### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Depth in Center:** 25½"

**Wingspan:** 66"

### MATERIALS

**Fibra Natura Cottonwood** (100% organic cotton; 50g/115 yds)

- 41120 Barbara (A) – 5 balls
- 41107 Monica (B) – 1 ball
- 41118 Joanne (C) – 3 balls

**Hook:** US Size 7 (4.5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

### GAUGE

6 V-st = 4" wide

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### PATTERN NOTES

There is nothing quite as calming as relaxing on the sandy shore of a lake and listening to the water hitting the shore. It's even better on cool mornings with a shawl wrapped over your shoulders to add a touch of warmth and comfort. These are the feelings that inspired Sandbar – an exquisite shawl crocheted in organic Cottonwood.

Sandbar begins in the center with a decorative circular motif that is squared off. The wings are crocheted outward from two sides of the squared motif and a picot border is applied to the lower edges of the shawl.

### STITCH GUIDE

**V-st:** [dc, ch 1, dc]

**Beg V-st:** [Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), dc]

**Picot:** Ch 3, sl st in first ch

### SHAWL

#### Center

With A, ch 6, join with sl st to form ring.



*Note: At every color change, fasten off the old color and work the first stitch of the new color as a standing stitch.*

**Rnd 1:** With A, ch 1, work 18 sc into ring, join with sl st to beg sc.

**Rnd 2:** With A, [sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next 2 sc] around, join with sl st to beg sc – 6 sts inc'd, 24 sc.

**Rnd 3:** With B, beginning in any sc, beg V-st, sk next sc, [V-st in next sc, sk next sc] around, join with sl st to third ch of beg ch-4 – 36 sts, 12 V-st.

**Rnd 4:** With B, ch 1, [sc in next dc, 2 sc in ch-1 sp, sc in next dc] around, join with sl st to beg sc – 12 sts inc'd, 48 sc.

**Rnd 5:** With A, beginning in any sc, working in blo, [sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc] around, join with sl st to beg sc – 6 sts inc'd, 54 sc.

**Rnd 6:** With A, ch 1, [sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc] around, join with sl st to beg sc – 6 sts inc'd, 60 sc.

**Rnd 7:** With C, beginning in any sc, beg V-st in same st, sk next sc, V-st in next sc, sk next 2 sc, [V-st in next sc, sk next sc, V-st in next sc, sk next 2 sc] around, join with sl st to third ch of beg ch-4 – 72 sts, 24 V-st.

**Rnd 8:** With C, ch 1, [sc in next dc, sc in ch-1 sp, sc in next dc, 2 sc in ch-1 sp, sc in next dc] around, join with sl st to beg sc – 12 sts inc'd, 84 sc.

**Rnd 9:** With A, beg in any sc, working in blo, [sc in next 13 sc, 2 sc in next sc] around, join with sl st to beg sc – 6 sts inc'd, 90 sc.

**Rnd 10:** With A, ch 1, [sc in next 14 sc, 2 sc in next sc] around, join with sl st to beg sc – 6 sts inc'd, 96 sc.

**Rnd 11:** With B, beg in any sc, beg V-st in same sp, sk 1 sc, [V st in next sc, sk 2 sc] 2 times, {V-st in next sc, sk 1 sc, [V-st in next sc, sk 2 sc] 2 times} around, join with sl st to beg V-st –

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108 sts, 36 V-st.

**Rnd 12:** Sc in each st and sp around.

Fasten off. 108 sc.

**Rnd 13:** With A, beg in any sc, working in blo, [sc in next 17 sc, 2 sc in next sc] around, join with sl st to beg sc – 6 sts inc'd, 114 sc.**Rnd 14:** With A, ch 1, [sc in next 18 sc, 2 sc in next sc] around, join with sl st to beg sc – 6 sts inc'd, 120 sc.**Rnd 15:** With C, beginning in any sc, beg V-st in next st, sk 2 sc, V-st in next sc, sk 1 sc, [V-st in next sc, sk 2 sc] 5 times, {V-st in next sc, sk 2 sc, V st in next sc, sk 1 sc, [V-st in next sc, sk 2 sc] 5 times} around, join with sl st to beg V-st – 126 sts, 42 V-st.**Rnd 16:** With C, sl st in next sp, ch 1, [sc in next 20 sts, 2 sc in next st] 6 times, join with sl st to beg sc – 6 sts inc'd, 132 sts.**Rnd 17:** With A, beg in any sc, working in blo, [sc in next 10 sts, 2 sc in next st] 6 times, join with sl st to beg sc – 12 sts inc'd, 144 sts.**Rnd 18:** With A, ch 1, [sc in next 23 sts, 2 sc in next st] 6 times, join with sl st to beg sc – 6 sts inc'd, 150 sts.**Rnd 19:** With B, beginning in any sc, beg V-st in next st, [sk 2 sc, V-st in next sc] 2 times, sk 1 sc, V-st in next sc, [sk 2 sc, V-st in next sc] 3 times, sk 1 sc, V-st in next sc, sk 2 sc, V-st in next sc, sk 2 sc, [V-st in next st, [sk 2 sc, V-st in next sc] 2 times, sk 1 sc, V-st in next sc, [sk 2 sc, V-st in next sc] 3 times, sk 1 sc, V-st in next sc, sk 2 sc, V-st in next sc, sk 2 sc] around, join with sl st to beg V-st – 162 sts, 54 V-st.**Rnd 20:** With B, [sc in next 26 sts, 2 sc in next st] 8 times, join with sl st to beg sc – 6 sts inc'd, 168 sts.**Squaring Off****Rnd 21:** With A, beg in any sc, working in blo, {[sc, ch 2, sc] in sc, sc in next 41 sc} 4 times, join with sl st to beg sc – 43 sc along each side, 4 ch-2 corner sps.**Rnd 22:** With A, sl st into corner sp,

ch 4 (counts as tr), [1 tr, 2 dtr, ch 3, 2 dtr, 2 tr] in ch-2 sp, skip 3 sts, 3 tr, 3 dc, 4 hdc, 17 sc, 4 hdc, 3 dc, 3 tr, sk 3 sts {[2 tr, 2 dtr, ch 3, 2 dtr, 2 tr] in ch-2 sp, skip 3 sts, 3 tr, 3 dc, 4 hdc, 17 sc, 4 hdc, 3 dc, 3 tr, sk 3 sts} 3 times, join with sl st to top of beg ch-4 – 45 sts along each side, 4 ch-3 corner sps.

**Rnd 23:** With A, sl st into corner sp, [beg V-st, 2 V-st] in corner sp, sk 1 st, [V-st in next st, sk 2 sts] 14 times, V-st in next st, {[3 V-st in corner sp, sk 1 st, [V-st in next st, sk 2 sts] 14 times, V-st in next st } 3 times, join with sl st to top of beg V-st – 17 V-st along each side, 4 V-st corners.**Rnd 24:** With A, sl st into corner sp, {[sc, ch 2, sc] in corner, sc in each st and sp to corner} 4 times, join with sl st to beg sc – 53 sc along each side, 4 ch-2 corner sps.**Rnd 25:** With A, sl st into corner sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), [ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc] in same sp, sk next 3 sc, [V-st in next sc, sk next 2 sc] to 4 sc bef corner, V-st in next sc, sk next 3 sc, {[dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc] in corner, sk next 3 sc, [V-st in next sc, sk next 2 sc] to 4 sc bef corner, V-st in next sc, sk next 3 sc} 3 times, join with sl st to top of beg ch-3 – 17 V-st along each side, 4 ch-1 corners.**Rnd 26:** Rep Rnd 24 – 57 sc along each side, 4 ch-2 corner sps.**Rnd 27:** With A, sl st into corner sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), [ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc] in same sp, sk next 2 sc, [V-st in next sc, sk next 2 sc] to 4 sc bef corner, V-st in next sc, sk next 2 sc, {[dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc] in corner, sk next 2 sc, [V-st in next sc, sk next 2 sc] to 4 sc bef corner, V-st in next sc, sk next 2 sc} 3 times, join with sl st to top of beg ch-3 – 19 V-st along each side, 4 ch-2 corner sps.**Rnd 28:** Rep Rnd 24 – 65 sts along each side, 4 ch-2 corner sps.**First Wing**

Sl st into ch-2 corner sp. Turn.

**Set-up row (WS):** Ch 3 (counts as dc), sk next sc, [V-st in next sc, sk next 2 sc] to last 2 sc bef ch-2 corner sp, V-st in next sc, sk next sc, dc in ch-2 sp, turn – 65 total sts and sps; 21 V-st, 2 dc.**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in each st and sp to end, turn – 1 st dec'd, 64 sc rem.**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), sk next sc, [V-st in next sc, sk next 2 sc] to last 2sc, dc in last 2 sc, turn – 1 st dec'd, 63 total sts and sps rem, 20 V-st, 3 dc.**Row 3:** Rep Row 1 – 1 st dec'd, 62 sc rem.**Row 4:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), sk next sc, [V-st in next sc, sk next 2 sc] to last 3 sc, V-st in next sc, sk next sc, dc in last sc, turn – 20 V-st, 2 dc.**Rows 5-80:** Rep Rows 1-4, 19 more times – 5 sts rem; 1 V-st, 2 dc.**Row 81:** Ch 1, sc3tog, sc in last 2 sts, turn – 3 sc rem.**Row 82:** Ch 3, dc2tog. Fasten off.**Second Wing**

Join A to same corner as the last dc of Set-up Row from First Wing was worked into. This will be the corner that is 90 degrees clockwise from the start of rnd.

**Set-up row (WS):** Ch 3 (counts as dc), sk next sc, [V-st in next sc, sk next 2 sc] to last 2 sc bef ch-2 corner sp, V-st in next sc, sk next sc, dc in ch-2 sp, turn – 65 total sts and sps; 21 V-st, 2 dc.**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 1 (counts as sc), sc in each st to last 2 sts, sc2tog, turn – 1 st dec'd, 64 sc rem.**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next dc, [sk next 2 sc, V-st in next sc] to last 2 sc, sc in next sc, dc in last sc, turn – 1 st dec'd, 63 total sts and sps rem, 20 V-st, 3 dc.**Row 3:** Rep Row 1 – 1 st dec'd, 62 sts rem.**Row 4:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), sk next sc, [V-st in next sc, sk next 2 sc] to last 3 sc, V-st in next sc, sk next sc, dc in last sc, turn – 20 V-st, 2 dc.**Rows 5-80:** Rep Rows 1-4, 19 more



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times – 5 sts rem; 1 V-st, 2 dc.

**Row 81:** Ch 1, sc in first 2 sts, sc3tog, turn – 3 sc rem.

**Row 82:** Ch 3, dc2tog. Fasten off.

## Edging

With RS facing, Join A with sl st to corner sp indicated in diagram. This will be the same corner sp at the end of Second Wing set-up row.

*Note 1:* Work sc at a rate of 2 sc for each dc row and 1 sc for each sc row.

*Note 2:* Rnd 1 of Edging is worked around the entire perimeter of the shawl except for the still unworked two sides of final Rnd 28 of Center.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, sc evenly along straight edge of Second Wing, 3 sc in final dc2tog from top of Second Wing, sc evenly along shaped edge of Second Wing, 1 sc in same ch-2 corner sp that both Wings share, sc evenly along shaped edge of First Wing, 3 sc in final dc2tog from top of First Wing,

sc evenly along straight edge of First Wing. Fasten off.

## Border

With RS facing, join C with sl st to first sc from tip of First Wing.

**Row 1 (RS):** Beg V-st in same sc, [sk 2 sc, V-st in next sc] to 2 sts bef ch-2 corner sp from Rnd 28 of Center, sk next 2 sc, 3 V-st in ch-2 corner, [sk 2 sc, V-st in next sc] to 3 sts bef tip of Second Wing, sk 2 sc, V-st in next sc, turn – 65 V-st along each side, 1 V-st in corner.

**Row 2 (WS):** Ch 1, sc in each st and sp to ch-1 of corner V-st, ch 2, sk ch-1 sp, sc in each st and sp to end, turn.

**Row 3:** Sl st in next sc, beg-V-st in same sc, [sk 2 sc, V-st in next sc] to 2 sts bef ch-2 corner sp, sk next 2 sc, 3 V-st in ch-2 corner, [sk 2 sc, V-st in next sc] to last 4 sc, sk 2 sc, V-st in next sc, turn – 66 V-st along each side, 1 V-st corner.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in next ch-1 sp, sc in each st and sp to ch-1 of corner V-st,

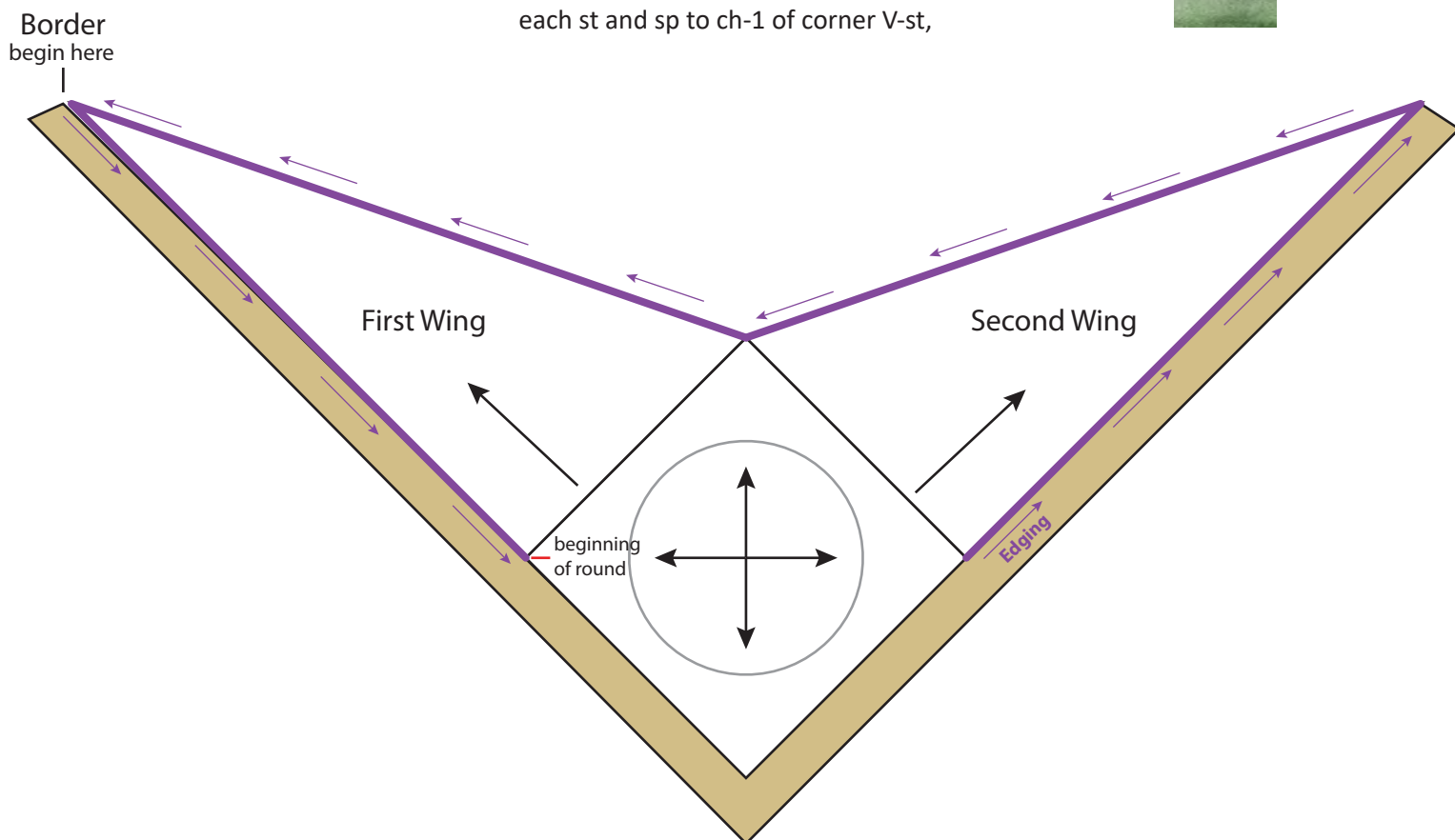
3 sc in ch-1 sp, sc in each st and sp to last ch-1 sp, sc in last ch-1 sp, turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, [sc in sc, hdc in sc, dc in sc, tr in sc, Picot, sk sc, tr in sc, dc in sc, hdc in sc, sc in sc] 22 times, sc in same sc as last sc made, [hdc, dc] in next sc, [tr, Picot, tr] in next (corner sc), [dc, hdc] in next sc, sc in next sc, sc in same sc as last sc worked, hdc in sc, dc in sc, tr in sc, Picot, sk sc, tr in sc, dc in sc, hdc in sc, sc in sc, [sc in sc, hdc in sc, dc in sc, tr in sc, Picot, sk sc, tr in sc, dc in sc, hdc in sc, sc in sc] 21 times.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

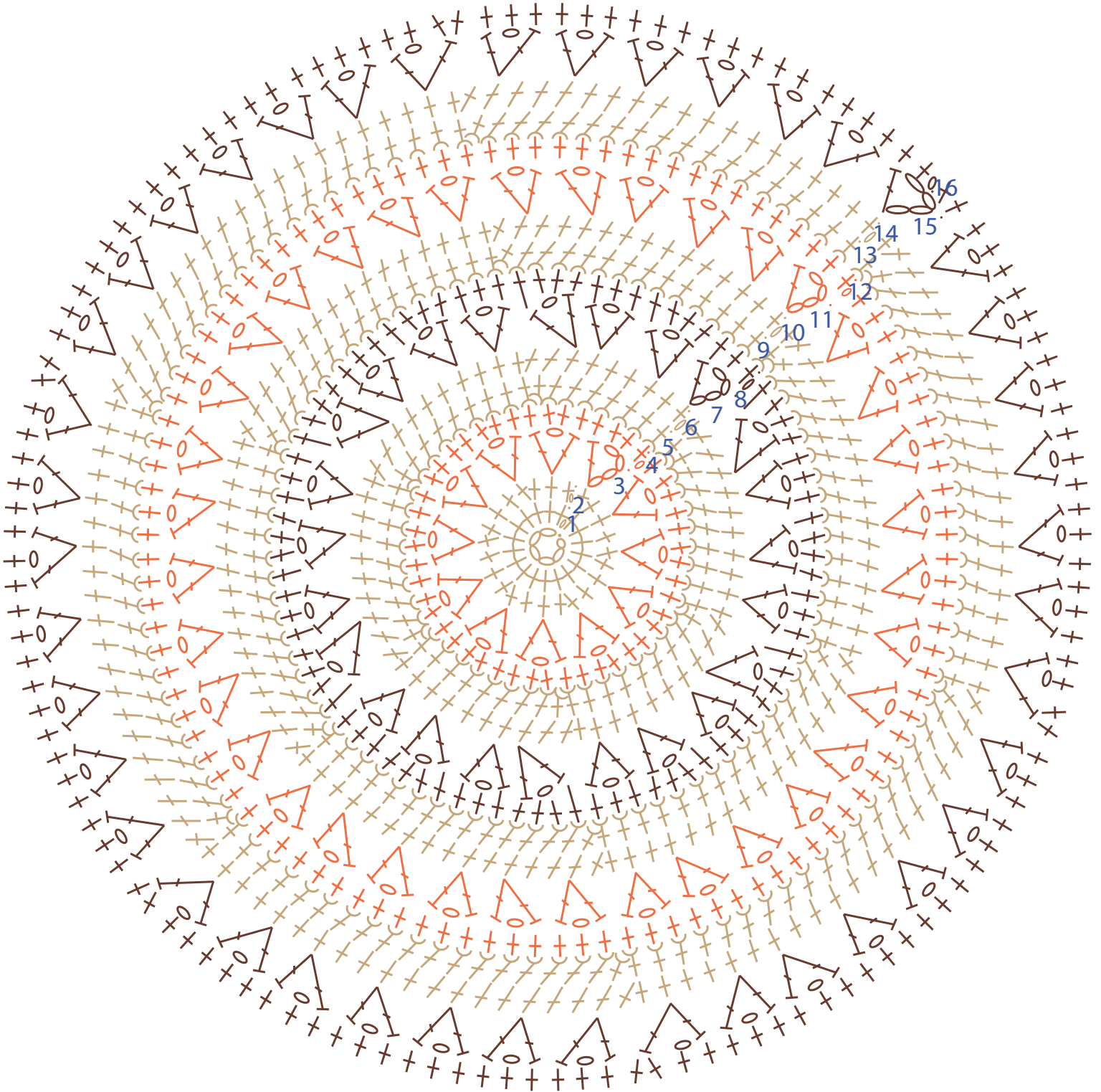
Weave in ends. Run blocking wires along straight edges of shawl and through Picots in Row 5 of Border. Wet or steam block. Pin blocking wires to blocking board, stretching to enhance lace.

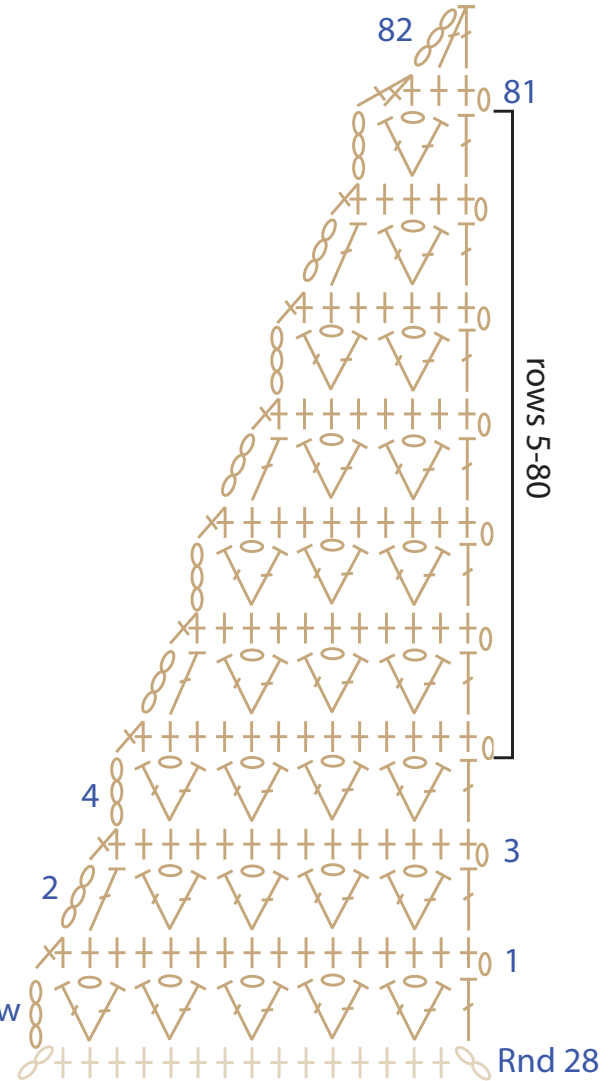


First Wing
