FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Scarflette: Length: 49½"

Width at Center: 434"

Beret:

Brim Circumference: 19½" Stretches up to 23"

#### **MATERIALS**

<u>Universal Yarn Uni Merino Neons</u> (75% superwash merino wool, 25% nylon; 100g/437 yds)

• 152 Neon Pink (A) - 1 skein <u>Rico Design Essentials Super Kid Mohair</u> <u>Loves Silk</u> (70% mohair, 30% silk; 25g/218 yds)

• 065 Neon Pink (B) – 2 balls Needles: US Size 6 (4 mm) straight, 16" circular, and set of DPNs (or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences)

US Size 5 (3.75 mm) 16" circular

**Notions**: Tapestry needle, stitch markers (one unique marker to denote bor), removable marker (optional)

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

#### **GAUGE**

21 sts x 34 rows/rnds = 4" in Seed stitch with larger ndl after blocking
Save time, check your gauge.

#### PATTERN NOTES

The Seeded Scarflette and Beret is a chic accessory set that makes a bold statement in bright colors. Effortless seed stitch and simple shaping are paired to bring each piece together. The scarflette features pointed ends, making it adorable for tying around your neck. Spiral crown decreases and an I-Cord loop completes the beret. Both accessories are worked holding a strand of airy, fluffy Rico Design Essentials Super Kid Mohair Loves Silk and a strand of our Uni Merino Neons yarn together – a match made in heaven!

The scarflette is knit flat from point to point. It begins with gradual increases, is worked even at the center, and ends with gradual decreases. You may wish to place a removable marker on the RS to help you stay on track.

The beret is knit in the round from the bottom up. The brim is worked in Half Twisted Rib and the rest of the hat is worked in Seed stitch. The spiral crown is finished with an I-Cord for a classic look.

#### I-Cord

Begin with 3 sts on ndl. \* K3, slide sts to other end of ndl and place in left hand; rep from \* until I-Cord meas desired length.

#### STITCH GUIDE

Seed

(odd number of sts, worked flat)

Row 1 (RS): \* K1, p1; rep from \* to last st, k1.

Row 2 (WS): Rep Row 1. Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

#### Seed

(even number of sts, worked in the rnd)

**Rnd 1**: \* K1, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rnd 2: \* P1, k1; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnds 1-2 for patt.

#### Half Twisted Rib

(even number of sts, worked in the rnd) Rnd 1: \* K1 tbl, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.



# PATTERN BEGINS SCARFLETTE

#### Increase Section

With larger ndl and holding a strand of yarns A and B together as one, cast on 3 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, p1, k1.

Row 2 (WS): Rep Row 1.

Row 3: K1, m1, p1, m1, k1 - 2 sts inc'd, 5 sts.

Rows 4-8: K2, p1, k2.

Row 9: K1, m1P, k1, p1, k1, m1P, k1 - 2 sts inc'd, 7 sts.

Rows 10-14: \* K1, p1; rep from \* to last st, k1.

Row 15: K1, m1, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, p1, m1, k1 - 2 sts inc'd, 9 sts.

Rows 16-20: K2, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to last st, k1.

Row 21: K1, m1P, \* k1, p1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k1, m1P, k1, 2 sts ino'd, 11 sts

m1P, k1 - 2 sts inc'd, 11 sts.

Rows 22-26: \* K1, p1; rep from \* to last st, k1.

Rows 27-62: Rep Rows 15-26, 3 more times - 12

sts inc'd, 23 sts.

Row 63: K1, m1, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, p1, m1, k1 - 2 sts inc'd, 25 sts.

Row 64: K2, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to last st, k1.

#### **Even Section**

Row 1 (RS): K2, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to last st, k1. Row 2 (WS): K2, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to last st, k1. Rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas approx. 42" from cast-on edge, ending with Row 2 of patt.

#### **Decrease Section**

Row 1 (RS): K2tog, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to last 3 sts, p1, ssk - 2 sts dec'd, 23 sts rem.

Rows 2-6: \* K1, p1; rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Row 7**: K2tog, \* k1, p1; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k1, ssk - 2 sts dec'd, 21 sts rem.

Rows 8-12: K2, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to last st, k1.

Rows 13-48: Rep Rows 1-12, 3 more times – 12 sts dec'd. 9 sts rem.

Row 49: K2tog, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to last 3 sts, p1, ssk - 2 sts dec'd, 7 sts rem.

Rows 50-54: \* K1, p1; rep from \* to last st, k1. Row 55: K2tog, k1, p1, k1, ssk - 2 sts dec'd, 5 sts

Rows 56-60: K2, p1, k2.

Row 61: K2tog, p1, ssk - 2 sts dec'd, 3 sts rem.

**Rows 62-64:** K1, p1, k1. Bind off rem 3 sts.

#### **FINISHING**

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

#### **BERET**

#### Brim

Note: We recommend using a unique marker to denote the bor.

With smaller 16" circ ndl and holding a strand of yarns A and B together as one, cast on 92 sts.

Work in Half Twisted Rib for 11/4".

Inc Rnd: \* K2, m1; rep from \* to end - 46 sts inc'd,

138 sts.

Change to larger 16" circ ndl.

#### Main Hat

Work in Seed patt until piece meas approx. 3" from end of Brim, or 4%" from cast-on edge.

#### Shape Crown

Note: Change to DPNs or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences when there are too few sts to fit comfortably on 16" circ.

Set-up Rnd: Cont as est'd over 23 sts, pm; rep from \* to end - 5 markers placed across rnd (6 total including bor marker).

Rnd 1 (Dec Rnd): \* Cont in Seed patt as est'd to 2 sts bef m, k2tog, sl m; rep from \* to end - 6 sts dec'd, 132 sts rem.

Rnd 2 (Even Rnd): \* Cont in Seed patt as est'd to 1 st bef m, k1, sl m; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnds 1-2, 20 more times – 120 sts dec'd, 12 sts rem

Next Rnd: \* K2tog; rep from \* to end - 6 sts dec'd, 6 sts rem. Note: Remove markers as you come to them.

Next Rnd: \* K2tog; rep from \* to end - 3 sts rem.

Do not break yarn.

With rem 3 sts, work an I-Cord for approx. 1½". Break yarn leaving approx. 10" tail. Thread tail through rem I-Cord sts. Pull taut to close. Bring tail to the inside of the hat to create a loop in the I-cord. Secure loop by weaving in end of tail on inside of hat.

#### **FINISHING**

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.
