

STATEMENT ON HEALTH & SAFETY OF THE COVERBIND COVERS

It is the policy of COVERBIND, that all its undertakings, operations, premises, plant and equipment are conducted and maintained to ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, the health and safety of all its employees, customers, the public and others who may be affected by its products or activities.

One of the more frequently asked questions regarding our products that relates to H&S is if the adhesive used in our covers has any components that during the binding process will create fumes or emissions that are dangerous for the customer. We can make the following statements:

- During the binding process there are no emissions, fumes or other components from the book binding glue used in the COVERBIND covers that impose a risk from a Health & Safety standpoint. All emissions are well below any thresholds set by regulatory authorities.
- The adhesive is classified as non-hazardous according to EU regulations and is approved by FDA in the US for indirect food contact (FDA 175.105).
