

Pattern Collection: Children



Special Gift Jacket

Designed by Universal Yarn Design Team

SIZES

3-6 mo (1-2 yr, 4-6 yr, 6-8 yr, 8-10 yr) Shown in 1-2 yr size.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest, closed: 20½ (23, 25, 27½, 29½)" Length: 10½ (12, 15¼, 17¼, 19)"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Adore* (55% Superwash Merino, 45% Acrylic; 100g/273 yds)

• 111 Banana – 3 (3, 4, 5, 6) skeins **Hook:** US Size G-6 (4 mm) straight *or size*

needed to obtain gauge Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

7 reps x 15 rows = 4" in Scrunch Stitch

patt

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

This cardigan is worked in pieces and seamed.

STITCH GUIDE

Scrunch Stitch

(begins with multiple of $3 \cosh + 4$)

Row 1: Sc in fourth ch from hk (last ch 2 counts as hdc), {[sc, hdc, dc] in next ch, sk next 2 chs} to last ch, hdc in last ch, turn.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), {[sc, hdc, dc] in next dc, sk hdc and sc} to last ch-2, hdc in top of ch-2, turn.

Rep Row 2 for patt.

Shell Edging

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in next sp or st, 4 dc in next sp or st; rep from * around, join with sl st to beg sc.

BACK

Ch 58 (64, 70, 76, 82).

Work Row 1 of Scrunch Stitch. Patt will be repeated 18 (20, 22, 24, 26) times across row. Rep Row 2 of patt until piece meas 6½ (7½, 10, 11, 12)".

Shape Armholes

Row 1: Ch 1, sl st in hdc, dc, hdc, and sc, work Row 2 of Scrunch Stitch patt to last rep, hdc in last dc, turn – 1 rep dec'd each side.

Row 2: Rep Row 1 - 14 (16, 18, 20, 22) reps rem. Work even in patt until Armhole meas 4 (4½, 5½, 6½, 7)". Fasten off.

LEFT FRONT

Ch 52 (58, 64, 70, 76).

Work Row 1 of Scrunch Stitch. Patt will be repeated 16 (18, 20, 22, 24) times across row. Rep Row 2 of patt an even number of times until piece meas 4 (5, 7, 8, 9½)".

Shape Neck Opening

Row 1 (RS): Work Row 2 of Scrunch Stitch patt to last rep, hdc in last dc, turn – 1 rep dec'd at Neck edge.

Row 2 (WS): Work even in patt to end. Rep Rows 1-2, 9 (10, 12, 14, 15) more times. At the same time, when piece meas 6½ (7½, 10, 11, 12)", proceed to Shape Armholes section, ending with WS row.

Shape Armholes

Row 2 of Scrunch Stitch patt to last rep, hdc in last dc, turn – 1 rep dec'd at Neck edge and Armhole edge.

Row 2 (WS): Work in patt to last rep, hdc in last dc, turn – 1 rep dec'd at Armhole Edge. Armhole shaping complete. Cont to shape Left Front. After all decs are complete, 4 (5, 5, 5, 6) reps rem for Shoulder. Work even in patt, if necessary, until as many rows have been worked as for Back. Fasten off.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, sl st in hdc, dc, hdc, and sc, work

RIGHT FRONT

Work as for Left Front.

SLEEVES

Ch 46 (49, 52, 55, 58).

Work Row 1 of Scrunch Stitch. Patt will be repeated 14 (15, 16, 17, 18) times across row. Rep Row 2 of patt until piece meas 4½ (6½, 8½, 10, 11)".

Shape Cap

Row 1: Ch 1, sl st in hdc, dc, hdc, and sc, work Row 2 of Scrunch Stitch patt to last rep, hdc in last dc, turn – 1 rep dec'd each side, 12 (13, 14, 15, 16) reps rem. Dec 1 rep each side every 3 rows, 0 (0, 0, 4, 3) times, every 2 rows, 2 (4, 5, 1, 3) times, and every row 3 (1, 1, 1, 1) times – 2 (3, 2, 3, 2) reps rem. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Block pieces to finished measurements. Sew Shoulder seams. Sew Sleeve Caps into Armholes. Sew Sleeve and side seams.

Body Edging

Attach yarn with sl st to left side seam.

Work Shell Edging evenly along lower edge of Jacket, up Right Front, along Back Neck, down Left Front, and along remainder of lower edge. Fasten off.

Sleeve Edging

Attach yarn with sl st to lower edge of Sleeve seam. Work Shell Edging evenly along beg-ch edge of Sleeve. Fasten off.

Left Front Ties

Join yarn with sl st to inside of Left Front at corner where Neck Shaping begins. Make a chain 7" long. Fasten off. Close Jacket with Right Front layered underneath Left Front. Join yarn with sl st to Right Seam to correspond with Left Front tie. Make a chain 7" long. Fasten off.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

Right Front Ties

Join yarn with sl st to inside of Right Front at corner where Neck Shaping begins. Make a chain 7" long. Fasten off. Open Left front. Close Right Front. Join yarn with sl st to inside of Left Side seam to correspond with Right Front tie. Make a chain 7" long. Fasten off. Tie ties to wear. Weave in ends.






Scrunch Stitch Shaping for Front



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
