Stripe-o-saurus Sweater

SIZES

3-6 mos (1, 2, 4, 6, 8, 10) years

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest Circumference: 18½ (19¾, 22, 23¼, 25¼, 26, 28¼)''

Length: 11½ (13, 14½, 16, 17½, 19, 20)''

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Bamboo Pop* (50% bamboo, 50% cotton; 100g/292 yds)

- 209 Jungle Life (A) – 1 (1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 2) balls
- 117 Emerald (B) – 1 (1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 2) balls
- 124 Tropical Green (C) – 1 ball, all sizes

Needles: US Size 5 (3.75 mm) 16 or 24'' circular *or size needed to obtain gauge*
US Size 4 (3.5 mm) straight and set of dpns (3-6 mo, 1 yr, & 2 yr sizes only) or 16'' circular

Notions: Tapestry needle, 2 removable stitch markers, stitch holders or waste yarn

GAUGE

23 sts x 33 rows = 4'' in Stockinette Stitch (St st) with larger ndl

Save time, check your gauge.

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PATTERN NOTES

Dinosaurs (real and imaginary) appear in many different colors. Luckily, so does Bamboo Pop! This machine washable yarn is perfect for kids' garments (and adults, too!) and is a delight to knit with. Have fun creating a Stripe-o-saurus for your favorite little person.

This sweater is worked flat from the bottom up and seamed. Neck edging stitches are picked up and worked in the round. A circular needle is used to work the body because there are times in which stitches will need to be slipped to the other end of the needle during the Stripe Sequence. Cut yarn after each color section and weave in these ends.

STITCH GUIDE

K1, P1 Twisted Rib

(odd number of sts, worked flat)

Row 1 (RS): K1, * p1, k1 tbl; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

Row 2 (WS): P1, * k1, p1 tbl; rep from * to last 2 sts, k1, p1.

Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

K1, P1 Twisted Rib

(even number of sts, worked in the rnd)

Rnd 1: * K1 tbl, p1; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

Stripe Sequence

(any number of sts)

RS Rows 1, 3, 7, & 9: With A, knit to end.

WS Rows 2, 4, 6, & 8: With A, purl to end.

WS Rows 10, 12, & 14: With B, purl to end.

RS Rows 11 & 13: With B, knit to end. Slide sts to other end of ndl.

Row 15 (RS): With C, knit to end. Slide sts to other end of ndl.

RS Rows 16, 18, & 20: With B, knit to end.

WS Rows 17 & 19: With B, purl to end.

Rep Rows 1-20 for patt.

SWEATER

Back

Hem

With C and smaller ndl, cast on 55 (59, 65, 69, 75, 77, 83) sts. Work in K1, P1 Twisted Rib until piece meas 1¼ (1½, 1½, 1¾, 1¾, 2, 2)'' from cast-on edge, ending with a WS row. Break C and change to larger ndl.

Body

Note: Maintain Stripe Sequence patt throughout Raglan Shaping.

Join A. Beg with Row 1, work in Stripe Sequence patt until piece meas 7 (8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 12½)'' from cast-on edge, ending with a WS Row.

Shape Raglan

Bind off 3 sts at the beg of the next 2 rows – 49 (53, 59, 63, 69, 71, 77) sts rem.

Dec Row (RS): K1, k2tog, cont as est'd to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 – 2 sts dec'd; 47 (51, 57, 61, 67, 69, 75) sts rem. *Note: There will be instances in which the Decrease Row will fall on a WS row. Work dec's on WS Rows as foll: P1, p2tog, cont as est'd to last 3 sts, ssp, p1.*

Rep Dec Row every 4 rows 7 (8, 7, 8, 7, 9, 8) more times, then rep Dec Row every 2 rows 3 (3, 7, 7, 11, 9, 13) times – 20 (22, 28, 30, 36, 36, 42) sts dec'd, 27 (29, 29, 31, 31, 33, 33) Back Neck sts rem, place Back Neck sts on holder or waste yarn.

Front

Work as for Back to Raglan Shaping.

Shape Raglan

Note: Maintain Stripe Sequence patt throughout Raglan Shaping.

Note 2: Read through entire section before proceeding – Raglan Shaping and Front Neck Shaping occur at the same time.

Place removable markers on each side of center 5 (7, 7, 9, 9, 11, 11) sts. *Note: Slide removable marker as you come to it.*

Bind off 3 sts at the beg of the next 2 rows – 49 (53, 59, 63, 69, 71, 77) sts rem.

Dec Row (RS): K1, k2tog, cont as est'd to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 – 2 sts dec'd; 47 (51, 57, 61, 67, 69, 5) sts rem. Rep Dec Row every 4 rows 8 (9, 8, 9, 8, 10, 9) more times, then rep Dec Row every 2 rows 3 (3, 7, 7, 11, 9, 13) times – 20 (22, 28, 30,

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36, 36, 42) sts dec'd. *Note: There will be instances in which the Decrease Row will fall on a WS row. Work dec's on WS Rows as foll: P1, p2tog, cont as est'd to last 3 sts, ssp, p1.*

At the same time, when piece meas 3¼ (3½, 4, 4¼, 4¾, 5¼, 5½)" from armhole bind-off, shape Front Neck as follows:

Cont as est'd over Left Front sts to removable m, join a new ball of yarn and bind off 5 (7, 7, 9, 9, 11, 11) Front Neck sts, cont as est'd over Right Front sts to end.

Right Front

Work 1 WS row as est'd to end. Bind off 4 sts at the beg of the next 2 RS rows, then bind off 3 sts at the beg of the next RS row. Cont in patt as est'd until Right Front Shaping is complete and *all* Raglan decreases are complete – 1 st rem on ndl.

Note: Final Raglan Dec Row will be worked as: k2tog.

Left Front

Bind off 4 sts at the beg of the next 2 WS rows, then bind off 3 sts at the beg of the next WS row. Cont in patt as est'd until Left Front Shaping is complete and *all* Raglan decreases are complete. Bind off rem st.

Note: Final Raglan Dec Row will be worked as: ssk.

Sleeves

With C and smaller ndl, cast on 29 (33, 35, 37, 37, 39, 41) sts. Work in K1, P1 Twisted Rib until piece meas ¾ (1, 1, 1¼, 1¼, 1½, 1½)" from cast-on edge, ending with a WS Row. Break C and change to larger ndl.

Shape Sleeve

Note: Maintain Stripe Sequence patt as est'd throughout Sleeve shaping.

Join A.

Row 1 (RS): Work Row 1 of Stripe Sequence patt to end.

Row 2 (WS): Work Row 2 of Stripe Sequence patt to end.

Inc Row (RS): K1, m1, work next row of Stripe Sequence patt to last st, m1, k1. *Note: There will be instances in which the Increase Row will fall on a WS row. Work dec's on WS Rows as foll: P1, m1p, cont as est'd to last st, m1p, p1.*



Rep Inc Row every 4 (4, 6, 6, 8, 8, 8) rows 8 (-, 4, -, 9, 9, 3) more times, then rep Inc Row every - (6, 8, 8, -, 10, 10) rows - (7, 4, 8, -, 1, 7) times – 16 (14, 16, 16, 18, 20, 20) sts inc'd, 47 (49, 53, 55, 57, 61, 63) sts. Cont even as est'd until piece meas 6½ (7½), 9½, 10½, 11¾, 13, 14½)" from cast-on edge, ending with a WS row.

Shape Raglan

Note: Cont in Stripe Sequence patt as est'd throughout Raglan Shaping.

Bind off 3 sts at the beg of the next 2 rows – 41 (43, 47, 49, 51, 55, 57) sts rem.

Dec Row (RS): K1, k2tog, cont as est'd to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 – 2 sts dec'd; 47 (51, 57, 61, 67, 69, 75) sts rem. *Note: There will be instances in which the Decrease Row will fall on a WS row. Work dec's on WS Rows as foll: P1, p2tog, cont as est'd to last 3 sts, ssp, p1.*

Rep Dec Row every 4 rows 3 (5, 5, 7, 8, 9, 10) more times, then rep Dec Row every 2 rows 11 (9, 11, 9, 9, 9, 9) times, 11 (13, 13, 15, 15, 17, 17) sts rem. Place rem sts on holder or waste yarn.

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FINISHING

Block pieces to finished measurements and weave in ends. Sew Raglan seams, sew side and Sleeve seams.

Neck Edge

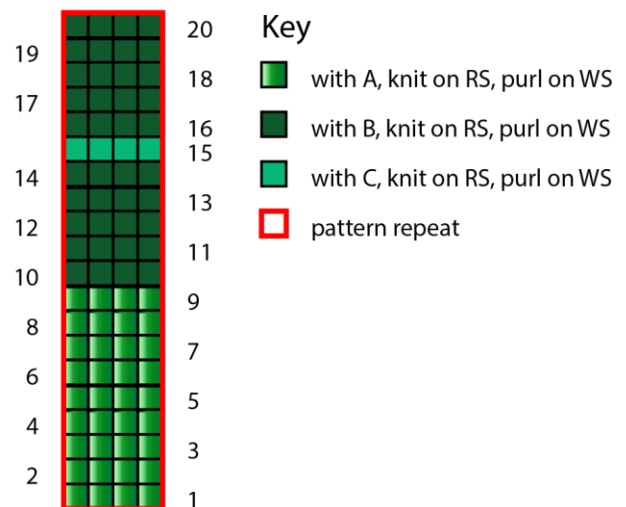
With smaller dpns (for sizes 3-6 mo, 1 & 2 year) or 16" circ and color C and RS facing, beg at right back neck, knit across 27 (29, 29, 31, 31, 33, 33) Back Neck sts, knit across 11 (13, 13, 15, 15, 17, 17) Left Shoulder sts, pick up and knit 13 (15, 15, 17, 17, 17, 18) sts along Left Front Neck edge, pick up and knit 5 (7, 7, 9, 9, 11, 11) sts along center Neck bind-off edge, pick up and knit 13 (15, 15, 17, 17, 17, 18) sts along Right Front Neck edge, knit across 11 (13, 13, 15, 15, 17, 17) Right Shoulder sts – 80 (92, 92, 104, 104, 112, 114) sts. PM and join to work in the rnd. Work in K1, P1 Twisted Rib until piece meas $\frac{3}{4}$ (1, 1, 1 $\frac{1}{4}$, 1 $\frac{1}{4}$, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$)" from picked up edge. Bind off all sts loosely in patt. Weave in rem ends.

beg	begin(ning)
circ	circular
cont	continue
dec('d)	decrease(d)
dpn(s)	double pointed needle(s)
est'd	established
inc('d)	increase(d)
k	knit
k2tog	knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
m1	insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st inc'd)
m1P	insert left needle from back to front under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, purl this st through the front loop (1 st inc'd)
meas	measures
ndl	needle
p	purl
p2tog	purl 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
patt	pattern

rem	remain(ing)
rep	repeat
rnd	round
RS	right side
ssk	slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
ssp	slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, purl them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
St st	Stockinette stitch (knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows; in the rnd, knit every rnd)
st(s)	stitch(es)
tbl	through the back loop(s)
WS	wrong side

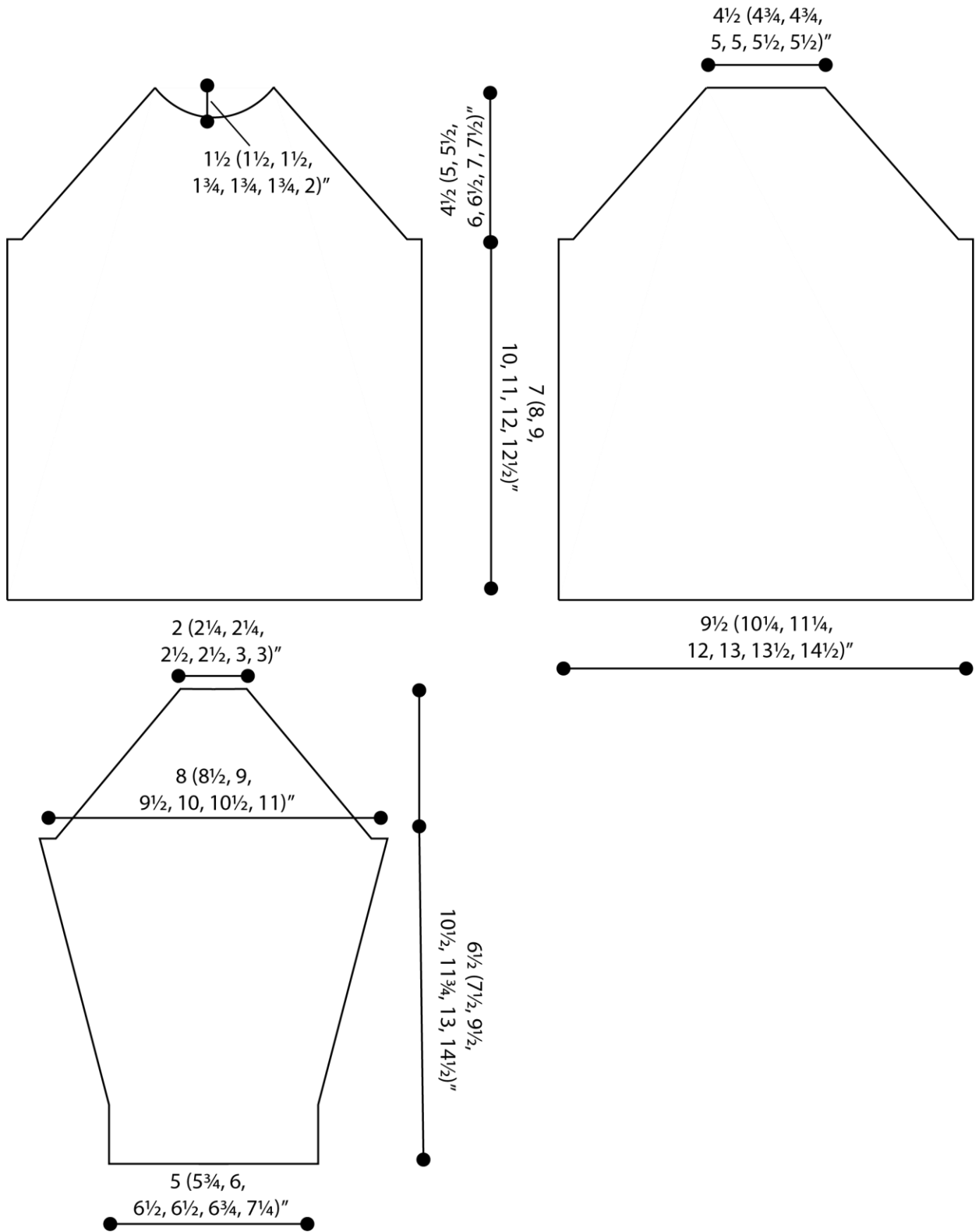
