DESCRIPTION

Bostik All Purpose Adhesive is a multipurpose solvent-borne adhesive, the dried film of which is virtually colourless and non-staining. It is easy to use and provides strong, water-resistant bonds with excellent ageing properties.

USES

Bostik All Purpose Adhesive will bond a wide variety of materials including metals, wood, glass, china, leather, felt, canvas, paper, cardboard, certain fabrics, PVC and various other plastics. It will bond all these materials to themselves or to each other as well as to plaster, stone and concrete.

Bostik All Purpose Adhesive is also excellent for bonding vinyl and plasticised PVC without the associated problems of migration that most other adhesives suffer.

Bostik All Purpose Adhesive is ideally suited for many assembly and repair applications in and around the home and other locations. Typical items on which it is used are handbags, luggage, lampshades, picture frames, upholstery, jewellery, books, china and marquetry pieces.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IMPORTANT: Before using Bostik All Purpose Adhesive, refer to the relevant Safety Data Sheet, available at www.bostik.com.au

PREPARATION

1. Make sure that the surfaces to be bonded are clean, dry and free from dust, dirt, grease and any other contaminants.
2. Protect nearby polished, cellulose or any other solvent sensitive surfaces as the adhesive may spoil the finish.
3. Always point the tube away from you when opening and don't squeeze!

APPLICATION

4. To bond non-absorbent surfaces such as metal or glass, apply a thin film of adhesive to both surfaces. Allow 5 to 10 minutes drying time and then, having correctly positioned the surfaces, press them together firmly. The bond will be instant and non-adjustable.
5. If one or both surfaces are absorbent, apply a generous film of adhesive to one surface only and immediately join the two surfaces together under pressure. Immobilise the items until the solvent has evaporated. Using this technique initial bond strength may be a little lower.

CLEANING

6. Remove surplus adhesive with nail polish remover or acetone.
7. Dry adhesive is not easy to remove, particularly from sensitive surfaces where the solvent in the adhesive may have already caused damage. It is advisable to work carefully and protect such surfaces to reduce the problem.

PRECAUTIONS IN USE

Bostik All Purpose Adhesive will not bond polythene (polyethylene), polypropylene or Teflon. Bostik All Purpose Adhesive is unsuitable for use on polystyrene, cellulose paint, rayon, acetate fabrics and other man-made materials. This is because the solvent in the adhesive will damage the materials. Bostik All Purpose Adhesive is unsuitable for repairing pottery handles or other items that contain hot food and liquids.

STORAGE AND SHELF LIFE

Store for up to 24 months from date of manufacture when stored in the original, unopened packaging under dry conditions within the temperature range of +5°C to +25°C.

Store away from sources of ignition.
