SKILL

Knitting

DIFFICULTY

Easy

SIZES

Small (Medium, Large)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 11½"

Length: 36 (64, 93)" Shown in Medium size

MATERIALS

<u>Universal Yarn Linear</u> (34% superfine alpaca, 33% RWS merino wool, 33% acrylic; 50g/191 yds)

• 110 Contemporary - 2 (3, 4) balls **Needle:** US Size 7 (4.5 mm) straight (or your preferred needle for knitting flat) *or*

size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

GAUGE

18 sts x 24 rows = 4" in Scarf patt after blocking

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

Watteau is a romantic, airy scarf featuring a meandering lace motif bordered by a delicate mesh pattern. It is a lovely addition to your neckline regardless of the season. Our Linear yarn adds softness and a touch of rustic charm, making this piece a treat to knit and wear.

This scarf is knit flat in one piece from the bottom up. Each end features a garter stitch border. A garter border is also maintained along the sides.

The pattern is both written and charted for your convenience.

STITCH GUIDE

Net

(even number of sts)

Row 1 (RS): * K2tog, yo; rep from * to end.

WS Rows 2-12: Purl.

Row 3: * Yo, k2tog; rep from * to end.

Row 5: Rep Row 1.

Row 7: * Yo, ssk; rep from * to end.

Row 9: * Ssk, yo; rep from * to end.

Row 11: Rep Row 7. Rep Rows 1-12 for patt.

PATTERN BEGINS

SCARF

Lower Border

Cast on 51 sts.

Rows 1-4: Knit.

Main Scarf

Row 1 (RS): K3, pm, work Row 1 of Net patt over 16 sts, pm, [k2tog, yo] 2 times, k1, yo, k2, ssk, k3, yo, k2tog, k1, ssk, yo, k3, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, yo, ssk, knit to end.

WS Rows 2-12: K3, purl to m, sl m, work next row of Net patt to m, sl m, knit to end.

Row 3: K3, sl m, work Row 3 of Net patt to m, sl m, k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, k2, ssk, k1, yo, k2tog, k3, ssk, yo, k1, k2tog, k2, yo, k3, yo, ssk, knit to end.

Row 5: K3, sl m, work Row 5 of Net patt to m, sl m, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, k2, ssk, k2tog, [k1, yo] 2 times, k1, ssk, k2tog, k2, yo, k5, yo, ssk, knit to end.

Row 7: K3, sl m, work Row 7 of Net patt to m, sl m, yo, ssk, yo, k2, ssk, k4, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, ssk, k4, k2tog, yo, knit to end.

Row 9: K3, sl m, work Row 9 of Net patt to m, sl m, k1, yo, ssk, yo, k2, ssk, k2, k2tog, k2, yo, k3, yo, k2, ssk, k2, k2tog, k2, yo, k2tog, yo, knit to end.

Row 11: K3, sl m, work Row 11 of Net patt to m, sl m, [yo, ssk] 2 times, yo, k2, ssk, k2tog, k2, yo, k5, yo, k2, ssk, k2tog, k2, yo, k2tog, yo, knit to end. Cont as est'd until piece meas approx 35½ (63½, 92½)" from cast-on edge, ending with Row 12 of Net patt.

Upper Border Rows 1-4: Knit.

Bind off all sts kwise.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

indicates a repeat section

approx. approximately cont continue est'd established garter st knit every row

k knit

k2tog knit 2 stitches together (1 st

dec'd)

kwise knitwise m marker meas measures р purl pattern patt place marker pm rep repeat RS right side

ssk slip next 2 sts individually


knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops

(1 st dec'd)

slslipst(s)stitch(es)WSwrong sideyoyarn over
