

PATTERN COLLECTION: *ACCESSORIES*



Shaded Garden Scarf

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 90" (not including fringe)

Width: 7"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Uptown Bulky* (100% anti pilling acrylic; 100g/87 g)

- 403 Bright Yellow (A) 1 ball
- 407 Baby Pink (B) − 1 ball
- 408 Old Rose (C) 1 ball
- 410 Grass Green (D) 1 ball
- 411 lvy (E) 1 ball

Needles: US Size 10½ (6.5 mm) 32" or longer circular needle *or size*

needed to obtain gauge Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

12 sts x 24 rows = 4" in Slip Stitch

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

PATTERN NOTES

Slip all stitches purlwise with yarn in front (at the right side of the work).

All rows are worked from the Right Side. After each row, cut yarn and slide sts back to the other end of the needle. Before beginning each row, leave an 8" tail for fringe. After ending a row, cut yarn leaving an 8" tail for fringe.

STITCH GUIDE

Slip Stitch Pattern

(even number of sts)

Row 1 (RS): * K1, sl 1; rep from * to last 2 sts, end k2.

Row 2 (RS): K2, * sl 1, k1; rep from * to end. Rep Rows 1 & 2 for patt.

SCARF

With crochet hook and waste yarn, chain 280 (a few extra chains are included for ease of picking up stitches. With ndls and A, pick up and knit 270 sts through the back of purl bump from chains.

Row 1: With A, work Row 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

Rows 2 & 3: With B, work Rows 1 & 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

Rows 4 & 5: With C, work Rows 1 & 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

Rows 6 & 7: With D, work Rows 1 & 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

Rows 8 & 9: With E, work Rows 1 & 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

Rows 10 & 11: With A, work Rows 1 & 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

Rows 12 & 13: With B, work Rows 1 & 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

Rows 14 & 15: With C, work Rows 1 & 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

Rows 16 & 17: With D, work Rows 1 & 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

Rows 18 & 19: With E, work Rows 1 & 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

Rows 20 & 21: With A, work Rows 1 & 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

Rows 22 & 23: With B, work Rows 1 & 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

Rows 24 & 25: With C, work Rows 1 & 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

Rows 26 & 27: With D, work Rows 1 & 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

Rows 28 & 29: With E, work Rows 1 & 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

Rows 30 & 31: With A, work Rows 1 & 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

Rows 32 & 33: With B, work Rows 1 & 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

Rows 34 & 35: With C, work Rows 1 & 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

Rows 36 & 37: With D, work Rows 1 & 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

Rows 38 & 39: With E, work Rows 1 & 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

Rows 40 & 41: With A, work Rows 1 & 2 of Slip Stitch Pattern.

With A, Bind off all sts, kwise.

Carefully unzip crochet chain, placing resulting live sts on ndl. With A, bind off all sts, kwise.

FINISHING

Cut 10, 16" pieces of A, and 8, 6" pieces of B, C, D, and E. Fold each piece in half and attach to ends of corresponding edges. Tie fringe together. Trim fringe to 7". Weave in ends and block.
