

BREYERFEST® CHILDREN and YOUTH SHOW EXHIBITOR'S CODE OF CONDUCT 2019

The focus of the BreyerFest® Children and Youth Shows is to create an environment conducive to learning, fun, and fairness in which everyone can feel comfortable. The goal of this document is to set a standard of sportsmanship for the Breyer® Children and Youth Shows under which ALL entrants, their family/guardians, and their guests are bound.

Violations of this Code may result in removal from the show hall and forfeiture of entry fees. Forfeiture of any or all placings or prizes earned in the show is also possible. If you have concerns about a violation of this Code, please report them to the Show Managers or Head Steward immediately so that prompt action may be taken.

1. All entrants, their families/guardians, and their guests agree to abide by the rules of the show. Entrants and adults are both responsible for reading and understanding the rules of this show, which may be different from other shows in your area.
2. All entrants and their families/guardians attest that neither the entrant nor the Breyer models they are exhibiting at the Children/Youth Show have ever shown at any North American Nationals™ (NAN) show.
3. Decisions of the Judges, Stewards, and Show Managers are final.
4. Entrants, their family/guardians, and guests are expected to demonstrate respect at all times to fellow exhibitors, Judges, Stewards, Staff members, Breyer representatives, spectators, and Kentucky Horse Park staff. Should an issue arise that needs to be resolved, you agree to bring the issue to the Show Managers or Head Steward for resolution rather than acting on the issue independent of the Children/Youth Show Staff.
5. Displays of poor sportsmanship before, during or after the show is unacceptable. This includes questioning the staff over their decisions in an impolite manner, behaving disrespectfully towards entrants, their families/guardians/guests OR their entries, and making derogatory comments on the Internet regarding the same. Actions deemed inappropriate by the show staff may result in an entrant, their family/guardian or guest being asked to leave the show with no expectation of entry fee refund.
6. Inappropriate or disrespectful language is not permitted in the show hall and surrounding areas.
7. Pursuant to the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, possession of alcoholic beverages, illegal substances (including tobacco products held by a minor), or carrying weapons/firearms are not permitted at the Kentucky Horse Park and, by extension, at BreyerFest.
8. Breyer reserves the right to take and use photographs at any time during the show, and reserves all rights to use photographs for promotional purposes. Your entry to the show constitutes agreement to be photographed without expectation of remuneration.

This original form must be signed and returned the morning of the show in order for you and your family to enter the Alltech Arena. One of the show staff will check off your name as you hand in the form.

By registering for either the Children or Youth Model Horse shows, you are accepting the entire Code of Conduct. Entrants, their families, guardians, and guests therefore agree to abide by this Code of Conduct at all times.
