

Pattern Collection: Women



Super Fan Poncho

Designed by Universal Yarn Design Team

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 41 Length: 21½" Cowl Width: 7½" Cowl Length: 33"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Uptown Worsted Spirit Stripes* (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 100g/180 yds)

- 518 Interception (A) 4 balls **Universal Yarn** *Uptown Worsted* (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 100g/180 yds)
- 308 Baby Blue (B) 4 balls
 Needles: US Size 9 (5.5 mm) 40" circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge
 Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch holder

GAUGE

17 sts x 28 rows = 4" in Mock Rib Stitch Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

PATTERN NOTES

This Poncho is knit from the bottom up in 2 pieces and seamed. The Cowl is knit separately and sewn to the neck opening.

The circular needle is used only to accommodate the large number of stitches. All work is done back and forth in rows.

STITCH GUIDE

Mock Rib Stitch (even number of sts)

Row 1 (RS): With A, knit.

Row 2 (WS): With A, k2, * sl 1 pwise wyif, k1; rep

from * to end.

Rows 3-4: With B, rep Rows 1-2.

Rep Rows 1-4 for patt.

FRONT

With A, cast on 174 sts. Beg with Row 1, work in Mock Rib Stitch until piece meas 20" from cast-on edge, ending with WS row.

Divide for Neck Opening

Row 1 (RS): Work in patt over 64 sts, turn, placing rem 110 sts on holder. Work in patt over 64 sts for 7 more rows. Bind off all sts.

Return held sts to ndl.

Next row (RS): Bind off 46 sts for Neck Opening, work in patt over rem 64 sts. Cont in patt for 7 more rows. Bind off all sts.

BACK

Work as for Front.

COWL

With A, cast on 32 sts. Beg with Row 1, work in Mock Rib Stitch until piece meas 33" from cast-on edge, ending with WS row. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Block pieces to finished measurements. Sew bindoff edges of Front and Back tog to form shoulder seams. Sew side seams, leaving approximately 8" unsewn for armholes. You may wish to try the poncho on first to determine the best height for armhole openings.

Sew cast-on and bind-off edges of Cowl tog. With RS of Cowl facing inside, sew one side of Cowl to

Neck opening, easing in where necessary. Fold Cowl over to wear. Weave in ends.
