

PATTERN COLLECTION: *ACCESSORIES*



Persephone Handpaints CowlDesigned by Michael del Vecchio

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 28"

Length: 8"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Bamboo Bloom Handpaints (48% rayon from bamboo, 44% wool, 8% acrylic; 100g/154 yds)

• 302 Koi Pond – 1 hank Needles: US Size 10 (6 mm) 16" circular needle or size to obtain gauge Notions: stitch marker, tapestry needle

GAUGE

16 sts x 22 rows = 4" in St st, measured over bamboo sections of yarn **Save time, check your gauge**

ABBREVIATIONS

K Knit Sl st slip stitch

St st Stockinette stitch

PATTERN NOTE

Entire cowl is worked in St st. Knit every stitch until you come upon a wool section of yarn, then double wrap all st as follows: [Insert ndl into next st, wrap yarn around ndl twice, pull loops out of st and sl st off LH ndl] 3 times, knit to next wool section. On the next rnd, cont double wrapping yarn on wool sections and working all double-wrapped sts as: knit into first loop of double wrap, sl second wrap from LH ndl.

COWL

Cast on 100 sts. Place marker and join for working in the rnd, being careful not to twist. Knit 1 rnd without double wrapping any sts. Working even in St st, knit every stitch across bamboo sections of yarn and work 3 double wrapped sts per each section of wool yarn until cowl measures 8". Knit 1 rnd without double wrapping any sts. Bind off all sts loosely.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends.
