



Finished Measurements

Chest: 24½ (25½, 27, 28, 31, 33)"

Length: 151/4 (163/4, 181/4, 191/4, 20, 211/4)"

Materials

Universal Yarn *Uptown Baby Sport* (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 100g/361 yds)

217 Seafoam – 2 (3, 3, 4, 4, 4) balls

Needles: US Size 6 (4 mm)straight needles OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

Notions: 6 – ½" buttons, cable needle, locking ring stitch markers, tapestry needle

Gauge

32 sts and 34 rows = 4" in patt st SAVE TIME, CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

Cable & Rib Stitch Pattern

Multiples of 12 sts

Row 1 (RS): * K2, p2, k6, p2; rep from * to end. **Row 2:** * K2, p6, k2, p2; rep from * to end. **Row 3:** * K2, p2, sl 3 sts to cn and hold at back, k3, k3 from cn, p2; rep from * to end. **Row 4:** Rep row 2. Rep rows 1-4 for patt st.

BACK

Cast on 84 (88, 92, 96, 104, 114) sts. **Row 1 (WS):** P0 (2, 0, 0, 0, 0), k0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 1), p0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 2), * k2, p2; rep from * to last 0 (2, 4, 0, 4, 3) sts, end k0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 2), p0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 1), k0 (2, 0, 0, 0, 0). **Row 2:** P0 (2, 0, 0, 0, 0), k0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 1), p0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 2), * k2, p2; rep from * to last 0 (2, 4, 0, 4, 3) sts, end k0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 2), p0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 1), k0 (2, 0, 0, 0, 0). Work even in 2 x 2 rib patt as set until piece measures 2 (2, $2\frac{1}{2}$, $2\frac{3}{4}$, 3)" from cast on, ending after a RS row.

Beg Patt St

Set-up row (WS): P0 (2, 0, 0, 0, 0), k0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 1), p0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 2), * K2, p6, k2, p2; rep from * across to last 0 (2, 4, 0, 4, 3) sts, end k0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 2), p0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 1), k0 (2, 0, 0, 0, 0). **Row 1** (**RS):** P0 (2, 0, 0, 0, 0), k0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 1), p0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 2), work row 1 of patt st to last 0 (2, 4, 0, 4, 3) sts, end k0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 2), p0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 1), k0 (2, 0, 0, 0, 0). Work even in patt as set until piece measures 9½ (10½, 11½, 12, 12½, 13½)", ending after a WS row. Insert stitch markers into fabric at start and end of row to indicate placement of armholes. Work even in patt until armhole measures 5¾ (6¼, 6¾, 7¼, 7½, 7¾)", ending after a WS row. Bind off all sts in patt.

Cabled Cardigan Vest Designed by Michael del Vecchio

Sizes

Pullover sized to fit Child's 4 (6, 8, 10, 12, 14).



LEFT FRONT

Cast on 40 (42, 45, 48, 53, 55) sts. **Row 1(WS):** P0 (0, 1, 0, 1, 0), k2 (2, 2, 0, 0, 2), p2 (2, 2, 0, 0, 2), * K2, p2; rep from * across to last 0 (2, 4, 0, 4, 3) sts, end k0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 2), p0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 1), k0 (2, 0, 0, 0, 0). **Row 2:** P0 (2, 0, 0, 0, 0), k0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 1), p0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 2), * k2, p2; rep from * to last 4 (4, 5, 0, 1, 4) sts, end k2 (2, 2, 0, 0, 2), p2 (2, 2, 0, 0, 2), k0 (0, 1, 0, 1, 0). Work even in 2 x 2 rib patt as set until piece measures 2 (2, 2½, 2½, 2¾, 3)" from cast on, ending after a RS row.

Beg Patt St

Set-up row (WS): P0 (0, 1, 0, 1, 0), k2 (2, 2, 0, 0, 2), p2 (2, 2, 0, 0, 2), * K2, p6, k2, p2; rep from * across to last 0 (2, 4, 0, 4, 3) sts, end k0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 2), p0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 1), k0 (2, 0, 0, 0, 0). **Row 1 (RS):** P0 (2, 0, 0, 0, 0), k0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 1), p0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 2), work row 1 of patt st to last 4 (4, 5, 0, 1, 4) sts, end k2 (2, 2, 0, 0, 2), p2 (2, 2, 0, 0, 2), k0 (0, 1, 0, 1, 0). Work even in patt as set until piece measures 9½ (10½, 11½, 12, 12½, 13½)", ending after a WS row. Insert stitch markers into fabric at start and end of row to indicate placement of armholes. Work even in patt until armhole measures 3¼ (3¾, 4¼, 4¼, 4½, 4¾)", ending after a RS row.

Shape Front Neck

Next row (WS): Bind off 10 (12, 14, 13, 14, 14) sts, work in patt to end. Dec row (RS): Work in patt to last 3 sts, end k2tog, k1 – 1 st dec'd. Work 1 WS row in patt. Rep these 2 rows 5 (5, 6, 9, 9, 8) more times – 24 (24, 24, 25, 28, 32) sts rem. Work even until armhole measures 5¾ (6¼, 6¾, 7¼, 7½, 7¾)", ending after a WS row. Bind off all sts in patt.

RIGHT FRONT

Cast on 40 (42, 45, 48, 53, 55) sts. **Row 1(WS):** K0 (2, 0, 0, 0, 0), p0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 1), k0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 2), * p2, k2; rep from * to last 4 (4, 5, 0, 1, 4) sts, end p2 (2, 2, 0, 0, 2), k2 (2, 2, 0, 0, 2), p0 (0, 1, 0, 1, 0). **Row 2:** K0 (0, 1, 0, 1, 0), p2 (2, 2, 0, 0, 2), k2 (2, 2, 0, 0, 2), * p2, k2; rep from * to last 0 (2, 4, 0, 4, 3) sts, end p0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 2), k0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 1), p0 (2, 0, 0, 0, 0). Work even in 2 x 2 rib patt as set until piece measures 2 (2, 2½, 2½, 2¾, 3)" from cast on, ending after a RS row.

Beg Patt St

Set-up row (WS): K0 (2, 0, 0, 0, 0), p0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 1), k0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 2), * p2, k2, p6, k2; rep from * to last 4 (4, 5, 0, 1, 4) sts, end p2 (2, 2, 0, 0, 2), k2 (2, 2, 0, 0, 2), p0 (0, 1, 0, 1, 0). **Row 1:** K0 (0, 1, 0, 1, 0), p2 (2, 2, 0, 0, 2), k2 (2, 2, 0, 0, 2), * p2, k6, p2, k2; rep from * to to last 0 (2, 4, 0, 4, 3) sts, end p0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 2), k0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 1), p0 (2, 0, 0, 0, 0). **Rows 2 & 4:** Rep set-up row. **Row 3:** K0 (0, 1, 0, 1, 0), p2 (2, 2, 0, 0, 2), k2 (2, 2, 0, 0, 2), * p2, sl 3 sts to cn, hold at back of work, k3, k3 from cn, p2, k2; rep from * to to last 0 (2, 4, 0, 4, 3) sts, end p0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 2), k0 (0, 2, 0, 2, 1), p0 (2, 0, 0, 0, 0). Rep rows 1-4 and work as for Left Front, rev all shaping.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams.

Button Band

With RS facing, beg at neck edge of Left Front, pick up and knit 100 (112, 124, 132, 136, 144) sts evenly to lower edge. **Row 1 (WS):** * P2, k2; rep from * to end. Work even in 2 x 2 rib until band measures 1½". Bind off all sts in patt.

Buttonhole Band

With RS facing, beg at lower edge of Right Front, pick up and knit 100 (112, 124, 132, 136, 144) sts evenly to neck edge. **Row 1 (WS):** * P2, k2; rep from * to end. Work even in 2 x 2 rib for 2 more rows. **Buttonhole row (RS):** P2, yo, k2tog, * work in patt across 23 (26, 29, 31, 32, 34) sts, yo, k2tog; rep from * 3 more times, work in patt to end. Work even in 2 x 2 rib until band measures 1½". Bind off all sts in patt.

Neck Band

With RS facing, beg at neck edge of buttonhole band pick up and knit 94 (106, 118, 126, 138, 138) sts evenly around neck. **Row 1 (WS):** P2, * k2, p2; rep from * to end. Work even in 2 x 2 rib patt for 2 more rows. **Next row (RS):** K2, yo, p2tog, work in rib patt to end. Work even in rib until band measures 1½". Bind off all sts in patt.

Arm Bands

With RS facing and using stitch markers as a guide, beg at underarm pick up and knit 76 (84, 92, 100, 104, 108) sts evenly around armhole. **Row 1 (WS):** * K2, p2; rep from * to end. Work even in 2 x 2 rib patt until arm band measures 1½". Bind off all sts in patt.

Sew side and armband seams. Sew buttons opposite buttonholes. Weave in all ends.
