







Woven Sky Throw

SIZES

Small (Large)
Shown in Small size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 42 (69)"
Width: 31¼ (50½)"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Major* (100% acrylic; 200g/328 yds)

117 Graphite (MC) – 2 (5) skeins
 104 Pebbles (CC) – 2 (5) skeins

Needles: US Size 10½ (6.5 mm) 32" circular needle *or size needed to obtain*

gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

12 sts x 18 rows = 4" in St st Save time, check your gauge.

THROW

With CC, cast on 77 (133) sts.

Base Triangles

Row 1 (WS): P2; turn. Row 2 (RS): K2; turn.

Row 3: P3; turn.

Row 4: K3; turn.

Row 5: P4; turn.

Row 6: K4; turn.

Row 7: P5; turn.

Row 8: K5; turn.

Row 9: P6; turn.

Row 10: K6; turn.

Row 11: P7.

Rep these 11 rows, 10 (18) more times for a total of 11 (19) Base Triangles; turn.

TIER 1

(With MC.)

Right Side Triangle

Row 1 (RS): K2; turn.

Row 2 (WS): P2; turn.

Row 3: K1, m1, ssk; turn.

Row 4: P3; turn.

Row 5: K1, m1, k1, ssk; turn.

Row 6: P4; turn.

Row 7: K1, m1, k2, ssk; turn.

Row 8: P5; turn.

Row 9: K1, m1, k3, ssk; turn.

Row 10: P6; turn.

Row 11: K1, m1, k4, ssk.

Left Leaning Rectangles

* With RS facing, pick up and knit 7 sts along next

edge; turn.

Rows 1-13 (WS): P7; turn.

Rows 2-12 (RS): K6, ssk; turn.

Row 14: K6, ssk.

Rep from * 9 (17) more times – 10 (18) Left

Leaning Rectangles.

TIER 2

(With CC)

Left Side Triangle

With RS facing, pick up and knit 7 sts along edge

of last Triangle or Rectangle; turn.

Row 1 (WS): P2tog, p5; turn.

Row 2 (RS): K6; turn.

Row 3: P2tog, p4; turn.

Row 4: K5; turn.

Row 5: P2tog, p3; turn.

Row 6: K4; turn.

Row 7: P2tog, p2; turn.

Row 8: K3; turn.

Row 9: P2tog, p1; turn.

Row 10: K2; turn.

Row 11: P2tog.

Right Leaning Rectangles

With WS facing, pick up and purl 6 sts along edge

of Triangle just worked; turn.

* Row 1-13 (RS): K7; turn.

Row 2-12 (WS): P6, p2tog; turn.

Row 14: P6, p2tog.

With WS facing, pick up and purl 7 sts along next

edge; turn.

Rep from * 10 (18) more times – 11 (19) Right

Leaning Rectangles.

Rep Tiers 1 & 2, 11 (21) more times, then rep Tier

1, 1 more time.

UPPER TRIANGLES

(With CC)

Work a Left Side Triangle.

* Pick up and purl 6 sts along edge of Triangle

just worked.

Row 1 (RS): K7; turn.

Row 2 (WS): P2tog, p4, p2tog; turn.

Row 3: K6; turn.

Row 4: P2tog, p3, p2tog; turn.

Row 5: K5; turn.

Row 6: P2tog, p2, p2tog; turn.

Row 7: K4; turn.

Row 8: P2tog, p1, p2tog.

Row 9: K3; turn.

Row 10: [P2tog] 2 times; turn.

Row 11: K2; turn.

Row 12: [P2tog] 2 times, pass 1^{st} st over 2^{nd} st -1

st rem on RH ndl.

Rep from * 10 (18) more times – 11 (19) Upper

Triangles. Break yarn and pull through last st to

secure.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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BORDER

With MC and RS facing, pick up and knit 112 (210) sts evenly along side of throw. Work even in garter st until Border meas approx. 2¼", loosely bind off sts. Rep for other side.

With MC and RS facing, pick up and knit 94 (150) sts along bottom of throw. Work even in garter st until Border meas approx. 2¼", loosely bind off sts. Rep for top of throw.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends, wash and block to Finished Measurements.

Abbreviations

approxapproximatelyCCcontrast colorgarter stknit every row

k knit

m1 insert left needle from front to

back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st

inc'd)

MC main color meas measures ndl needle purl rep repeat

ssk slip next 2 sts individually

knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops

(1 st dec'd)


