



## Pattern Collection: Accessory



### Sailing Stone Shawl

#### SIZE

One

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 52"

Depth: 38"

#### MATERIALS

**Universal Yarn *Deluxe Chunky Naturals***  
(100% undyed wool; 100g/120 yds)

- 50003 Musket (MC) – 5 skeins
- 50004 Pewter (CC) – 1 skein

**Needles:** US Size 10 (6 mm) 32" circular  
*or size needed to obtain gauge*

US Size 9 (5.5 mm) 32" circular

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers, cable needle (cn)

#### GAUGE

12 sts x 17 rows = 4" in St st

**Save time, check your gauge.**

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## PATTERN NOTES

This generously sized shawl is knit from the top down and features a reversible cable. The cable panel is ribbed making the shawl just a bit stretchy when pulled around the shoulders.

**Applied I-Cord:** Cast on 3 sts to ndl. \* K2, k2tog tbl (last I-Cord st tog with picked up st), sl 3 sts back to left ndl; rep from \*.

**I-Cord (without joining):** \* K3, sl 3 sts back to left ndl; rep from \*.

## STITCH GUIDE

**3x3 Right Ribbed Cross 1 (RRC 1):** Sl next 3 sts to cn and hold in back, [p1, k1 tbl, p1] from left ndl, [p1, k1 tbl, p1] from cn.

**3x3 Left Ribbed Cross 1 (LRC 1):** Sl next 3 sts to cn and hold in front, [p1, k1 tbl, p1] from left ndl, [p1, k1 tbl, p1] from cn.

**3x3 Right Ribbed Cross 2 (RRC 2):** Sl next 3 sts to cn and hold in back, [k1, p1, k1] from left ndl, [k1, p1, k1] from cn.

**3x3 Left Ribbed Cross 2 (LRC 2):** Sl next 3 sts to cn and hold in front, [k1, p1, k1] from left ndl, [k1, p1, k1] from cn.

## Cable Panel

(panel of 52 sts)

**Row 1 (RS):** [P2, k1 tbl] 2 times, p2, k1, p1, [k2, p1, k1, p1] 6 times, k2, p1, k1, p2, [k1 tbl, p2] 2 times.

**WS Rows 2-20:** [K2, p1 tbl] 2 times, k2, p1, k1, p2, [k1, p1, k1, p2] 6 times, k1, p1, k2, [p1 tbl, k2] 2 times.

**Rows 3 & 5:** Rep Row 1.

**Row 7:** P1, 3x3 RRC 1, p1, [3x3 RRC 2, p1, k2, p1] 3 times, 3x3 RRC 2, p1, 3x3 LRC 1, p1.

**Rows 9, 11, 13, 15:** Rep Row 1.

**Row 17:** P1, 3x3 RRC 1, p1, k1, [p1, k2, p1, 3x3 LRC 2] 3 times, p1, k2, p1, k1, p1, 3x3 LRC 1, p1.

**Row 19:** Rep Row 1.

Rep Rows 1-20 for patt.

## SHAWL

With MC and larger ndl, cast on 156 sts. Knit 4 rows in garter st.

**Set-up row (WS):** K3, p58, pm, k2, p1 tbl, m1, k1, p1 tbl, m1, k1, p1, m1, [p2, m1, p1, m1] 6 times, p2, m1, p1, k1, m1, p1 tbl, k1, m1, p1 tbl, k2, pm, p58, k3 – 18 sts inc'd, 174 sts.

## Establish Pattern

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, ssk, knit to m, sl m, work Row 1 of Cable Panel to m, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2 – 2 sts dec'd, 172 sts rem.

**Row 2 (WS):** K3, purl to m, sl m, work Row 2 of Cable Panel to m, purl to last 3 sts, k3.

**Rows 3-164:** Cont in patt as est'd, dec'ing 1 st each edge on RS rows – 8 sts rem.

*Note: Once all the St sts have been consumed, remove markers and cont dec'ing as est'd. Maintain Cable Panel sts in patt as much as possible.*

**Row 165:** K2, ssk, k2tog, k2 – 6 sts rem.

**Row 166:** K6.

**Row 167:** K2, k2tog, k2 – 5 sts rem.

**Row 168:** K2, k2tog, k1 – 4 sts rem.

**Row 169:** K1, k2tog, k1 – 3 sts rem.

**Row 170:** K3tog. Fasten off last st.

## Edging

With cast-on edge of Shawl closest to you, smaller ndl, CC and RS facing, pick up (do not pick up and knit, just pick up) 1 st for every row along right shaped edge of Shawl – 170 sts on ndl. Work applied I-Cord over these sts, work 2 rows of I-Cord without joining (bottom corner turned), pick up 170 sts along left shaped edge of Shawl, work applied I-Cord over these sts, work 2 rows of I-Cord without joining (top corner turned), pick up 156 sts along cast-on edge of shawl, work applied I-Cord over these sts, work 1 row of I-Cord without joining. Bind off sts.

## FINISHING

Sew ends of I-Cord tog. Weave in ends and block to finished measurements.

## Tassels (make 3)

Wrap CC around 8" piece of cardboard, book, or other rigid surface, 50 times. Cut yarn at one end, freeing loops. Cut 2 pieces of yarn, 8" long. Loop one piece around tassel at the top (un-cut) end, securing strands. Carefully slide tassel off

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cardboard or surface. Wrap the other 8" piece of yarn around Tassel approx 1" from top end several times. Hide ends of this piece inside Tassel. Sew one tassel to each corner of Shawl.

<b>approx</b>	approximately
<b>CC</b>	contrast color
<b>cn</b>	cable needle
<b>cont</b>	continue
<b>dec('d)</b>	decrease(d)
<b>est'd</b>	established
<b>garter st</b>	knit every row
<b>inc('d)</b>	increase(d)
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
<b>k3tog</b>	knit 3 stitches together (2 sts dec'd)
<b>m</b>	marker
<b>m1</b>	insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st inc'd)
<b>MC</b>	main color
<b>ndl</b>	needle
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>patt</b>	pattern
<b>pm</b>	place marker
<b>rem</b>	remain(ing)
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>sl</b>	slip
<b>ssk</b>	slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
<b>St st</b>	Stockinette stitch (knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows; in the rnd, knit every rnd)
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>tbl</b>	through the back loop(s)
<b>WS</b>	wrong side

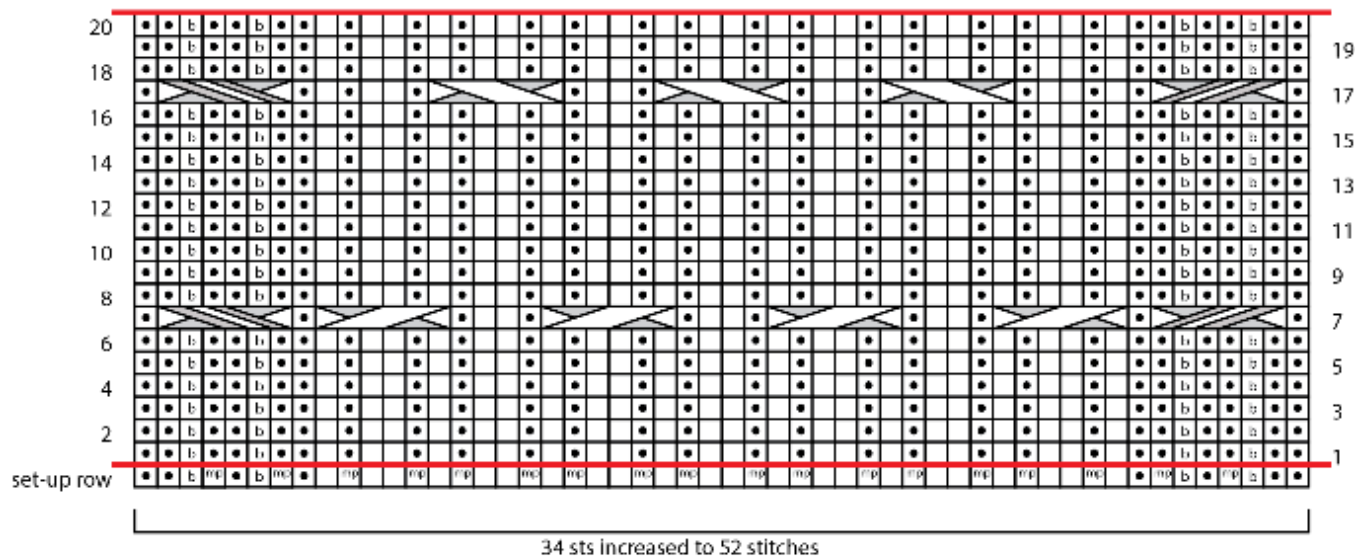


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## Cable Panel



### Key

- knit on RS, purl on WS
- purl on RS, knit on WS
- | k1 tbl on RS, p1 tbl on WS
- m1 knit on WS
- 3x3 RRC 1
- 3x3 LRC 1
- 3x3 RRC 2
- 3x3 LRC 2
- pattern repeat

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
