DIFFICULTY Intermediate

SIZES

Extra Small (Small, Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, 3X, 4X, 5X) Shown in Small size with no ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: 28 (32, 36, 40, 44, 48, 52, 56, 60)" Length: 22 (22½, 23, 24, 24½, 25, 26, 26½, 27)"

MATERIALS

<u>Universal Yarn Wool Pop</u> (50% bamboo, 35% superwash wool, 15% polyamide; 100g/284 yds)

- 616 Denim (MC) 3 (3, 3, 3, 3, 4, 4, 4, 5) skeins
- 625 Sage (CC1) 1 (1, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2) skeins
- 603 Sand (CC2) 1 (1, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2) skeins
- 602 Cream (CC3) 1 (1, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2) skeins

Needles: US Size 6 (4 mm) straight *or* size needed to obtain gauge US Size 5 (3.75 mm) straight and 16" circular

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, stitch holders or waste yarn

GAUGE

24 sts x 32 rows = 4" in Stockinette stitch (St st) with larger ndl Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

A raglan pullover is a classic style that adds versatility to your handmade wardrobe. Whether you choose to dress it up or keep it casual, it will become a beloved staple garment you wear again and again. The Riverstone Sweater is knit using our three-season wool and bamboo blend, Wool Pop. Combining color blocking with stripes, the Riverstone pattern results in a project that's addictive to knit and effortless to wear.

This sweater is knit from the bottom up. The body is worked in the round and the front and back are separated at the underarm. The sleeves are knit flat, separately, and seamed to the body. Stitches for the neckband are picked up and knit in the round.

When working the Stripe Sequence patt in the Body, do not break yarn at the end of each stripe. Instead, carry the yarn up the inside of the work and twist the strands of yarn around one another every color change to prevent holes.

STITCH GUIDE

Rib

(multiple of 6 sts, worked in the rnd)
Rnd 1: * K3, p3; rep from * to end.
Rnd 2: * K1, p1; rep from * to end.
Rep Rnds 1-2 for patt.

Rib

(multiple of 6 sts, plus 5)

Row 1 (RS): K1, * k3, p3; rep from * to last 4 sts,

Row 2 (WS): P2, k1, p1, * k1, p1; rep from * to last st, p1.

Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

Stripe Sequence

(any number of sts, worked in the rnd)

Rnds 1-4: With MC, knit. Rnds 5-8: With CC1, knit. Rnds 9-12: With CC2, knit. Rnds 13-16: With CC3, knit. Rep Rnds 1-16 for patt.

Stripe Sequence

(any number of sts, worked flat) Row 1 (RS): With MC, knit.

Row 2 (WS): With MC, purl. Rows 3-4: Rep Rows 1-2.



Rows 5-8: With CC1, rep Rows 1-4. Rows 9-12: With CC2, rep Rows 1-4. Rows 13-16: With CC3, rep Rows 1-4. Rep Rows 1-16 for patt.

PATTERN BEGINS

BODY

Hem

With MC and smaller ndl, cast on 168 (192, 216, 240, 264, 288, 312, 336, 360) sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd.

Work in Rib patt for 2", ending with Rnd 2 of patt. Change to larger ndl.

Main Body

Note 1: Slip side marker as you come to it. Note 2: Change colors as indicated in Stripe Sequence patt.

Set-up Rnd: K84 (96, 108, 120, 132, 144, 156, 168, 180) Front sts, pm, k84 (96, 108, 120, 132, 144, 156, 168, 180) Back sts.

Work in Stripe Sequence patt until piece meas approx. 15 (15, 15, 15½, 15½, 15½, 16, 16, 16)" from cast-on edge, ending with Rnd 4, 8, 12, or 16 of Stripe Sequence, and ending 3 (4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11) sts bef bor m.

Separate Front and Back

Separation Row (RS): Bind off 6 (8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 22) underarm sts, removing bor m as you come to it, cont as est'd over Front sts to 3 (4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11) sts bef side m, bind off 6 (8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 22) underarm sts, cont as est'd over Back sts to end, turn work – 78 (88, 98, 108, 118, 128, 138, 148, 158) sts rem for each Front and Back. Place Front sts on holder or waste yarn.

Back Raglan Shaping

Note: Maintain Stripe Sequence as established throughout Raglan Shaping. You will now begin to work flat throughout the remainder of the Body.

Row 1 (WS): Cont as est'd to end.

Working Rows as outlined below, beginning with a RS Dec Row, work a Dec Row every 4 (4, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2) rows, 6 (3, 32, 32, 31, 30, 30, 29, 28) times, then work a Dec Row every 2 (2, 0, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1) row(s), 16 (24, 0, 4, 10, 16, 20, 26, 32) times – 44 (54, 64, 72, 82, 92, 100, 110, 120) sts dec'd.

Dec Row (RS): K2, ssk, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2 - 2 sts dec'd.

Dec Row (WS): P2, p2tog, purl to last 4 sts, ssp, p2 - 2 sts dec'd.

Even Row (RS): Knit. Even Row (WS): Purl.

After all dec's are completed, 34 (34, 34, 36, 36, 36, 38, 38, 38) sts rem for Back. Bind off all sts in patt. Return held Front sts to ndl, ready to work a WS row.

Front Raglan Shaping

Work as for Back Raglan Shaping, and at the same time, when 34 (38, 42, 46, 50, 54, 58, 62, 66) total Raglan Rows have been worked, shape Front Neck as follows:

Front Neck Shaping

Note 1: Maintain Raglan Shaping as est'd throughout Neck shaping.

Note 2: When Neck Shaping begins, you will work both the Left and Right Front at the same time using separate balls of yarn.

Place a marker on each side of center 10 (10, 10, 12, 12, 12, 14, 14, 14) sts.

Row 1 (RS): Cont as est'd over Left Front sts to m, join a new ball of yarn and bind off center 10 (10, 10, 12, 12, 12, 14, 14, 14) Neck sts, cont as est'd over Right Front sts to end.

Row 2 (WS): Cont as est'd over Right Front sts, bind off 2 Left Front sts, cont as est'd to end.

Row 3: Cont as est'd over Left Front sts, bind off 2 Right Front sts, cont as est'd to end.

Rows 4-9: Rep Rows 2-3, 3 more times.

Row 10: Cont as est'd over Right Front sts, bind off 1 Left Front st, cont as est'd to end.

Row 11: Cont as est'd over Left Front sts, bind off 1 Right Front st. cont as est'd to end.

Rows 12-17: Rep Rows 8-9, 3 more times.

Neck Shaping is complete. Cont as est'd throughout remainder of Raglan Shaping. Fasten off final stitch.

SIZES XS (S, M) ONLY:

After Neck Shaping is complete, 4 sts remeach Left and Right Front and there are 5 rem rows in Raglan Shaping.

Next Row (RS): K2, ssk over Left Front sts, k2tog, k2 over Right Front sts - 3 sts rem each Left and Right Front.

Next Row (WS): Work even as est'd to end.

Next Row (RS): K1, ssk over Left Front sts, k2tog, k1 over Right Front sts - 2 sts rem each Left and Right Front.

Next Row: Cont as est'd to end.

Next Row: Ssk over Left Front, K2tog over Right Front – 1 st rem each Left and Right Front. Fasten off rem st.

SIZES L (1X, 2X, 3X, 4X, 5X) ONLY:

After Neck Shaping is complete, 5 sts rem each Left and Right Front and there are 5 rem rows in Raglan Shaping.

Next Row (RS): K2, ssk, k1 over Left Front sts, k1, k2tog, k2 over Right Front sts – 4 sts rem each Left and Right Front.

Next Row (WS): P2, p2tog over Right Front, ssp, p2 over Left Front - 3 sts rem each Left and Right Front.

Next Row: K1, ssk over Left Front sts, k2tog, k1 over Right Front sts – 2 sts rem each Left and Right Front.

Next Row: Cont as est'd to end.

Next Row: Ssk over Left Front, K2tog over Right Front – 1 st rem each Left and Right Front. Fasten off rem st.

SLEEVES

(make two)

Cuff

With MC and smaller ndl, cast on 47 (47, 47, 53, 53, 53, 59, 59, 59) sts.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

Work in Rib patt for 2", ending with Row 2 of patt. circ Change to larger ndl. cont dec('d)

Row every 0 (12, 0, 0, 8, 6, 6, 4, 4) rows, 0 (1, 0, 0, 5, 12, 8, 26, 20) times – 14 (20, 26, 26, 32, 42, 46, through the back loop (1 st inc'd)

58, 70) sts inc'd, 63 (69, 75, 81, 87, 97, 107, 119, 131) sts.

Cont even in St st until piece meas 17" from caston edge, ending with a WS row.

Shape Raglan

Bind off 3 (4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11) sts at the beg of the next 2 rows - 57 (61, 65, 69, 73, 81, 89, 99, meas measures 109) sts rem.

MC main color meas measures ndl needle

Row 1 (Dec Row): K2, ssk, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, p purl k2- 2 sts dec'd, 55 (59, 63, 67, 71, 79, 87, 97, 107) p2tog purl 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

sts rem.

Rep Dec Row every 4 (4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 2) rows, 7 (7, 7, 8, 8, 6, 5, 2, 43) more times, then rep Dec Row every 2 rows, 12 (14, 16, 16, 18, 24, 28, 36, 0) times – 38 (42, 46, 48, 52, 60, 66, 76, 86) sts dec'd, 17 (17, 17, 19, 19, 19, 21, 21, 21) sts rem. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Block Body and Sleeves to finished measurements. Weave in ends. Sew Raglan and Sleeve seams.

Neckband

beg

With smaller 16" circ ndl, RS facing, and beg at Right Shoulder, pick up and knit 108 (108, 108, 114, 114, 126, 126, 126) sts evenly around neck. PM and join in the rnd. Work in Rib patt for 1½" from picked-up edge, ending with Rnd 2 of patt. Bind off all sts in patt.

Weave in rem ends.

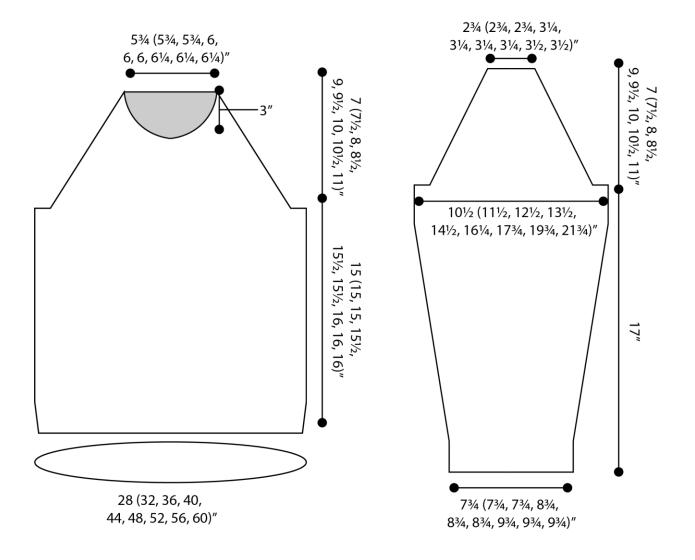

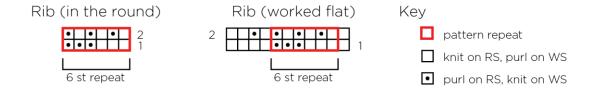
