



## Pattern Collection: Accessories

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

12½" wide x 42" long

### MATERIALS

- **Fibra Natura Radiant Cotton**  
(100% Egyptian cotton 100g/203 yds) #801 Crocus – 3 balls

**Hook:** US Size H-8 (5 mm) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, 2 – 1" buttons

### GAUGE

2 reps of V-Stitch Mesh patt = 2½" wide;  
9 rows = 4" tall

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### PATTERN NOTES

This versatile capelet can be worn a variety of ways. Fasten the buttons in different spots to create a cowl or wrap, or alter the number and style of buttons for a colorful accent!

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## STITCH GUIDE

### V-Stitch Mesh

*(begins with multiple of 8 chs + 5)*

**Row 1:** [Dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] in 9<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, ch 1, sk next 3 chs, dc in next ch, \* ch 1, [sk next 3 chs, [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] in next ch, sk next 3 chs, ch 1, dc in next ch; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), sk 2 dcs, [dc, ch 3, dc] in ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk 2 dcs, dc in next dc, ch 1, \* sk 2 dcs, [dc, ch 3, dc] in ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk 2 dcs rep from \* to end, dc in second ch after last dc.

**Row 3:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), \* [dc 2, ch 1, dc 2] in ch-3 sp, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1; rep from \* to last ch-3 sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4.

**Row 4:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), sk 2 dcs, [dc, ch 3, dc] in ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk 2 dcs, dc in next dc, ch 1, \* sk 2 dcs, [dc, ch 3, dc] in ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk 2 dcs rep from \* to end, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4.

Rep Rows 3 and 4 for patt.

### Picot Edging

*(multiple of 4 sts + 1)*

**Row 1:** Ch 3, \*dc in ch-1 sp, dc in dc, dc 2 in ch-3 sp, dc in dc, dc in ch-1 sp, dc in dc; rep from \* to last dc, dc in ch-4 sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4.

**Row 2:** Ch 3, dc in first dc, \* sk next dc, dc in next dc, sk next dc, dc 3 in next dc; rep from \* to last 4 dcs, sk next dc, dc in next dc, sk next dc, dc 2 in last dc.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, sk 2 dcs, [dc 2, ch 3, sl st in first ch, dc] in next dc, \* ch 1, sk next 3 dcs, [dc 2, ch 3, sl st in first ch, dc] in next dc; rep from \* to last dc, dc in top of beg ch-3.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in first dc, ch 6, \* sc in ch-1 sp, ch 6; rep from \* to end, sc in top of beg ch-3.

## WRAP

With A, ch 245.

Work V-Stitch Mesh patt until piece meas 10<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>", ending with Row 4 of patt.

Work Picot Edging.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Try on your wrap and mark position for buttons along one short edge of wrap. Sew buttons in place.

<b>beg</b>	beginning
<b>ch</b>	chain
<b>dc</b>	double crochet
<b>meas</b>	measures
<b>patt</b>	pattern
<b>sc</b>	single crochet
<b>sk</b>	skip
<b>sl st</b>	slip stitch
<b>sp</b>	space
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)



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
