Application

Directions

Invert can and shake vigorously for 2 minutes after the mixing ball starts to rattle. Shake frequently during use. Hold upright and spray from a distance of approximately 15-30cm. For best results, apply 2 light even coats at 15-20 minute intervals rather than 1 heavy coat. Additional coats can be applied after 15-20 minutes. Touch dry in 15 minutes at 20°C. Fully cured in 24 hours at 20°C.

Clean up

Clear nozzle after use, invert can and spray for 3 seconds or until only propellant is expelled. Overspray can be cleaned with Mineral Turpentine or All Purpose Thinners.

Surface Preparation

For best results, apply to a clean, degreased, dry surface. Remove any residual rust and scale with a wire brush or other abrasive method. Clean the area to be treated with a non-residue solvent cleaner such as Boston Wax & Grease Remover. Prime the surface with a suitable Boston Primer.

Packaging

Storage/Shelf Life

Store in a cool place out of direct sun light.

Do not store over 50°C.

Health and Safety

Aerosols should be completely empty before disposing. Recycle if facility available or place in household rubbish. Always use in a well-ventilated area and avoid prolonged breathing of vapours. If sprayed in eyes flush with water.

Limitations

When painting over previously painted surfaces, check for compatibility on a small area first. Always check compatibility with substrate before use.
