



## Pattern Collection: Accessories



### **Sweet Little Cowl**

### **SIZES**

One Size

### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

**Circumference:** 24"

**Height:** 10"

### **MATERIALS**

**Fibra Natura Cottonwood** (100% organic cotton; 50g/115 yds)

Peachy:

- 41125 Erin (A) – 1 balls
- 41107 Monica (B) – 2 balls

Chocolate Cherry:

- 41121 Callie (A) – 1 balls
- 41120 Barbara (B) – 2 balls

**Needles:** US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16" circular  
*or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch marker

### **GAUGE**

14 sts x 40 rows = 4" in Stockinette

Brioche stitch

14 sts x 40 rows = 4" in Two-Color Pearl

Brioche

**Save time, check your gauge.**

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## PATTERN NOTES

These cowls are a great introduction to brioche knitting. Have fun with color and select something bright or high contrast—there are plenty of options within the Cottonwood palette.

The errata on this cowl turned out to be a happy accident, so at the advice of a customer, we've decided to include instructions for two versions. Version A reflects the sample photos – the Pearl Brioche has a “v” shape. Version B reflects the happy accident in which the two-color portion has small bars in place of the “v” shape shown on the samples.

### Slip 1, yarnover (sl1yo)

Bring the working yarn under the needle to the front of the work, slip the next st pwise, bring the working yarn over the ndl and the slipped stitch to the back. On the following row, treat the sl1yo stitch as one stich, working the slipped stitch and yarnover stitch together.

### Crochet Provisional Cast-on

With waste yarn and crochet hook, make a ch approximately 10 chs longer than the number of sts to be cast on. With working yarn and knitting needle, pick up and knit sts through the bottom bump of each ch.

### I-Cord Bind-Off

Cast on 4 sts to first st on left ndl using knitted cast-on. \* K3, k2tog tbl (1 st bound-off), slip these 4 sts back to left ndl; rep from \* until all sts have been bound-off. Bind off rem 4 I-Cord sts.

## STITCH GUIDE

### Stockinette Brioche

*(even number of sts)*

**Set up Rnd:** Wyif, \* Sl1yo, k1; rep from \* to end

**Rnd 1:** \* Brk1, sl1yo; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 2:** \* Sl1yo, brk1; rep from \* to end

Rep Rnds 1-2 for patt.

### Version A Two-Color Pearl Brioche

*Note: As shown in photos.*

*(even number of sts)*

**Rnd 1:** With A, \* p1, sl1yo; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 2:** With B, \* k1, brk1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 3:** With A, \* sl1yo, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 4:** With B, \* brk1, k1; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnds 1-4 for patt.

### Version B Two-Color Pearl Brioche

*(even number of sts)*

**Rnd 1:** With A, \* Sl1yo, k1 \* rep from to end

**Rnd 2:** With B, \* Brk1, p1; rep from \* to end

**Rnd 3:** With A, \* K1, sl1yo; rep from \* to end

**Rnd 4:** With B, \* P1, brk1; rep from \* to end

Rep Rnds 1-4 for patt.

## COWL

### Version A

#### Bottom Edge

With A, cast on 82 sts using the Crochet Provisional method. PM and join in the rnd being careful not to twists sts. Join B, do not break A. Work in Version A Two-Color Pearl Brioche until piece meas 2½". Break A.

#### Body

With B, work in Stockinette Brioche until piece meas 7½" from bottom edge.

#### Top Edge

Join A. Work in Version A Two-Color Pearl Brioche until piece meas 10". Break B. Bind off all sts in A using the I-Cord method.

## FINISHING

Carefully unravel crochet chain, placing resulting live sts onto ndl. With A, bind off all sts using the I-Cord method.

Weave in ends. Block piece to finished measurements.

### Version B

#### Bottom Edge

With A, cast on 82 sts using the Crochet Provisional method. PM and join in the rnd being careful not to twists sts. Join B, do not break A. Work in Version B Two-Color Pearl Brioche until piece meas 2½". Break A.

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## Body

With B, work in Stockinette Brioche until piece meas 7½" from bottom edge.

## Top Edge

Join A. Work in Version B Two-Color Pearl Brioche until piece meas 10". Break B. Bind off all sts in A using the I-Cord method.

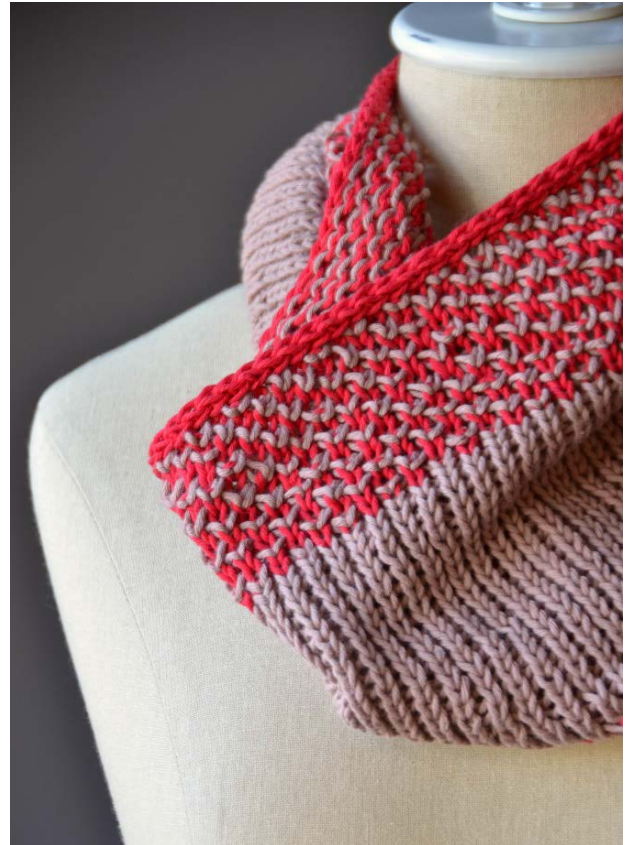
## FINISHING

Carefully unravel crochet chain, placing resulting live sts onto ndl. With A, bind off all sts using the I-Cord method.

Weave in ends. Block piece to finished measurements.

## Abbreviations

<b>brk</b>	brioche knit – knit the stitch that was slipped in the previous row together with its yarnover
<b>ch</b>	chain
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
<b>meas</b>	measures
<b>ndl</b>	needle
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>patt</b>	pattern
<b>pm</b>	place marker
<b>pwise</b>	purlwise
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>sl1yo</b>	slip 1, yarnover – bring the working yarn under the needle to the front of the work, slip the next st pwise, bring the working yarn over the ndl and the slipped stitch to the back
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>tbl</b>	through the back loop(s)
<b>wyif</b>	with yarn held in front



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
