, * sl 3, p3; rep from * to last 3 sts, p3.

Row 5: K1, * sl 3, k3; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 6: P4, * sl 3, p3; rep from * to last 5 sts, sl 3, p2.

Work Rows 1-6 in CC.

PATTERN NOTES

This scarf is worked flat in one piece. The intarsia method is used to change colors at the edges on rows worked in the CC. All stitches are slipped purlwise with yarn in front on RS rows and with yarn in back on WS rows.

SCARF

With MC, cast on 37 sts. Work 1" even in garter st.

Diagonals Stripe Section

(Note: maintain 2 garter stitches at each edge in MC, when switching to the CC; bring the MC up and around the new color, preventing any holes from forming in the piece.)

Row 1 (RS): With MC k2, work Row 1 of Left Diagonals Slip Stitch in CC to last 2 sts, with MC k2.

Row 2 (WS): With MC k2, work Row 2 of Left Diagonals Slip Stitch in CC to last 2 sts, with MC k2.

Keeping 2 edge sts in garter st, work through Row 6 of patt.

Next, with MC, work Rows 1-6 of Right Diagonals Slip Stitch. Cont in this manner, working Rows 1-6 of Left Diagonals Slip Stitch in CC and Rows 1-6 of Right Diagonals Slip Stch in MC 36 more times and then work Rows 1-6 of Left Diagonal Slip Stitch in CC 1 more time, 75 stripes total.

With MC, work 1" even in garter st. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends, wash and block Scarf to Finished Measurements.

Fringe

Cut 36, 12" pieces of yarn each in MC and CC (72 strands total). Holding 3 strands together as one group of fringe, attach each group to cast-on and bind off edge of scarf, spaced approximately ½" apart. Trim ends.

Abbreviations

cont	continue
CC	contrasting color
garter st	knit every row
k	knit
MC	main color
patt	pattern
p	purl
rep	repeat
RS	right side
sl	slip
st(s)	stitch(es)
WS	wrong side
wyib	with yarn held in back
wyif	with yarn held in front

Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat!

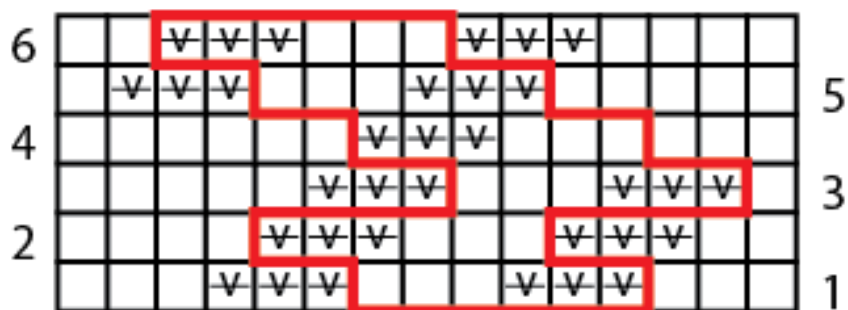
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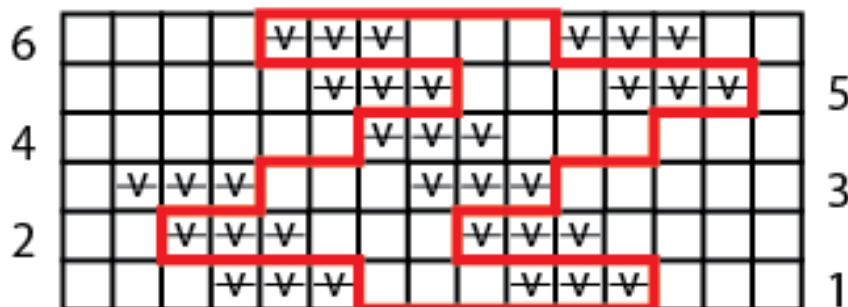
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Right Slip Stitch Diagonals (MC)
