## SKILL

Knitting

### DIFFICULTY

Intermediate

#### SIZES

One Size

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 56½" Length: 11½"

#### **MATERIALS**

<u>Universal Yarn Offbeat</u> (90% acrylic, 10% alpaca; 150g/586 yds)

• 104 Vibes – 1 skein

Needle: US Size 6 (4 mm) 40" circular or longer (to accommodate large number of sts) or size needed to obtain gauge Notions: stitch markers, cable needle

(cn), tapestry needle

#### **GAUGE**

21 sts x 28 rows = 4" in Cable and Lace patt (after blocking)

Save time, check your gauge.

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

Inspired by floral blooms swaying in the breeze during springtime, the Snapdragon wrap is sure to become your next go-to accessory. Our soft and squishy Offbeat yarn gives a light and lofty feel to the piece, while the cable and lace motif worked across the wrap enhances the self-striping effect.

This wrap is knit flat from the bottom up. You may wish to place markers between pattern repeats to help you stay on track.

#### STITCH GUIDE

#### 2x2 Left Cross (LC)

Slip 2 sts to cn and hold in front, k2 from LH ndl, k2 from cn.

#### Cable and Lace

(multiple of 19 sts, plus 6)

Row 1 (RS): \* P1, k4, p4, k2tog, k1, [yo, k1] 2 times, ssk, p3; rep from \* to last 6 sts, p1, k4, p1.

Row 2 (WS): K1, p4, k1, \* k3, p7, k4, p4, k1; rep from \* to end.

Row 3: \* P1, k4, p3, k2tog, k1, yo, k3, yo, k1, ssk, p2; rep from \* to last 6 sts, p1, k4, p1.

**Row 4**: K1, p4, k1, \*k2, p9, k3, p4, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 5**: \* P1, 2x2 LC, p2, k2tog, k1, yo, k5, yo, k1, ssk, p1; rep from \* to last 6 sts, p1, 2x2 LC, p1.

Row 6: K1, p4, k1, \* k1, p11, k2, p4, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 7**: \* P1, k4, p1, k2tog, k1, yo, k7, yo, k1, ssk; rep from \* to last 6 sts, p1, k4, p1.

**Row 8**: K1, p4, k1, \* p13, k1, p4, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 9**: \* P1, k4, p5, k5, p4; rep from \* to last 6 sts, p1, k4, p1.

**Row 10**: K1, p4, k1, \* k4, p5, k5, p4, k1; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rows 1-10 for patt.

#### **PATTERN BEGINS**

#### Lower Edge

Cast on 297 sts. Knit 4 rows.

#### Main Body

Note: You may wish to place markers between pattern repeats to help you stay on track.

Row 1 (RS): K3, pm, work Row 1 of Cable and Lace patt to last 3 sts, pm, k3. Pattern will be repeated 15 times across each row.

Row 2 (WS): K3, sl m, work Row 2 of Cable and Lace patt to m, sl m, k3.

Row 3: K3, sl m, work Row 3 of Cable and Lace patt to m, sl m, k3.

Row 4: K3, sl m, work Row 4 of Cable and Lace patt to m, sl m, k3.



Cont as est'd through Row 10 of Cable and Lace patt, then rep Rows 1-10, 6 more times, then rep Rows 1-8, one more time.

#### Upper Edge

Knit 4 rows.

Bind off all sts kwise.

#### **FINISHING**

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.


knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops
