# **Sideways Sweater**

Designed by Universal Yarn Design Team

#### **SIZES**

Small (Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, 3X)
Shown in Small size modeled with 1" of ease in the bust

# **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Bust: 34 (38, 42, 46, 50, 54)"

#### **MATERIALS**

**Universal Yarn** *Classic Shades Frenzy* (70% acrylic, 30% wool; 100g/158 yds)

• 911 Stranded – 5 (6, 7, 7, 8, 9) balls

**Needles:** US Size 10 (6 mm) straight *or size needed to obtain gauge*US Size 9 (5.5 mm) straight, 16" circular

(for neck edging)

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

# **GAUGE**

12 sts x 18 rows = 4" in St st using larger ndl

15 sts x 20 rows = 4" in Slipped Ribbing patt using larger ndl

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

This A line sweater is worked in pieces and seamed. Front, Back, and Sleeves are worked sideways. The hems and cuffs are worked by picking up stitches from the sides of the main pieces and then knit downward.

#### **STITCH GUIDE**

# **Slipped Ribbing**

(odd number of sts)

Row 1 (RS): K1, \* p1, sl 1 pwise wyib; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k1.

Row 2 (WS): \* P1, k1; rep from \* to last st, p1. Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

#### **I-Cord Bind-Off**

Cast on 3 sts to first st on left ndl using knitted cast-on. \* K2, k2tog tbl (1 st bound-off), slip these 3 sts back to left ndl; rep from \* until all sts have been bound-off. Bind off rem 3 I-Cord sts.

#### **FRONT**

With larger ndl, cast on 7 sts (all sizes).

**Shape Hip** 

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 (WS): Cast on 7 sts, purl to end – 14 sts.

Row 3: Knit.

**Rows 4-11:** Rep Rows 2-3, 4 more times – 42 sts.

**Row 12:** Cast on 22 (24, 26, 27, 28, 29) sts – 64 (66, 69, 60, 70, 71) sts

(66, 68, 69, 70, 71) sts.

Work even in St st until piece meas 4 (5, 6, 6¾, 7¾, 8¾)" from last cast-on row, ending with WS row.

**Shape Neck** 

**Dec row (RS):** Knit to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 - 1 st dec'd.

**Dec row (WS):** P1, ssp, purl to end – 1 st dec'd.

Cont to dec every row, 18 (18, 18, 20, 20, 20) more

times - 44 (46, 48, 47, 48, 49) sts rem.

Inc row (RS): Knit to last st, m1, k1 - 1 st inc'd.

Inc row (WS): P1, m1p, purl to end – 1 st inc'd.

Cont to inc every row, 18 (18, 18, 20, 20, 20) more

times – 64 (66, 68, 69, 70, 71) sts.

Work even in St st until piece meas 4 (5, 6, 6¾, 7¾, 8¾)" from last Inc row, ending with RS row.

**Shape Hip** 

Row 1 (WS): Bind off 22 (24, 26, 27, 28, 29) sts,

purl to end – 42 sts rem.

Row 2 (RS): Knit.

Row 3 (WS): Bind off 7 sts, purl to end – 35 sts rem.

Row 4 (RS): Knit.

**Rows 5-12:** Rep Rows 3-4, 4 more times – 7 sts rem. Bind off rem sts.

#### Hem

With RS facing and smaller ndl, pick up and knit 71 (79, 87, 93, 101, 109) sts evenly along short end of Sleeve. Knit 3 rows. With larger ndl, bind off all sts over the next RS row, do not fasten off. With last loop on ndl, pick up and purl 70 (78, 86, 92, 100, 108) sts along bind-off edge, working behind sts so that bind-off edge creates a ridge on the RS of the work – 71 (79, 87, 93, 101, 109) sts. Rep Rows 1-2 of Slipped Ribbing patt until Cuff meas 4" from first pick-up edge, ending with WS row. Bind off all sts using I-Cord Bind-off.

#### **BACK**

With larger ndl, cast on 7 sts (all sizes).

**Shape Hip** 

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 (WS): Cast on 7 sts, purl to end – 14 sts.

Row 3: Knit.

**Rows 4-11:** Rep Rows 2-3, 4 more times – 42 sts.

**Row 12:** Cast on 22 (24, 26, 27, 28, 29) sts – 64 (66, 68, 69, 70, 71) sts.

Work even in St st until piece meas 4 (5, 6, 6%, 7%, 8%)" from last cast-on row, ending with WS row.

## **Shape Neck**

**Dec row 1(RS):** Knit to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 - 1 st dec'd.

**Dec row 2(WS):** P1, ssp, purl to end -1 st dec'd.

**Dec row 3:** Rep Row 1 - 61 (63, 65, 66, 67, 68) sts rem. Work even in St st until piece meas  $7\frac{1}{2}$  ( $7\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $7\frac{1}{2}$ , 8, 8, 8)" from last Dec row, ending with RS row.

Inc row 1 (WS): P1, m1p, purl to end – 1 st inc'd.

Inc row 2 (RS): Knit to last st, m1, k1 – 1 st inc'd.

Inc row 3: Rep Row 1 – 64 (66, 68, 69, 70, 71) sts. Work even in St st until piece meas 4 (5, 6, 6¾, 7¾, 8¾)" from last Inc row, ending with RS row.

# Shape Hip

**Row 1 (WS):** Bind off 22 (24, 26, 27, 28, 29) sts, purl to end – 42 sts rem.

Row 2 (RS): Knit.

Row 3 (WS): Bind off 7 sts, purl to end – 35 sts rem.

Row 4 (RS): Knit.

**Rows 5-12:** Rep Rows 3-4, 4 more times – 7 sts rem. Bind off rem sts.

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#### **SLEEVES**

With larger ndl, cast on 4 (4, 3, 3, 3, 3) sts.

# **Increase Section**

Row 1 (RS): Knit. Row 2 (WS): Purl.

Cast on 4 (4, 3, 3, 3, 3) sts at beg of next 1 (6, 1, 5, 5, 9) RS row(s), then cast on 5 (5, 4, 4, 4, 4) sts at beg of next 6 (2, 8, 5, 5, 2) RS rows – 38 sts, all sizes. Work even in St st for 8 (8, 8½, 8½, 9, 9)" more, ending with WS row.

#### **Decrease Section**

Bind off 5 (5, 4, 4, 4, 4) sts at beg of next 6 (2, 8, 5, 5, 2) RS rows, then bind off 4 (4, 3, 3, 3, 3) sts at beg of next 1 (6, 1, 5, 5, 9) RS row(s). Bind off rem sts.

# Cuff

With RS facing and smaller ndl, pick up and knit 29 (29, 31, 31, 33, 33) sts evenly along short end of Sleeve. Knit 3 rows. With larger ndl, bind off all sts over the next RS row, do not fasten off. With last loop on ndl, pick up and purl 28 (28, 30, 30, 32, 32) sts along bind-off edge, working behind sts so that bind-off edge creates a ridge on the RS of the work – 29 (29, 31, 31, 33, 33) sts. Rep Rows 1-2 of Slipped Ribbing patt until Cuff meas 5" from first pick-up edge, ending with WS row. Bind off all sts using I-Cord Bind-off.

## **FINISHING**

Block pieces to finished measurements. Sew Shoulder seams. Sew Sleeves to body. Sew Sleeve and side seams.

#### **Neck Edging**

With smaller circ ndl, pick up and knit 27 (27, 27, 29, 29, 29) sts along Back Neck, 28 (28, 28, 30, 30, 30) sts along Left Front Neck, and 28 (28, 28, 30, 30, 30) sts along Right Front Neck. PM and join to work in the rnd. Purl 1 rnd. Bind off all sts using I-Cord Bind-off.

Weave in ends.

under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, purl this st through the front loop (1

st inc'd)

meas measures
ndl needle

**pm** place marker

**p2tog** purl 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

pwise
rem remain(ing)
rep repeat
rnd round
RS right side

ssk slip next 2 sts individually knitwise,

slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through

the back loops (1 st dec'd)

ssp slip next 2 sts individually knitwise,

slip them back to left needle in this position, purl them together through

the back loops (1 st dec'd)




