#### Spring Forward Scarflette

#### SKILL

Knitting

#### DIFFICULTY

Easy

#### SIZES

One Size

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width (at widest point): 5"

Length (from tip to tip): 46"

#### MATERIALS

[Universal Yarn Magnolia](#) (95% modal, 5% cashmere; 100g/361 yds)

- 113 Key Lime – 1 skein

**Needles:** US Size 3 (3.25 mm) straight (or your preferred needle for knitting flat) or *size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers

#### GAUGE

26 sts x 26 rows = 4" in Stockinette stitch (St st)

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## PATTERN NOTES

When the start of Daylight Savings has got you down, and the weather is neither here nor there, the Spring Forward Scarflette will get you in the mood for warmer weather. Worked up in our deliciously soft Magnolia yarn, a garter border and nupp edge details give this pattern just enough interest to keep you engaged while still being a fairly easy-to-follow, rhythmic knit.

This scarflette is knit flat, from point to point, starting with a small number of stitches. Tassels are added to each end of the scarf after finishing.

## STITCH GUIDE

### Make Nupp (MN)

*(worked in 1 st)*

**Step 1:** Knit into st but do not remove from ndl.

**Step 2:** Yarn over.

**Step 3:** Knit into the same st again.

**Step 4:** Repeat steps 2-3, 2 more times, you will now have 7 sts on the RH needle. *(make sure to work these steps quite loosely)*

**Step 5:** Turn work so WS is facing you. Insert RH needle from right to left, into the back of all 7 sts and purl them together. Turn work back to RS.

## PATTERN BEGINS

### SCARFLETTE

Cast on 3 sts.

#### Increase Section

**Set-up Row (WS):** K1, p1, k1.

**Row 1 (RS):** Kfb, m1R, k1, m1L, kfb - 4 sts inc'd, 7 sts.

**Row 2 (WS):** K2, p3, k1, sl 1 wyif.

**Row 3:** K1, kfb, m1R, k3, m1L, kfb, sl 1 wyif - 4 sts inc'd, 11 sts.

**Row 4:** K4, purl to last 4 sts, k3, sl 1 wyif.

**Row 5:** K1, kfb, k1, m1R, k5, m1L, k1, kfb, sl 1 wyif - 4 sts inc'd, 15 sts.

**Row 6:** K4, purl to last 4 sts, k3, sl 1 wyif.

**Row 7:** K2, MN, k1, m1R, knit to last 4 sts, m1L, k1, MN, k1, sl 1 wyif - 2 sts inc'd, 17 sts

**WS Rows 8-12:** K4, purl to last 4 sts, k3, sl 1 wyif.

**RS Rows 9-11:** K4, m1R, knit to last 4 sts, m1L, k3, sl 1 wyif - 4 sts inc'd - 21 sts.

**Rows 13-24:** Rep Rows 7-12, 2 times - 12 sts inc'd, 33 sts.

#### Center Section

*Note 1: Stitch count will not change in this section.*

*Note 2: We recommend placing markers after your first 4 sts and before your last 4 sts to mark the garter border.*



**Row 1 (RS):** K2, MN, knit to last 3 sts, MN, k1, sl 1 wyif.

**Row 2 (WS):** K4, purl to last 4 sts, k3, sl 1 wyif.

**RS Rows 3-5:** Knit to last st, sl 1 wyif.

**WS Rows 4-6:** Rep Row 2.

Rep Rows 1-6 until piece meas approx. 38½" from cast-on edge, ending with Row 6.

#### Decrease Section

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, MN, k1, ssk, knit to last 7 sts, k2tog, k1, MN, k2, sl 1 wyif - 2 sts dec'd, 31 sts rem.

**WS Rows 2-6:** K4, purl to last 4 sts, k3, sl 1 wyif.

**RS Rows 3-5:** K4, ssk, knit to last 6 sts, k2tog, k3, sl 1 wyif - 4 sts dec'd, 27 sts rem.

**Rows 7-18:** Rep Rows 1-6, 2 times; 12 sts dec'd, 15 sts rem.

**Rows 19-20:** Rep Rows 1-2 - 2 sts dec'd, 13 sts rem.

**Row 21:** [K1, ssk] 2 times, [k1, k2tog] 2 times, sl 1 wyif - 4 sts dec'd - 9 sts rem.

**Row 22:** K3, p3, k2, sl 1 wyif.

**Row 23:** [Ssk] 2 times, k1, [k2tog] 2 times - 4 sts dec'd, 5 sts rem.

**Row 24:** K1, p3, k1.

**Row 25:** Ssk, k1, k2tog - 2 sts dec'd, 3 sts rem.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

Bind off rem sts kwise.

## FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements.  
Weave in ends.

## Tassels (make 2)

Wrap yarn around 6" piece of cardboard, 40 times. Cut yarn at one end of cardboard. Cut 2 pieces of yarn, 8" long. Loop one piece around tassel at the top (un-cut) end, securing strands. Carefully slide tassel off cardboard. Wrap the other 8" piece of yarn around Tassel approx 1" from top end several times. Hide ends of this piece inside Tassel. Sew one tassel to each tip of scarflette. Weave in any rem ends.

## Abbreviations

<b>approx.</b>	approximately
<b>dec('d)</b>	decrease(d)
<b>inc('d)</b>	increase(d)
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
<b>kfb</b>	knit into front and back of next st (1 st inc'd)
<b>LH</b>	left hand
<b>m1L</b>	insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st inc'd)
<b>m1R</b>	insert left needle from back to front under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the front loop (1 st inc'd)
<b>meas</b>	measures
<b>MN</b>	make nupp
<b>ndl</b>	needle
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>rem</b>	remain(ing)
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>RH</b>	right hand
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>sl</b>	slip
<b>ssk</b>	slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
<b>St st</b>	Stockinette stitch (knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows; in the rnd, knit every rnd)
