Wavelength Hat

DIFFICULTY

Easy

SIZES

Adult Small (Medium, Large)

Shown in Adult Medium

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Brim Circumference: 18 (20,22)"

Length: 8 (8½, 9)"

MATERIALS

[Universal Yarn Cassatt](#) (35% baby alpaca, 35% wool, 20% nylon, 10% viscose; 50g/120 yds)

- 604 Water Lilies - 2 balls

Hook: US Size H/8 (5 mm) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, removable stitch marker, 3" pom pom maker

GAUGE

16 sts x 13 rows = 4" in Almond Ridges patt

14 sts x 10 rows = 4" in Half Double Crochet (hdc)

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

Light and lofty, warm and woolly, the Wavelength hat is a treat to make and wear! Simple stitches around the crown are complemented by an undulating pattern of ridges along the brim. Topped with a pom pom, this beanie couldn't get any cuter!

This hat is worked top down, first with half double crochet in joined, unturned rounds, then in the Almond Ridges pattern in joined, turned rounds. When working the Almond Ridges pattern, you will work in the back loop only. Place a marker in the first stitch of the first round and move the marker up each round. If you desire a longer hat, work rounds of half double crochet evenly before moving on to the Hat Body. Note that this may require more yarn than what is suggested.

STITCH GUIDE

Almond Ridges (*worked flat for gauge*)

(*chain a multiple of 8 + 5*)

Note: Work blo across rows.

Row 1 (RS): Sl st in second ch from hk and in next 3 ch, * hdc in next 4 ch, sl st in next 4 ch; rep from * across, turn.

Row 2 (WS): Ch 1, * sl st in next 4 sts, hdc in next 4 sts; rep from * across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), hdc in next 3 sts, * sl st in next 4 sts, hdc in next 4 sts; rep from * across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 2, hdc in next 3 sts, * sl st in next 4 sts, hdc in next 4 sts; rep from * across, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, * sl st in next 4 sts, hdc in next 4 sts; rep from * across, turn.

Rep Rows 2-5 for patt

PATTERN BEGINS

HAT

Crown Shaping

Note: The Crown Shaping is worked in joined, unturned rounds

Make a Magic Circle.

Rnd 1 (WS): Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), pm, 8 (9, 10) hdc in Magic Circle, sl st to top of beg ch-2 – 9 (10, 11) hdc.

Rnd 2: Ch 2, hdc in same st, 2 hdc in each st around, sl st to top of beg ch-2 – 9 (10, 11) sts inc'd, 18 (20, 22) hdc.

Rnd 3: Ch 2, 2 hdc in next st, * hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st; rep from * around, sl st to top of beg ch-2 – 9 (10, 11) sts inc'd, 27 (30, 33) hdc.

Rnd 4: Ch 2, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, * hdc in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st; rep from * around, sl

st to top of beg ch-2 – 9 (10, 11) sts inc'd, 36 (40, 44) hdc.

Rnd 5: Ch 2, hdc in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, * hdc in next 3 sts, 2 hdc in next st; rep from * around, sl st to top of beg ch-2 – 9 (10, 11) sts inc'd, 45 (50, 55) hdc.

Rnd 6: Ch 2, hdc in next 3 sts, 2 hdc in next st, * hdc in next 4 sts, 2 hdc in next st; rep from * around, sl st to top of beg ch-2 – 9 (10, 11) sts inc'd, 54 (60, 66) hdc.

Rnd 7: Ch 2, hdc in next 4 sts, 2 hdc in next st, * hdc in next 5 sts, 2 hdc in next st; rep from * around, sl st to top of beg ch-2 – 9 (10, 11) sts inc'd, 63 (70, 77) hdc.

Rnd 8: Ch 2, hdc in next 5 sts, 2 hdc in next st, * hdc in next 6 sts, 2 hdc in next st; rep from * around, sl st to top of beg ch-2, turn – 9 (10, 11) sts inc'd, 72 (80, 88) hdc.

Hat Body

Note: The Hat Body is worked in joined, turned rounds. Work in blo for every round. This section is also charted for your convenience.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1 (does not count as a st here and throughout), * sl st in next 4 sts, hdc in next 4 sts; rep from * around, sl st to first ch, turn – 72 (80, 88) sts. Patt will be repeated 9 (10, 11) times across each row.

Rnd 2 (WS): Ch 2 (does not count as hdc), * hdc in next 4 sts, * sl st in next 4 sts; rep from * around, ch 1, sl st to beg ch-2, turn.

Rnd 3: Sk ch-1, * hdc in next 4 sts, sl st in next 4 sts; rep from * around, sl st to first st, turn.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, * sl st in next 4 sts, hdc in next 4 sts; rep from * around, sl st first ch, turn.

Rep Rnds 1-4, 4 times, for a total of 20 rnds with Crown and Hat Body. Remove marker and fasten off.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Pull tail at Crown Shaping taut to close Magic Circle. Weave in ends.

Make a 3" pom-pom and secure to top of Hat.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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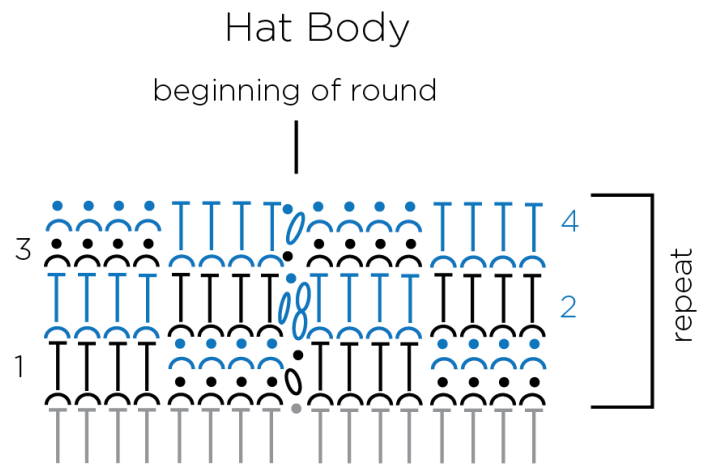
