Thank you for purchasing the Zoology 1, 2nd Edition *Activity Supplies Kit*! If your children enjoy a fun, hands-on approach to learning, then this activity driven course will be engaging from cover to cover.

So that you will understand the organization and contents of this kit, please look through these introductory notes and comments. While we strive to include as many supplies as possible, it is impossible to include every item that will be needed. We assess the inclusion of each activity, or item, based on cost, long term availability of the item, allergy exposure, and ease of distribution. This is an incredible course filled with wonderful things to explore. It is imperative that you plan, in advance, for the activities which are not provided in this kit.

There are several activities involving **live insects**. You will need to secure the larvae and habitats for these activities:

- *Raise Painted Lady Butterflies*, activity 3.4, page 67.
- *Raise Ladybugs from Larvae to Adult*, activity 6.4, page 120.
- *Raise Mantids*, activity 7.2, page 134
- All of the supplies for the *Make an Ant Farm* activity, page 88, are included in this kit. However, you will need to gather your own ants or purchase ants to load into the habitat.
- The above insect supplies are available through *workshopplus.com* 1-888-393-5663, or other online suppliers.
- *Find Out Which Environment a Cricket Prefers*, activity 7.10, page 149. You will need to supply all items, including the crickets, for this activity. Purchase crickets from your local pet supply store or bait shop.

We assess the inclusion of each activity, or item, based on cost, long term availability of the item, allergy exposure, and ease of distribution. The following activities are not included in your supplies kit, based on one or more of the reasons listed above. Should you choose to complete these wonderful activities, you will need to provide **all** of the necessary supplies.

- *Make Honey Taffy*, activity 5.3, page 103
- *Make Wearable Dragonfly Wings*, activity 7.5, page 138
- *Find Out Which Environment a Cricket Prefers*, activity 7.10, page 149.
- *Make a Bird Feeder: Seed Feeder*, activity 9.6A, page 180
- *Make a Bird Feeder: Suet Feeder*, activity 9.6B, page 180. (Included in your kit is a *suet cake and mesh-bag* to hang the suet from a tree. Please enjoy the experience of making your own homemade suet according to the book instruction, at your convenience.)

- *Build a Nesting Material Station*, activity 12.2, page 242. *Make a Cup Nest*, activity 12.4, page 248. These delightful activities require seasonal materials from nature which are best supplied from a nature hike or from your own back yard. (A mesh-bag has been included in the kit as a substitution for the wire whisk, should you prefer this economical substitution.)
- *Build a Birdhouse*, activity 12.7, page 254.
- *Flying Fox Stuffed Animal*, activity 14.6B, page 298

Reading the Lesson Bag labels

Supplies are organized into bags according to the text’s lesson numbers. Supplies for **lesson one** are contained in **bag one**, etc. Because many items are used for more than one activity, each label not only identifies the items in the bag, but also directs you to the location of additional items that you will need. By replacing each reusable item to its original lesson bag, the labels will direct you through the kit with ease. The labels also reveal the items that you need to provide.

You will find that many activities require not only time and organization, but also require items that **you will need to provide**. Once you have everything ready to go, we believe that your study through this text will be a rewarding, informative, and enjoyable way of learning many new things about our Creator and the *Flying Creatures* He has made.

Clay Kit

Your children will enjoy the activities involving air-dry clay. The chart below reveals the distribution of the clay colors within the Clay Kit. Feel free to change the colors if so desired. Once opened, seal the remaining clay in an airtight container or bag. Be creative, have fun!

Things to Know

Activity 5.4

70 Cardstock Strips have been substituted for the 12 paper towel tubes. We suggest taping or stapling the cardstock strips into 1.5 inch diameter circles for the *Buzzing Board Game*.

Yellow Poster Board has been substituted for yellow paint. Use two pieces of corrugated cardboard, located in the *Miscellaneous Kit*, taped together. Lay the yellow poster board on top and secure with tape or staples.

When crafting the adorable *game pieces* from air-dry clay, make them very small or they will not fit into the rings when playing the game.

Paper- Mache Activities 8.9, 10.7, 11.7

News Print Paper has been substituted for regular newspaper. Your kit has allotted two sheets of news print paper for each activity.

Googly Eyes

Several activities call for Googly Eyes! Your kit has a full card of Googly Eyes of various sizes. Use the medium and large sizes when possible. The smallest ones will run out first. Your black marker, located in Lesson Bag 5 works very well to draw the eyes onto the clay should you run out of small sized Googly Eyes.

Glitter Markers

Glitter markers have been substituted for metallic paint in activity 7.4, and for both glitter and paint in activity 13.2.

Safety Instructions

- Thoroughly read all instructions for each activity.
- Scissors, wire cutters, needles, stoves, power tools, and kitchen knives are needed to complete some activities. Parents or other adults must supervise each activity.
- Never eat any ingredients unless the instructions specifically say to do so.
- Do not put any activity supplies in your mouth.
- Wear an art smock or apron to avoid damage to clothing.
- Tie back long hair from your face so it doesn't block your view or get caught in any equipment.
- Complete activities in a well ventilated area.
- Keep your work area clean.
