



## Pattern Collection: Accessories



### **Trawler**

Designed by Rachel Brockman

### **SIZES**

Adult Small (Medium, Large)

### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

**Hat Circumference:** 18 (20 $\frac{1}{4}$ , 22 $\frac{1}{4}$ )"

**Depth with brim unfolded:** 10 $\frac{1}{4}$  (10 $\frac{1}{2}$ , 10 $\frac{3}{4}$ )"

### **MATERIALS**

**Universal Yarn *Bella Cash*** (60% fine merino superwash, 30% nylon, 10% cashmere; 50g/230 yds)

- 106 Oat (A) – 2 balls all sizes
- 115 Peacoat (B) – 2 balls all sizes

**Needles:** US Size 4 (3.5 mm) 16" circular, set of dpns *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Stitch markers, tapestry needle

### **GAUGE**

19 sts x 44 rows = 4" in Brioche Rib with two strands held together

**Save time, check your gauge.**

*Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat!*

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## PATTERN NOTES

Inspired by fisherman's hats, Trawler is a hat that features a handsome marled effect and stretchy brioche ribbing. This classic design fits easily into any wardrobe. This hat is knit seamlessly in the round from the bottom up.

## STITCH GUIDE

### Brioche Right Slant Decrease (BrRsl)

Sl 1 kwise, k1, pass the slipped st to LH ndl, pass the next st from the LH ndl over the first st. Place rem stitch on RH ndl – 2 sts dec'd.

### Brioche Left Slant Decrease (BrLsl)

Sl 1 kwise, brk the next 2 sts tog, pssso – 2 sts dec'd.

### Brioche Rib

*(even number of sts)*

**Set up Rnd:** \* Sl1yo, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 1:** \* Brk 1, sl1yo; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 2:** \* Sl1yo, brp; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnds 1-2 for patt.

## HAT

Holding one strand each of A and B tog, cast on 86 (96, 106) sts using the German Twisted method. PM and join to work in the rnd being careful not to twist sts. Work in Brioche Rib until piece meas 8" from cast-on edge, ending with Rnd 1.

### Shape Crown

*Note: Change to dpns when there are too few sts to fit comfortable on ndl.*

**Set up Rnd:** Work Brioche Rib as est'd over 40 (45, 50) sts, pm, cont as est'd over 3 sts, pm, cont as est'd over 40 (45, 50) sts, pm, cont as est'd to 3 sts bef end, pm, cont as est'd to end.

**Dec Rnd:** BrRsl, cont as est'd to 3 sts bef m, brLsl, sl m, cont as est'd to m, sl m, brRsl, cont as est'd to 3 sts bef m, brLsl, cont as est'd to end – 8 sts dec'd, 78 (88, 98) sts rem.

Rep Dec Rnd every 4 rnds, 2 more times, then rep Dec rnd every 2 rnds, 6 (7, 8) times – 14 (16, 18) sts rem.

**Next Rnd:** \* K2tog, rep from \* to end – 7 (8, 9) sts dec'd, 7 (8, 9) sts rem.

Break yarn and thread through 7 (8, 9) rem sts. Pull taut to close.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends and block.

## Abbreviations

<b>bef</b>	before
<b>brk</b>	bricoche knit – knit the stitch that was slipped in the previous row together with its yarnover
<b>brp</b>	bricoche purl – purl the stitch that was slipped in the previous row together with its yarnover
<b>circ</b>	circular
<b>cont</b>	continue
<b>dec('d)</b>	decrease(d)
<b>dpn(s)</b>	double pointed needle(s)
<b>est'd</b>	established
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
<b>kwise</b>	knitwise
<b>LH</b>	left hand
<b>m</b>	marker
<b>meas</b>	measures
<b>ndl</b>	needle
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>patt</b>	pattern
<b>pm</b>	place marker
<b>pssso</b>	pass slipped stitch over
<b>rem</b>	remain(ing)
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>RH</b>	right hand
<b>rnd</b>	round
<b>sl</b>	slip
<b>sl1yo</b>	slip 1, yarnover – bring the working yarn under the needle to the front of the work, slip the next st pwise, bring the working yarn over the ndl and the slipped stitch to the back
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>tog</b>	together

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
