Weekend Water Bottle Holder

DIFFICULTY

Easy

SIZES

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Height *(lying flat and excluding strap)*: 7½" Circumference: 11½"

MATERIALS

<u>Universal Yarn Cotton Supreme Speckles</u> (100% cotton; 100g/180 yds)

• 1005 Peachy - 1 skein

Hook: US Size H/8 (5 mm) or size needed

to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

14 sts x 10 rows = 4" in hdc Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

PATTERN NOTES

Don't get thirsty on the go! Stay hydrated in style with this adorable water bottle holder. It's made to accommodate wide water bottles or can be finished a few rows short to hug around standard sizes. Whatever water container you choose, dress it up with this cute holder!

This holder is crocheted in the round from the bottom up. The piece seamlessly transitions into creating the strap with short rows, then is finally fastened off to sew the strap to the opposite side.

STITCH GUIDE V Stitch (V st)

Sk st, [dc, ch, dc] in next st, sk st - 3 sts.

Magic Circle

Make a circle with tail of yarn behind working yarn. Reach hk inside of circle made, yo with working yarn, pull up a lp. Yo, ch indicated number of chs to begin patt. Once Rnd 1 of patt is est'd, pull tail of yarn taught.

PATTERN BEGINS WATER BOTTLE HOLDER

Base

Create a magic circle.

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), 9 hdc in circle, join with sl st to top of beg ch-2 - 10 hdc.

Rnd 2 (Inc Rnd): Ch 2, hdc in same st, * 2 hdc in next st; rep from * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch-2 - 10 sts inc'd, 20 hdc.

Rnd 3 (Inc Rnd): Ch 2, 2 hdc in next st, * hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st; rep from * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch-2 - 10 sts inc'd, 30 hdc.

Rnd 4 (Inc Rnd): Ch 2, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, * hdc in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st; rep from * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch-2, do not fasten off - 10 sts inc'd, 40 hdc.

Body

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), hdc in each st around, join with sl st to top of beg ch-2 - 40 hdc.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, V st across next 3 sts, dc in next st, * dc in next st, V st across next 3 sts, dc in next st; rep from * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch-3 - 40 sts total; 8 V sts, 16 dc.

Rnd 3: Ch 3, V st in V st dc in dc, * dc in dc, V st in V st, dc in dc; rep from * around, join with sl st to top of beg ch-3.

Rnds 4-10: Rep Rnd 3.

Rnd 11: Ch 2, hdc in each st and sp around, join with sl st to top of beg ch-2 - 40 sts total; 8 V sts, 16 dc

Rnds 12-13: Rep Rnd 11, do not fasten off.

Strap

Row 1: Ch 2, hdc in next 5 sts, turn - 6 hdc. Rep Row 1 until Strap is approx. 41 inches, or desired length when folded in half. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Assembly

Using a tapestry needle, sk 14 sts from the base of the Strap and whipstitch the end of the Strap into the next 6 sts. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.
