



## Pattern Collection: Women



### Spring Pullover

Designed by Universal Yarn Design Team

### SIZES

Small (Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, 3X)

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Bust:** 33 (37½, 42½, 45½, 50½, 53½)''

### MATERIALS

**Universal Yarn *Bamboo Bloom***

*Handpaints* (48% rayon from bamboo, 44% wool, 8% acrylic; 100g/154 yds)

- 304 Reflecting Pool – 4 (4, 5, 5, 6, 7) hanks

**Needle:** US Size 9 (5.5 mm) 24'' circular or size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, removable stitch markers, stitch holders

### GAUGE

14 sts x 22 rows = 4'' in St st

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## PATTERN NOTES

This pullover is worked in 2 pieces from the bottom up and seamed. The lower inch of the hem is turned to the inside after the knitting is complete and sewn for a neat folded hem. Waist shaping flatters the figure!

## STITCH GUIDE

### Double Eyelet

(worked over 3 sts)

Yo, sl 2-k1-p2sso, yo.

Work these 3 sts when called for in patt.

## BACK

Cast on 62 (70, 78, 84, 92, 98) sts. Work even in St st until piece meas 4" from cast-on edge, ending with WS row.

### Shape Waist

**Dec row (RS):** K1, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 – 2 sts dec'd. Rep Dec row every 6 rows, 4 more times – 52 (60, 68, 74, 82, 88) sts rem. Work even in St st until piece meas 9" from cast-on edge, ending with WS row.

**Inc row (RS):** K1, m1, knit to last st, m1, k1 – 2 sts inc'd. Rep Inc row every 10 rows, 2 more times – 58 (66, 74, 80, 88, 94) sts. Work even in St st until piece meas 16" from cast-on edge, ending with WS row. Place removable marker each edge to indicate beg of armholes.

### Increase for Sleeves

**Inc row (RS):** K1, m1, knit to last st, m1, k1 – 2 sts inc'd. Rep Inc row every 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 6) rows, 3 (2, 1, 7, 6, 5) more times, then rep Inc row every 6 (6, 6, -, 8, 8) rows, 4 (5, 6, -, 1, 2) more time(s) – 74 (82, 90, 96, 104, 110) sts. Work even in St st until armholes meas 7¼ (7¾, 8¼, 8¾, 9¼, 9½)" from markers, ending with WS row. Place 21 (25, 29, 32, 36, 39) sts each side on holders for shoulders, place center 32 sts on holder for Neck.

## FRONT

Work as for Back until piece meas 1¾ (2¼, 2¾, 3¼, 3¾, 4)" from Armhole marker, ending with WS row.

**First Eyelet Row (RS):** K18 (22, 26, 29, 33, 36), Double Eyelet, k16, Double Eyelet, knit to end.

Work even, continuing to shape Sleeve as for Back, until piece meas 2¾ (3¼, 3¾, 4¼, 4¾, 5)" from Armhole marker, ending with WS row.

### Shape Neck

*Note: Continue to work Sleeve Increases same as for Back.*

Place markers on either side of center 16 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** Work to m, attach new ball of yarn and bind off center 16 sts, work to end.

Working both sides at once, dec 1 st at Neck edge every row, 3 times.

**Second Eyelet Row (RS):** Work to last 8 sts of Left Front, Double Eyelet, k2, ssk, k1; working on Right Front, k1, k2tog, k2, Double Eyelet, work to end.

Dec 1 st at Neck edge every row, 4 more times, while continuing to work Sleeve Increases. 8 sts dec'd each side of Neck total. After all Neck decreases and Sleeve increases are complete, there are 21 (25, 29, 32, 36, 39) sts each Shoulder. Work both sides even in St st until pieces meas 7¼ (7¾, 8¼, 8¾, 9¼, 9½)" from markers, ending with WS row. Place each set of sts on holder.

## FINISHING

Block pieces to finished measurements. Join shoulder seams using Kitchener stitch.

### Armhole Edging

With RS facing, pick up and knit 50 (54, 58, 62, 64, 66) sts evenly along Armhole opening. Bind off all sts kwise over the next WS row. Sew side seams.

### Neck Edging

Place held Back Neck sts on ndl, pick up and knit 50 sts along Front Neck edge – 82 sts. Join to work in the rnd. Purl 1 rnd, knit 1 rnd. Bind off all sts, pwise. Fold lower 1" of cast-on edge at hem to the inside of the work. Whipstitch in place. Weave in ends.

*Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat!*

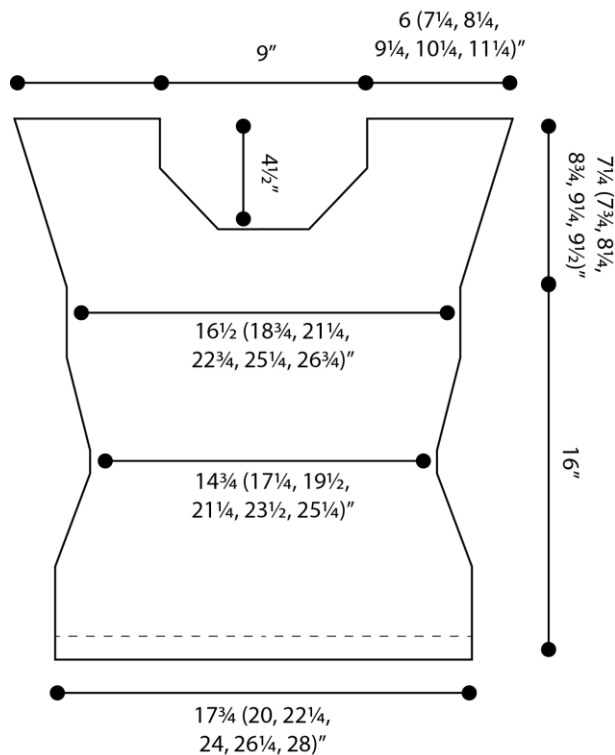
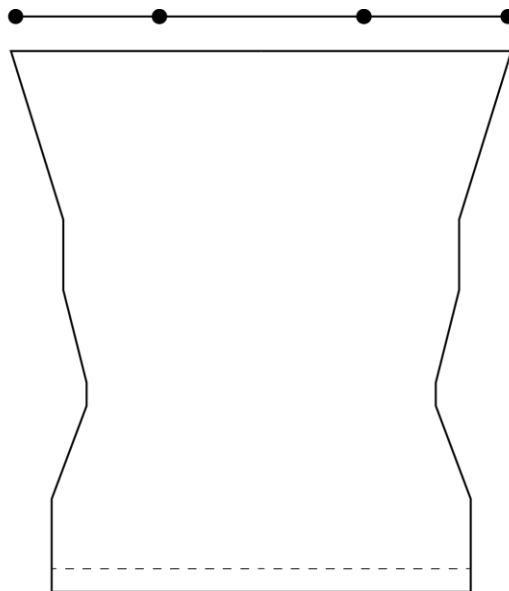

**Abbreviations**

<b>circ</b>	circular
<b>dec</b>	decrease
<b>inc</b>	increase
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
<b>m</b>	marker
<b>m1</b>	make 1 stitch
<b>meas</b>	measures
<b>ndl</b>	needle
<b>patt</b>	pattern
<b>pm</b>	place marker
<b>pssso</b>	pass slipped st(s) over
<b>pwise</b>	purlwise
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>rnd</b>	round
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>sk</b>	skip
<b>ssk</b>	slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>tog</b>	together
<b>WS</b>	wrong side
<b>yo</b>	yarn over
