



Pattern Collection: Accessories



Sparkle Windows Scarf (woven)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 20"

Length: 60" (without fringe)

BEGINNING DIMENSIONS

Width on Loom: 24" width

Warp Length: 100" allows 20" each end for waste and fringe

SETT

10 epi

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Universe (41% cotton, 42% linen, 8% polyamide, 9% glitter; 50g/246 yds)

- Warp and Weft: 10-07 Woolen – 7 skeins

Equipment: 4 shaft loom (though rigid heddle is possible with the use of pick-up sticks for the Atwater Bronson); 10 dent reed; 1 shuttle

Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

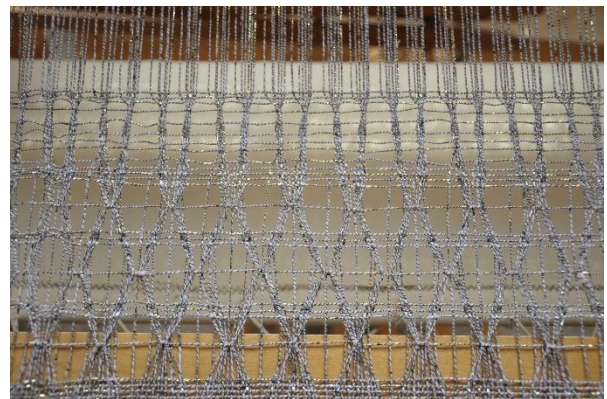
The beginning and end of this stole are worked in two variations of Brooks Lace (finger controlled weave), while the central body is worked in Atwater Bronson (a loom controlled weave).

- 1) Wind a 100" warp with 241 ends. Centering the warp in the reed at a width of 24", warp the loom following the Atwater Bronson draft.
- 2) Weave a few picks of plain weave (alternating raising shafts 1 & 2) to even out the warp length. Leave approximately 15" unwoven from tips of ends tied to front beam before beginning weaving to allow enough length for fringe.
- 3) Leaving a 60" length of working yarn, weave 8 picks of plain weave. Hemstitch, going over 2 weft ends and under 4 warp ends.
- 4) **First Brooks Lace Section (worked on an open shed):**
 - a. Raise shaft 1, thereby raising half the warp threads. Hold shaft up for this entire step. * Pass the shuttle around 6 raised warp threads 2 times, pull the group taut; rep from * across.
 - b. Weave 3 rows of plain weave.
 - c. Raise shaft 1, thereby raising half the warp threads. Hold shaft up for this entire step. Pass the shuttle around 3 raised warp threads 2 times, pull the group taut, * pass the shuttle around 6 raised warp threads 2 times, pull the group taut; rep from * across, ending by wrapping around last 3 warp threads (this row of blocks will be offset from step b.)
 - d. Weave 3 rows of plain weave.
 - e. Repeat steps a & b.



5) **Second Brooks Lace Section (worked on a closed shed):**

- a. * Pass the shuttle around 6 warp threads 2 times, pull the group taut; rep from * across.
- b. Weave 3 rows of plain weave.
- c. Repeat step a.



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- 6) **Main Stole Body:** Follow the Atwater Bronson Draft until you reach the last 25-30" of warp. Weave 3 rows of plain weave.



- 7) Repeat Step 5.
 8) Repeat Steps a-e of Step 4. Weave 8 rows of plain weave.
 9) Cut yarn leaving 60" tail. Hemstitch.
 10) Cut fabric from the loom. Trim fringe on both ends to 10". Collect ends into groups of 8, plying together for twisted fringe.

- 11) Handwash scarf and allow to air dry.
