## DIFFICULTY

Easy

#### **SIZES**

One Size

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 8" Length: 7% "

#### **MATERIALS**

<u>Universal Yarn Cotton Supreme</u> (100% cotton; 100g/180 yds)

- 612 Emerald (MC) 1 ball
- 502 White (CC) 1 ball

Hook: US Size H/8 (5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

#### GAUGE

16 sts x 19 rows = 4" in Single Crochet

Save time, check your gauge.

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

A quick project is just what you need for a fun holiday! The Shamrock Dishcloths are a bold and cheerful crochet pattern using two colors of durable and soft Cotton Supreme. Work one up for yourself and another for a friend, and may every petal on the shamrock bring you joy and good luck.

The yarn amounts listed are enough to make one of each cloth with inverted colors. These cloths are made using intarsia colorwork, with some stranded colorwork in the center of the clover. To prep for intarsia, create a mini ball of approximately 4 yards for each color. Then divide the remaining yarn into two equal balls for each color.

When working Row 1 of the chart, you will place your first single crochet in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook.

#### STITCH GUIDE

#### **Changing Colors**

Work until 2 lps remain on hk, yo with new color and pull through the last 2 lps to complete the stitch.

#### CLOTH 1

#### Washcloth

Note: Join CC as indicated in chart.

With MC, ch 32.

Rows 1-33: Work Rows 1-33 of Clover Colorwork Chart in sc.

Do not Fasten Off.

#### Border

Ch 1, \* sc in each st evenly along the side of the cloth, 3 sc in corner; rep from \* 3 more times stopping at the last corner. Do not Fasten Off.

#### Loop

Ch 15, sl st to base of the last st made from the Border, turn.

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in each ch, sl st to top of last st made from the Border. Fasten Off.

#### CLOTH 2

Follow instructions for Cloth 1, switching the MC and CC colors throughout.

#### **FINISHING**

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

#### **Abbreviations**

CC contrast color


