FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 33%"

Height: 12½"

MATERIALS VERSION A

<u>Universal Yarn Minou</u> (52% nylon, 40% baby alpaca, 8% merino wool; 50g/158



yds)

• 101 Borzoi (A) - 2 balls

<u>Universal Yarn Uni Merino</u> (75% superwash merino wool, 25% nylon; 100g/437 yds)

• 107 Conch (B) - 1 skein

VERSION B

<u>Universal Yarn Minou</u> (52% nylon, 40% baby alpaca, 8% merino wool; 50g/158 yds)

• 101 Borzoi (A) - 1 ball

<u>Universal Yarn Uni Merino</u> (75% superwash merino wool, 25% nylon; 100g/437 yds)

• 107 Conch (B) - 1 skein



SPECK COWL

Needles: US Size 5 (3.75 mm) 24" circular or size needed to obtain gauge
US Size 4 (3.5 mm) 24" circular

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

23 sts x 27 rnds = 4" in Speck A or B patt with larger ndl

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

When a chill hits the air, a soft knit cowl is just the thing you need. Throw it on as you head out in the morning for a cozy and stylish finishing touch to your 'outfit of the day'. Minou is an eyelash style yarn with a super-soft texture that is warm to wear and lush to look at and knit with. Paired with superwash merino wool/nylon blend Uni Merino, the Speck cowl has a simple dotted texture you can work in two different ways to create an accessory that is just perfect for you.

This cowl is knit in the round from the bottom up.

STITCH GUIDE

Speck A

(multiple of 4 sts)

Rnds 1-2: With color A, knit.

Rnds 3-4: * With color A k2, with color B k2; rep from * to end.

Rnds 5-6: With color A, knit.

Rnds 7-8: * With color B k2, with color A

k2; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnds 1-8 for patt.

Speck B

(multiple of 4 sts)

Rnds 1-2: With color B, knit.

Rnds 3-4: * With color B k2, with color A

k2; rep from * to end.

Rnds 5-6: With color B, knit.

Rnds 7-8: * With color A k2, with color B

k2; rep from * to end. Rep Rnds 1-8 for patt.

PATTERN BEGINS

COWL

VERSION A

Lower Edge

With smaller ndl and color B, cast on 192 sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

Rnd 1: Knit.

Rnd 2: Purl.

Rnds 3-4: Rep Rnds 1-2.

Change to larger ndl. Join color A, do not break color B.

Body

Work Rnds 1-8 of Speck A patt, 9 times, then rep Rnds 1-6, 1 more time. Break color A, cont with color B only. Change to smaller ndl.

Upper Edge

Work as for Lower Edge. Bind off all sts kwise.



SPECK COWL

VERSION B

Lower Edge

With smaller ndl and color A, cast on 192 sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

Rnd 1: Knit. Rnd 2: Purl.

Rnds 3-4: Rep Rnds 1-2.

Change to larger ndl. Join color B, do not break color A.

Body


Work Rnds 1-8 of Speck B patt, 9 times, then rep Rnds 1-6, 1 more time. Break color B, cont with color A only. Change to smaller ndl.


Upper Edge

Work as for Lower Edge. Bind off all sts kwise.


FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.
