SIZES

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 74" Width: 26"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Cotton Supreme Batik* (100% cotton)

• 50 Beachy Peachy (A) – 2 skeins **Fibra Natura** *Whisper Lace* (70% superwash wool, 30% silk; 50g/440 yds)

• 103 Harbor (B)—1 skein **Needles:** US Size 10½ (6.5 mm) 32" circular *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

12 sts x 20 rows = 4" in Drop Stitch Stripe patt

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

Scruncher Scarf gets its name because the size of it can be very deceiving. The finished scarf is large like a wrap. But due to the openness of the fabric, it can be easily "scrunched" and worn as a scarf.

There are two weights of yarn used in this pattern. Cotton Supreme Batik is a worsted weight yarn, while Whisper lace is a fingering weight. The same size needle is used throughout the project.

The colors shown in the second (pink and gray) version are Cotton Supreme Batik #49 Anemone and Whisper Lace #111 Ebony.

STITCH GUIDE

Drop Stitch Stripes

(any number of sts)

Row 1 (RS): With A, * k1, wrapping yarn 2 times

around needle; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS): With B, purl, dropping the extra

wrap from each st from Row 1.

Row 3 (RS): With B, purl. Row 4 (WS): With B, knit. Row 5 (RS): With B, purl.

Row 6 (WS): * With A, * p1, wrapping yarn 2 times around needle; rep from * to end. Slide sts

to other end of ndl.

Row 7 (WS): With B, purl, dropping the extra

wrap from each st from Row 1.

Row 8 (RS): With B, purl. Row 9 (WS): With B, knit.

Row 10 (RS): With B, purl. Slide sts to other end

of ndl.

Rep Rows 1-10 for patt.

SCARF

With A, cast on 78 sts. Work Rows 2-10 of Drop Stitch Stripes patt, then rep Rows 1-10 of patt until piece meas 74", ending with Row 5 or 9 of patt. With A, bind off all sts very loosely.

FINISHING


Weave in ends and block.

Abbreviations

k knit
meas
p purl
patt pattern
rep repeat
RS right side
st(s) stitch(es)
WS wrong side



Drop Stitch Stripes



Key

- knit on RS, purl on WS
- purl on RS, knit on WS
- k1 wrapping yarn 2 times on RS, p1 wrapping yarn 2 times on WS
 - pattern repeat
