### SIZES

One

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 69"

Length: 24"

### MATERIALS

**Rozetti Yarns Alaska** (44% acrylic, 26% polyamide, 15% alpaca, 15% superwash fine merino wool; 50g/246 yds)

- 902 Peach Puff (A) – 2 skeins (see pattern notes)
- 905 Stormy (B) – 2 skeins (see pattern notes)

**Hook:** US Size G-6 (4 mm) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

### GAUGE

5½ reps x 9½ rows = 4" in Mesh patt

**Save time, check your gauge.**

*Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat!*

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## PATTERN NOTES

This light and lofty rectangular stole is generously sized but works equally well as a scarf. It's crocheted lengthwise in a very easy all-over mesh pattern. The ending edge of the mesh pattern naturally forms cute scallops. After the main stole is complete, an edging is added to the beginning edge so that the two sides match. Grab your two favorite shades of Alaska and get to hooking!

The sample pictured took exactly two balls of each color. You may wish to purchase an extra skein of each (for a total of 3 skeins per color) in order to ensure that you do not run out.

## Mesh

*(begins with multiple of 3 chs)*

**Row 1:** \* Sc in second ch from hk, ch 3, sc in next ch, sk next ch; rep from \* to last 2 chs, sc in next ch, ch 3, sc in last ch, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, [sc, ch 3, sc] in each ch-3 sp across, turn.

Rep Row 2 for patt.

## STOLE

With A, ch 276.

## Stripe 1

**Row 1:** Work Row 1 of Mesh patt – 92 ch-3 sps.

**Rows 2-7:** Rep Row 2 of Mesh patt, 6 times, finishing the last sc of the final row with B. Cut A, cont with B.

## Stripe 2

**Rows 1-14:** Rep Row 2 of Mesh patt, 14 times, finishing the last sc of the final row with A. Cut B, cont with A.

## Stripe 3

**Rows 1-12:** Rep Row 2 of Mesh patt, 12 times, finishing the last sc of the final row with B. Cut A, cont with B.

## Stripe 4

**Rows 1-14:** Rep Row 2 of Mesh patt, 14 times, finishing the last sc of the final row with A. Cut B, cont with A.

## Stripe 5

**Rows 1-8:** Rep Row 2 of Mesh patt, 8 times. Fasten off.

## Edging

Join A to beg-ch edge.

**Row 1:** Ch 1, \* [sc, ch 3, sc] bet sc from Row 1 of Stripe 1; rep from \* to end – 92 ch-3 sps. Fasten off.

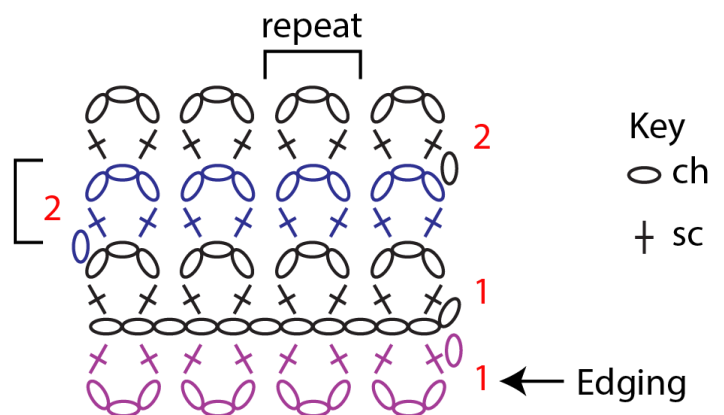
## FINISHING

Weave in ends. Run blocking wires along all edges of Stole. Pin to blocking board. Steam or wet block to open up Mesh patt.
