



## Pattern Collection: Home



### **Taku Throw**

Designed by Universal Yarn Design Team

### **SIZE**

One Size

### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

**Length:** 58¾"

**Width:** 43¾"

### **MATERIALS**

**Universal Yarn *Uptown Worsted Tapestry*** (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 100g/180 yds)

- 806 Emerald (A) – 4 skeins

**Universal Yarn *Uptown Worsted*** (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 100g/180 yds)

- 331 Sapphire (B) – 4 skeins

**Universal Yarn *Uptown Worsted Mist*** (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 100g/180 yds)

- 906 Aqua (C) – 2 skeins

**Needles:** US Size 8 (5 mm) 40" circular (to accommodate large number of stitches) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers

### **GAUGE**

16 sts x 32 rows = 4" in garter stitch

1 panel = 8¾" wide

**Save time, check your gauge.**

*Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat!*

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## PATTERN NOTES

The classic chevron gets an update in this squishy throw blanket. Wide panels and color blocking make this a modern statement piece that would love its place on the back of your couch. With a wide variety of colors available in Uptown Worsted, Uptown Worsted Mist, and Uptown Worsted Tapestry, there are endless color combinations for you to personalize this project.

This blanket is worked in one piece, mostly in garter stitch. It would make a good project for a beginner ready to move past the bare basics, or a relaxing knit for a more seasoned stitcher.

## STITCH GUIDE

### Central Double Decrease (CDD)

Sl 2 kwise, k1, p2sso – 2 sts dec'd.

## Throw

### Stripe 1

With A, cast on 213 sts.

**Set-up Row (WS):** K2, pm, k20, p1, k20, pm, [p1, k20, p1, k20, pm] 4 times, knit to last 2 sts, pm, k2.

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, [sl m, m1, k19, CDD, k19, m1, k1] 4 times, sl m, m1, k19, CDD, k19, m1, sl m, k2.

**Row 2:** K2, sl m, k20, [p1, k20] 9 times, sl m, k2. Rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas 2½" from cast-on edge, ending with Row 2. Break A, join B.

### Stripe 2

With B, rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas 13¼" from cast-on edge, ending with Row 2. Break B. Join A.

### Stripe 3

With A, rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas 24" from cast-on edge, ending with Row 2. Break A. Join C.

### Stripe 4

With C, rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas 34¾" from cast-on edge. Break C, Join A.

**Stripe 5:** With A, rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas 45½" from cast-on edge, ending with Row 2.

Break A, join B.

### Stripe 6

With B, rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas 56¼" from cast-on edge, ending with Row 2. Break B, join A.

### Stripe 7

With A, rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas 58¾" from cast-on edge, ending with Row 2. Bind off all sts loosely.

## FINISHING

Block to finished measurements and weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

<b>dec('d)</b>	decrease(d)
<b>garter st</b>	knit every row
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>kwise</b>	knitwise
<b>inc('d)</b>	increase(d)
<b>m</b>	marker
<b>m1</b>	insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st inc'd)
<b>meas</b>	measures
<b>pm</b>	place marker
<b>pssso</b>	pass slipped stitch(es) over
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>sl</b>	slip
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>WS</b>	wrong side

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
