SIZES

6-8 (10-12, 14-16) year Shown in 14-16 year

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest: 29 (32, 35)" Length: 17½ (18½, 19½)"

MATERIALS

Fibra Natura Dona (100% extrafine superwash merino; 50g/126 g)

• 111 Sweet Pea – 7 (9, 11) balls Needles: US Size 5 (3.75 mm) straight, 16" & 24" circular or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, stitch holders, cable needle

(cn)

GAUGE

22 sts x 29 rows = 4" in St st Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

This adorable pattern features an adorable cabled yoke with soothing stockinette stitch throughout the body. It's perfect for the most knit-worthy kids in your life (and for kids who knit, too!)

Front, Back, and Sleeves are knit flat from the bottom up. After binding off underarm sts, all pieces are joined, and the yoke is worked upward in the round. The yoke begins with raglan shaping up to the cabled portion. Decreases throughout the cabled portion occur within the patterning itself.

STITCH GUIDE

4x4 Right Cross (RC): SI next 4 sts to cn and hold in back, k4 from left ndl, k4 from cn.

K2, P2 Ribbing

(multiple of 4 sts + 2)

Row 1 (RS): * K2, p2; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2. **Row 2 (WS):** * P2, k2; rep from * to last 2 sts, p2. Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

SLEEVES

Cast on 30 (34, 38) sts. Work in K2, P2 Ribbing for $1\frac{3}{4}$ ", ending with WS row. Work in St st for 2 rows, inc'ing 0 (0, 1) st on last row – 30 (34, 39) sts.

Inc row (RS): K1, m1, knit to last st, m1, k1 – 2 sts inc'd. Rep Inc row every 4 (6, 6) rows, 1 (6, 6) more time(s), then rep Inc row every 6 (8, 8) rows, 6 (2, 2) times – 46 (52, 57) sts. Work even in St st until piece meas 11 (13, 14)", ending with WS row. Bind off 2 (3, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows – 42 (46, 49) sts rem. Break yarn, place sts on holder.

FRONT

Cast on 82 (90, 98) sts. Work in K2, P2 Ribbing for $1\frac{3}{4}$ ", ending with WS row. Work in St st until piece meas $11\frac{1}{4}$ (13, $13\frac{1}{4}$)", ending with WS row. Bind off 2 (3, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows – 78 (84, 90) sts rem. Break yarn, place sts on holder.

BACK

Cast on 82 (90, 98) sts. Work in K2, P2 Ribbing for $1\frac{3}{4}$ ", ending with WS row. Work 1 row in St st, dec'ing 0 (1, 0) st – 82 (89, 98) sts. Work in St st until piece meas $11\frac{1}{4}$ (13, $13\frac{1}{4}$)", ending with WS row. Bind off 2 (3, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows – 78 (83, 90) sts rem.

YOKE

Working onto 24" circ ndl, k78 (83, 90) Back sts, pm, k42 (46, 49) Left Sleeve sts, pm, k78 (84, 90) Front sts, pm, k42 (46, 49) Right Sleeve sts, pm and join to work in the rnd – 240 (261, 278) sts.

Dec rnd: * K2tog, knit to 3 sts bef m, ssk, k1, sl m; rep from * 3 more times – 8 sts dec'd.

Next rnd: Knit.

Rep these 2 rnds, 5 more times – 192 (211, 230) sts rem.

Next rnd: Rep Dec rnd – 184 (203, 222) sts rem.

Next rnd: Purl.

Rep these 2 rnds, 4 more times – 152 (171, 190) sts rem.

Begin Cable Pattern

Note 1: This section is also fully charted for your convenience.

Note 2: When there are too few sts to fit comfortably on the 24" circ ndl, switch to the 16" circ ndl.

Rnd 1: * P6, k8, p5, pm; rep from * to end. Patt will be repeated 8 (9, 10) times across each rnd.

Rnds 2-4: * P6, k8, p5; rep from * to end.

Rnd 5: * P4, p2tog, 4x4 RC, p5; rep from * to end – 1 st dec'd each rep, 18 sts rem each rep.

Rnds 6-8: * P5, k8, p5; rep from * to end.

Rnd 9: * P5, k8, p2tog, p3; rep from * to end -1 st dec'd each rep, 17 sts rem each rep.

Rnds 10-12: * P5, k8, p4; rep from * to end.

Rnd 13: * P3, p2tog, 4x4 RC, p4; rep from * to end – 1 st dec'd each rep, 16 sts rem each rep.

Rnds 14-16: * P4, k8, p4; rep from * to end.

Rnd 17: P4, k8, p2tog, p2; rep from * to end -1 st dec'd each rep, 15 sts rem each rep.

Rnds 18-20: * P4, k8, p3; rep from * to end.

Rnd 21: * P2, p2tog, 4x4 RC, p3; rep from * to end – 1 st dec'd each rep, 14 sts rem each rep.

Rnds 22-24: * P3, k8, p3; rep from * to end.

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Rnd 25: * P3, k8, p2tog, p1; rep from * to end – 1 st dec'd each rep, 13 sts rem each rep.
Rnds 26-28: * P3, k8, p2; rep from * to end.
Rnd 29: * P1, p2tog, 4x4 RC, p2; rep from * to
end – 1 st dec'd each rep, 12 sts rem each rep.
Rnds 30-32: * P2, k8, p2; rep from * to end.
Rnd 33: * P2, k8, p2tog; rep from * to end – 1 st
dec'd each rep, 11 sts rem each rep.
Rnds 34-35: * P2, k8, p1; rep from * to end.
Rnd 36: * P2tog, k2, k2tog, ssk, k2, p1; rep from *
to end – 3 sts dec'd each rep, 8 sts rem each rep.

Next rnd: Purl.

Collar

Rnds 1-5: * P1, k2, p2, k2, p1; rep from * to end. Bind off all sts in patt.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block piece to finished measurements. Sew Sleeve, underarm, and side seams.




