

Pattern Collection: Women



Sand Dollar Tank Designed by Yonca Ozbelli

SIZES Small (Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, 3X)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS Bust: 35 (39, 43½, 47½, 52, 56)" Length: 21½ (22, 23, 23½, 24¼, 24½)"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Cotton Supreme Splash* (100% cotton; 100g/180 yds)

201 Beach – 3 (4, 4, 4, 5, 5) balls
Needles: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) straight or size needed to obtain gauge
US Size 6 (4 mm) 16" circular (for neck edging)
Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch holder, stitch marker

GAUGE 19 sts x 24 rows = 4" in Sand Dollar Lace patt Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

This tank is worked from the bottom up in 2 pieces and seamed. Front and Back are identical.

STITCH GUIDE

Sand Dollar Lace (multiple of 10 sts + 3) Row 1 (RS): K1, * k1, yo, k3, sl 1-k2tog-psso, k3, yo; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 2 (WS): Purl.

Rows 3-6: Rep Rows 1-2, 2 times. **Row 7:** K1, k2tog, k3, yo, * k1, yo, k3, sl 1-k2togpsso, k3, yo; rep from * to last 7 sts, k1, yo, k3, ssk, k1.

Rows 8: Purl. Rows 9-12: Rep Rows 7-8, 2 times. Rep Rows 1-12 for patt.

FRONT

Cast on 83 (93, 103, 113, 123, 133) sts. Purl a WS row. Beg with Row 1, work in Sand Dollar Lace patt until piece meas 14 (14, 14½, 14½, 15, 15)", ending with WS row.

Shape Armholes

Note: Maintain sts in patt as much as possible. In pattern, if you work an inc, be sure to work the corresponding dec, and vice versa.

Bind off 2 (3, 4, 5, 6, 7) sts at beg of next 2 rows – 79 (87, 98, 103, 111, 119) sts rem.

Dec row (RS): K1, k2tog, work in patt to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 - 2 sts dec'd.

Dec row (WS): P1, ssp, work in patt to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1 – 2 sts dec'd. Cont to work a Dec row every row, - (-, -, -, 2, 2) more times, then work a Dec row every RS row, - (1, 2, 4, 4, 5) times – 75 (81, 87, 91, 95, 101) sts rem. Work even in patt until Armhole meas $3\frac{1}{2}$ (4, $4\frac{1}{2}$, 5, $5\frac{1}{4}$, $5\frac{1}{2}$)", ending with WS row.

Shape Left Front Neck

Row 1 (RS): Work in patt over 21 (23, 25, 26, 28, 30) sts, ssk, k1, turn. Place rem 51 (55, 59, 62, 64, 68) sts on holder.

Row 2 (WS): Work in patt to end.

Row 3: Work in patt to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 – 1 st dec'd.

Row 4: Work in patt to end.

Rows 5-12: Rep Rows 3-4, 4 more times – 18 (20, 22, 23, 25, 27) sts rem for Shoulder. Work even in

patt until Armhole meas 7½ (8, 8½, 9, 9¼, 9½)", ending with WS row. Bind off all sts.

Shape Right Neck

Return sts to ndl.

Row 1 (RS): Bind off 27 (29, 31, 33, 33, 35) Neck sts, k2tog, work in patt to end.

Row 2 (WS): Purl.

Row 3: K1, k2tog, work in patt to end – 1 st dec'd. **Row 4:** Purl.

Rows 5-12: Rep Rows 3-4, 4 more times – 18 (20, 22, 23, 25, 27) sts rem for Shoulder. Work even in patt until Armhole meas 7½ (8, 8½, 9, 9¼, 9½)", ending with WS row. Bind off all sts.

BACK


Work as for Front.

FINISHING

Block pieces to finished measurements. Sew Shoulder and side seams.


Neck Edging

With smaller circ ndl, pick up and knit 10 sts along Back Right Neck, 27 (29, 31, 33, 33, 35) sts along Back Neck bind-off edge, 10 sts along Back Left Neck, 10 sts along Front Left Neck, 27 (29, 31, 33, 33, 35) sts along Front Neck bind-off edge, and 10 sts along Frotn Right Neck – 94 (98, 102, 106, 106, 110) sts. PM and join to work in the rnd. [Purl 1 rnd, knit 1 rnd] 2 times. Bind off all sts pwise. Weave in ends.



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
