DIFFICULTY

Easy

SIZES

Adult Small (Medium, Large) Shown in Adult Medium Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Foot Circumference (unstretched): 6 (6¾, 7½)"

Note: Pattern is very stretchy.

Length: Adjustable

MATERIALS

<u>Universal Yarn Uni Merino Mini</u> (75% superwash merino wool, 25% nylon; 25g/109 yds)

- 116 Lemon Zest (A) 1 skein
- 134 Wisteria (B) 1 skein
- 121 Tree Frog (C) 1 skein
- 144 Taffy (D) 2 skeins

Needle: US Size 1 (2.25 mm) set of DPNs (or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences) or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker, waste yarn

GAUGE

38 sts x 44 rnds = 4" (unstretched) in Rib Stripes

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

Colorful Uni Merino was designed for socks, and the Sugar Stripe socks are the perfect example. Stretchy ribbing, fun stripes, and miniature yarnovers come together in these candy-coated socks.

These socks are knit seamlessly from the cuff down and feature an afterthought heel. The Rib Stripes pattern is also charted for your convenience.

STITCH GUIDE

Rib Stripes

(even number of sts)

Rnd 1: With color B, * k2tog, yo; rep from * to end. Rnds 2: With color B, * k1, p1 tbl; rep from * to end.

Rnds 3-4: With color B, * k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnds 5-8: With color C, rep Rnds 1-4. Rnds 9-12: With color A, rep Rnds 1-4. Rnds 13-16: With color D, rep Rnds 1-4. Rnds 17-20: With color B, rep Rnds 1-4. Rnds 21-24: With color C, rep Rnds 1-4. Rnds 25-28: With color D, rep Rnds 1-4. Rnds 29-32: With color A, rep Rnds 1-4.

Rep Rnds 1-32 for patt.

PATTERN BEGINS

SOCKS

(make two)

Lea

With color A, cast on 56 (64, 72) sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

Rnds 1-4: * K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Work Rnds 1-32 of Rib Stripes patt 2 times, then rep Rnds 1-2, 1 more time.

Heel Stitches: Cont in patt as est'd over 28 (32, 36) Instep sts, join waste yarn and k28 (32, 36) sts, slide these last 28 (32, 36) sts back to LH ndl, k28 (32, 36) with working yarn - 56 (64, 72) sts.

Foot

Note: You will continue working Rib Stripes patt over the Instep sts. Using the same color sequence as indicated in Rib Stripes patt, the bottom of the Foot will be worked in Stockinette stitch.

Rnd 1: Cont in Rib Stripes patt over 28 (32, 36) Instep sts. k28 (32, 36) Bottom Foot sts.

Cont even in patt as est'd until Foot meas approx. 5 (5½, 6)" from Heel sts, or 3¼ (3¾, 4)" less than



desired length, end ending with Rnd 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24, 28, or 32 of Rib Stripe patt.

Break all colors except color D, or desired color for Toe.

Shape Toe

Rnd 1: With color D, knit.

Rnd 2 (Dec Rnd): K1, ssk, knit to 3 sts bef m, k2tog, k1, sl m, ssk, knit to 3 sts bef m, k2tog, k1 - 4 sts dec'd, 52 (60, 68) sts rem.

Rep Rnds 1-2, 8 (9, 10) more times - 32 (36, 40) sts dec'd, 20, (24, 28) sts rem.

Place first 10 (12, 14) sts on one ndl and last 10 (12, 14) sts on separate ndl. Holding the two ndls parallel to one another, graft the two sets of sts together using the Kitchener method.

Heel

Place 28 (32, 36) sts on each side of the waste yarn onto DPNs or your preferred ndl for knitting small circumferences – 56 (64, 72) sts total. Carefully remove waste yarn. Join color D.

Complete as for Toe.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!


