What to Expect

BreyerFest is all about celebrating horses, and with over 250 real live horses and THOUSANDS of model horses, there is LOTS to celebrate!

Even if you're a seasoned BreyerFest attendee, a lot has changed about BreyerFest over the years, and it's always good to have this handy list of reminders so you can plan your weekend accordingly. If you're new to BreyerFest, here is a great list of tips to make sure you have the best weekend ever!

- It's Kentucky in July, so our #1 tip is always come prepared for the heat. Drink plenty of water throughout the day and wear plenty of sunscreen – you can get a burn even if it's overcast.
- Dress comfortably! Wear good walking shoes and comfortable clothes. Closed-toe shoes are recommended as you may be up close to live animals and walking over various types of terrain. BreyerFest is held mostly outdoors on grass, arena footing (sand mixture), or pavement. As well, BreyerFest spans across many parts of the Horse Park and events and activities are in various locations – expect to do a fair amount of walking on site.
- If you need assistance and can't be on your feet all day, BreyerFest partners with ScootAround to offer guests scooter and wheelchair rentals. These can be shipped directly to your home or hotel, but users are responsible for getting them to the KHP. The KHP does not offer on-site scooter or wheelchair rentals, so if you need assistance, we recommend you take advantage of this service.
- Need a break from the sun? Take advantage of our FREE seminars and EQUUS Films, located in the air conditioned Visitor Information Center, running all weekend long! Misting fans are also set up in many of the tents to help keep guests cool.
- Make your own schedule. There is a LOT to do at BreyerFest and some activities do overlap. Be sure you don't accidentally register for workshops that are happening at the same time (more on Workshops on page 2). Most free activities are offered several

times over the course of the weekend so map out your scheduled activities FIRST.

- Expect a bit of a line near the Ticket Booth/Will Call (main entrance into BreyerFest) in the early morning for those looking to make the BreyerFest Stores their first stop. (More on where to find special models on page 6.) After 9:30 am there is generally no line for admission into BreyerFest, but the BreyerFest Stores will be busy for the morning hours.
- Bags larger than a Traditional-sized model (approximately 10") are not permitted in either of the BreyerFest Stores. **This includes rolling bags of all sizes, wagons, duffel bags, large purses or tote bags, backpacks, and all shopping bags.** For your convenience, there is a bag check location right outside the Walnut Schooling Ring. Please check your bag before you shop. The bag check is only meant for short-term storage, so please do not leave your bags for more than 60 minutes.
- Avoid stress and take advantage of the free shuttle service offered by BreyerFest. See more about the shuttles on pages 5 and 15.
- Remember to take in the beautiful Kentucky Horse Park while you're there! The KHP boasts the International Museum of the Horse and the fantastic breeds barn, which are included with your tickets!
- **Relax! Don't forget to enjoy your vacation!**

Planning Your Trip

Plan ahead activities (REGISTRATION OR PREP REQUIRED)

In addition to all the live horses hosted by BreyerFest, there are many other activities to participate in – some of these, however, require a bit of advanced planning or registration and you must be a VIP or All-Access ticket holder to participate in these on-site activities.

Workshops

BreyerFest offers thirty workshops on-site throughout the weekend that are open to VIP and All-Access ticket holders only and DO require pre-registration online. A selection of these sessions is also exclusive to VIP ticket holders. Workshops are offered on a variety of topics, and most are only one session during the weekend. **Please be sure to look at the full schedule online before registering for workshops – workshop registrations are non-refundable and non-transferrable.** Topics include sculpting, repair, painting, tack making, and model horse showing. Workshops will be hosted in the South Exhibit Hall of the Alltech Arena, which is on the lower level of the Arena and on the opposite side of the building from where the Model Horse Shows take place. This location has a dedicated shuttle stop on the KHP Loop shuttle route.

Model Horse Shows

BreyerFest is home to some of the largest model horse shows in the country – these shows are where you show your model horses as if they were real horses!

BreyerFest hosts an **Open Model Horse Show**, which is a fast-paced show geared towards experienced showers. Guests with VIP or All-Access tickets over the age of 13 can participate in the show, which takes place on Friday in the North Exhibit Hall of the Alltech Arena. This is on the upper level of the Arena and on the opposite side of the building from where Workshops are located. This location also has a



dedicated shuttle stop on the KHP Loop shuttle route.

On Saturday, BreyerFest hosts the **Youth and Children's Model Horse Shows** in the North Exhibit Hall of the Alltech Arena, open to VIP and All-Access ticket holders 16 and under. These shows are slower-paced and geared towards younger and newer showers with a focus on the educational experience. The Youth Show and Children's Show are separated by age: the Children's Show for kids 12 and under and Youth 13-16. These shows run concurrently and have the same class list. Adult Novice showers can participate in **Breyer Boot Camp** online in the spring to get them ready for the in-person Open Show.

Collectors with porcelain or china models are welcome to show in **Breakables**, which will be hosted online in the late spring and present show awards in-person during BreyerFest weekend at the Clarion Hotel. This show is open to VIP, All-Access, and Online Traditional Access ticket holders.

If resin models and medallions are more your speed, **Resin Renaissance** will be hosted in person at the Clarion on the Thursday of BreyerFest weekend. This show is open to VIP and All-Access ticket holders. VIP, All-Access and Online traditional access ticket holders can also participate in **Resin Futurity**, which takes place post-BreyerFest.

For rules and information, especially if you are a first-time shower or are coming back after a hiatus, please visit the BreyerFest Model Horse Shows page on www.breyerhorses.com. Diorama Contest

BreyerFest VIP and All-Access ticket holders are invited to participate in the themed diorama contest! Dioramas must be brought to the Hobby Center tent on the Friday of BreyerFest weekend between 9 am and 5 pm. Judging will take place after 5 pm and is not open to the public. Getting to BreyerFest

BreyerFest does not currently offer ground transportation to the event from local hotels during the day. Rideshare options are available, but are limited. We recommend renting a car for traveling during your visit if you arrive by plane. We also recommend that guests purchase their parking passes in advance to ease entry into the park. VIP ticket holders will receive a complimentary KHP parking pass as a part of their ticket book that is good all three days of BreyerFest weekend.

A shuttle is available from the Kentucky Horse Park and local partner hotels to the Clarion Hotel for evening activities. The hotels with an asterisk (*) in the "Where to Stay" section on this page are serviced by the Hotel Loop Shuttle. There is also a Clarion to KHP shuttle option for those wishing to leave their car at the Horse Park. Both shuttles run from 5:00 pm to 11:30 pm Thursday, Friday, and Saturday.

Please note that parking at the Clarion can be difficult. Parking is limited to hotel guests (those with reservations at the hotel) only. Those wishing to visit the Swap Meet or Artisans' Gallery are highly encouraged to take advantage of the shuttle service from the KHP or the local hotels (see list for hotels with shuttle service).

What's Included in Your Ticket Package

All guests will receive a packet in the mail that contains their tickets and wristbands for the event, as well your parking pass if you ordered one.

Each **VIP Access ticket** purchase will receive the following in their ticket book:

- VIP Entry Wristband, valid for all three days
- Celebration Horse Model redemption ticket, which can be redeemed at the Special Run Line Tent
- Event Stablemates 4-pack redemption ticket, which can be redeemed at the Special Run Line Tent
- Special Run Model redemption tickets, which can be redeemed any time at the Special Run Line Tent
- Limited Edition Model redemption tickets, which can be redeemed any time at the Special Run Line Tent
- VIP Swag pack redemption ticket, which can be redeemed at any time at the Special Run Line Tent
- Evening Show ticket, valid on the night you selected
- Complimentary KHP Parking Pass, valid all three days of the event

For each **All-Access ticket** you purchase, you will receive the following in your ticket book:

- Entry wristband, valid for all three days
- Celebration Horse Model redemption ticket, which can be redeemed at any time at Event Model pickup
- Evening Show ticket, valid on the night you selected
- Special Run Model Reservation tickets for the models selected for you – you must pay for these models at BreyerFest at the Special Run Line Tent. If you purchased your tickets after the preference form deadline, didn't submit preferences, or your selections were not available, you'll receive Wild Card Special Run tickets, which can be redeemed at the Special Run Line Tent. Models must be paid for at BreyerFest.
- Parking pass (if purchased separately)

For each **General Admission ticket** you purchase, you will receive the following in your ticket book:

- Entry wristband valid for all three days
- Event Stablemate model redemption ticket (Gambler's Choice), which can be redeemed at at Event Model Pickup
- Parking pass (if purchased separately)

Workshops, Breyer Lounge, and model horse show registrations do not have physical tickets and are not included in your ticket books. Please save your email confirmations for these activities. Names will be checked at the individual locations when you arrive to participate.

Bringing models home

Part of the fun of BreyerFest is finding the perfect horse (or horses!) to commemorate your trip! As a courtesy, BreyerFest hosts UPS, both at the Clarion hotel and in the Vendor Marketplace in the Covered Arena so that you can ship your models home safely. UPS will weigh, securely pack, and ship your models directly to your home so you can be sure they will arrive without having to deal with airport security or baggage handlers. We highly recommend guests who are flying take advantage of this service.

Getting Around the Park

Arriving at the KHP

Guests arriving at BreyerFest will be parked in either the Main Parking Lot or the Alltech Arena Parking lot. You will be directed where to park. If you are participating in a model horse show or have a morning workshop session and want to park up at the Alltech Arena, please use the LEFT LANE of the entry and have your parking pass visible. See the map on page 10 to see lot locations. If you are not a VIP ticket holder, we highly recommend purchasing your parking pass in advance for some savings and speedy entry into the park.

From the Main Parking Lot, head towards the BreyerFest Main Entrance/Ticket Booth (between the American Saddlebred Museum and the KHP Visitor Information Center entrance) for event entry, to purchase tickets, or to pick up tickets at Will Call.

From the Alltech Arena Lot, board a TICKET BOOTH shuttle to the Main BreyerFest Entrance. See page 15 for shuttle information.

If you're an All-Access or General Admission ticket holder and your ticket book is being held at Will Call, you can pick your tickets up starting on the Thursday before BreyerFest weekend, and all BreyerFest weekend long – until Sunday at noon.

There are TWO lines to get into BreyerFest, so don't just hop onto the first one you see. As you are walking towards the entrance to BreyerFest through the parking lot, the line that goes to the LEFT of the entry is for the BreyerFest Stores. The line that goes to the RIGHT of the entry is for people who either need to purchase tickets, or general Event Entry (guests who have tickets and just want to enter the event without going to a BreyerFest store first thing).

The BreyerFest Store in the Covered Arena **and** the tented BreyerFest Store in the adjacent ring **both** have inventory of **all** Limited Editions, current Breyer product, warehouse finds, and swag. If you want to be one of the first to shop in either of the BreyerFest Stores for those items, head to the BREYERFEST STORE line – look for signs along the roadway in front of the KHP entrance to the Visitor Information Center that say BREYERFEST STORE. This line is the **red** line on the map to the right. Limited Edition items, warehouse finds, and swag in the BreyerFest Stores are made available each day to ensure availability throughout the weekend, but generally do sell out by early afternoon. Visit early if these items are on your list!

Those in line for the BreyerFest Stores will receive a number for one of the two stores before gates open each morning. Only people in your group who want to shop need a number, but you must have a number if you want to shop. For example, if you and a friend both want to purchase models, you both need a number to shop. If you are accompanying a minor and only intend to purchase one of each item, you only need one number.

All Limited Edition items in these stores are limited to one of each available option per customer. When the numbers are distributed, everyone in your group who wants to shop must be present. **Breyer staff are not permitted to distribute multiple numbers to people – no exceptions.** As well, you must go to the store for which your number corresponds – one store's number does not work at the other store.

Please make sure you know which store you are shopping in. These numbers ensure that guests will be able to shop in the order in which they lined up outside the gate. Please be sure to head to the corresponding store line **FIRST** as numbers will be taken in order. If you miss your number, you will have to go to the end of the line (which can be very long).

If you need to purchase tickets, head towards the EVENT ENTRY line - this line is to the RIGHT of the entry, along the sidewalk in front of the American Saddlebred Museum. This line is the **green** line on the map to the right. Ticket windows will open at 9am on Friday and Saturday and at 8:30 am on Sunday.

If you have your tickets already, or after you pick them up at Will Call, you may head towards the red BreyerFest Store line if you want to shop OR the green EVENT ENTRY line if you just want to enter.

WILL CALL – ALL tickets for international ticket buyers must be picked up at Will Call. If you purchased your tickets after the advanced tickets deadline, your tickets will be waiting for you at Will Call. There is a Breyer-branded canopy tent outside of the ticket booth where you can pick your tickets up before the gates open on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday mornings. Alternately, you can pick your tickets up at the Clarion Hotel on Thursday between 10 am and 5 pm.



Shuttles

KHP LOOP Shuttles (**Red Route**) run in a continuous loop around the perimeter of BreyerFest – you can see the route on the map on page 15. On-board volunteers can assist with finding event locations and with general questions. Shuttle stop locations within the KHP are marked with tall blue SHUTTLE feather flags. See the map on page 10-11 for locations. Buses will pick up at each location approximately every 15 minutes.

There is a direct shuttle route between the Alltech Arena main entrance and the Ticket Booth at the main entrance that runs continually back and forth between these two locations. This route is the **Blue Route**.

Shuttles are also available in the evening hours for travel to the Clarion Hotel, the home of the Artisans' Gallery, Swap Meet, Best Customs Contest, Breakables Model Horse Show awards, and endless shopping! Parking at the Clarion is restricted to hotel guests only so we encourage visitors to take advantage of the shuttles. Two shuttle loops will run continuously from 5:00 pm to 11:30 pm Thursday through Saturday evenings, the Kentucky Horse Park–Clarion Loop (**Green Route**) and the Hotels Loop (**Yellow Route**), which services many of our partner hotels in Lexington. The KHP-Clarion Loop will stop at both the Main Parking Lot and Alltech Arena Parking lot. The Hotel Loop will service the hotels listed in the Travel Guide on page 3 noted with an asterisk*. Shuttles on these loops will pick up approximately every half hour.

Special Models

Each year a number of models are produced exclusively for BreyerFest. These models include the Celebration Horse, Event Stablemates, Limited Edition models, and Special Run models.

Celebration Horse

The Celebration Horse is a Traditional scale (1:9) portrait model of our celebrity horse for the year. VIP and All-Access ticket books include a model redemption ticket for this model, which can be redeemed at either the Special Run Line Tent or Event Model Pickup, depending on your ticket types, noted on page 3. See page 10-11 for tent locations. Tickets can be redeemed at any point over the weekend so there is no need to stand in any long lines! Your models are reserved for you.

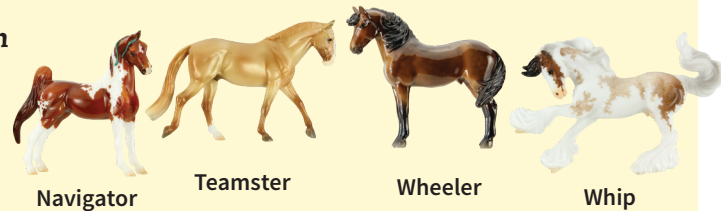


Event Stablemates

An Event Stablemates model (1:32 scale) is included with each General Admission ticket. These models range from beautifully designed realistic patterns, to fantasy colors, to portrait models of real horses, depending on the theme of each year's event – the total number of variations changes from year to year. The models are available as “Gambler's Choice” to General Admission ticket holders, meaning each ticket holder will receive one **randomly-selected** model from the line-up. General Admission Ticket holders will receive a redemption ticket(s) to redeem for their model(s) at the Event Model Pickup Tent. See Map for location. Tickets can be redeemed at any point over the weekend so there is no need to stand in any long lines.

A complete set of Event Stablemates models is included with each VIP ticket book, the ticket for which can be redeemed at the Special Run Line Tent at any time over the weekend.

The purchase of multiple General Admission tickets will not guarantee you will receive a complete set at the redemption tent.



Limited Editions

Limited Edition models are open to all guests (virtual and in-person) and are sold in each BreyerFest Store and online. An allotment of models is made available each day of BreyerFest to ensure models are available for sale throughout the weekend. These models generally sell through each day so be sure to visit the store early in the day. VIP Ticket holders, who have pre-selected and pre-paid for their Limited Edition models, will receive redemption tickets for their selected models in their ticket book, which can be redeemed at any time during the weekend at the **Special Run Line Tent**.

In addition to Traditional (1:9) scale portrait horses selected exclusively for each year's BreyerFest, the Limited Edition selection also includes other models and souvenirs themed to each year's event. These offerings typically include a 1:12 scale Freedom Series model, a 5" crystal model, a 6" huggable plush, 1:32 scale Stablemates models, and any other fun surprises we might think of! An allotment of these offerings is made available each day of BreyerFest to ensure availability throughout the weekend. These models generally sell through each day so be sure to visit the store early in the day if these items are on your list!



Special Run Models

Special Run models are available to VIP and All-Access in-person ticket holders. The total number of models offered varies from year to year, but typically there are at least 8 different options, including a non-horse animal option. Within each option we may or may not have included some surprises - like ½ the run is glossy or the entire model is a Surprise! With the “Surprise” model option you won't know anything about the model you are getting until you open it after you turn in your redemption ticket and purchase the model on site. Special Run models are not included with the cost of your ticket; they must be purchased at an additional cost.

VIP ticket holders will be the first to select and pay for their Special Run models from this year's lineup and will receive Special Run model Redemption tickets for their models in their ticket book prior to the event. VIP ticket buyers will select and pay for their Special Run models at the time of their ticket purchase. This selection is guaranteed and models must be picked up at BreyerFest.

All-Access ticket holders who have purchased their tickets prior to the Preference Form deadline in the spring (see ticket page for details) will have the opportunity to submit preference forms for their Special Run model choices and models will be selected and reserved for them based on these preferences and model availability. All-Access ticket holders will receive Special Run model Reservation tickets in their tickets books, which can be turned in for the corresponding models on site. **These models must be paid for at BreyerFest.**

All-Access ticket holders who do not purchase their tickets prior to the reservation deadline, did not submit preference forms, or if their preferred model selections were not available will still have the opportunity to purchase Special Run models at BreyerFest. These ticket books will contain Wild Card Special Run tickets in their ticket books, which can be redeemed on site at BreyerFest. Attendees with Wild Card Special Run tickets will be able to select their Special Run models from the remaining available options.

There will be no Special Run time slots so All-Access ticket holders can visit the Model Handout Tent to pick up their models anytime that is convenient for you during BreyerFest weekend! VIP ticket holders can pick up their Special Run models at the VIP line in the Special Run Line Tent.

Models are announced on the BreyerFest Blog prior to tickets going on sale so VIP ticket buyers can select and purchase their models in advance. Prices and quantities will be listed on the Exclusive Models page on BreyerHorses.com, and generally range from \$60 to \$85 each.

So, to sum up:

• **VIP ticket holders** will be able to select and purchase two (2) Special Run models and two (2) Limited Edition models at the time of their ticket purchase. This



selection is guaranteed and Special Run Redemption tickets will be included in their ticket books for these models. There will be no time slots so VIP ticket holders can visit the VIP line in the Special Run Line Tent anytime during BreyerFest weekend to receive their models.

• **All-Access ticket holders** who purchase their tickets prior to the Preference Form deadline will receive Special Run preference forms. Models will be assigned to these All-Access ticket holders based on submitted preferences and a model's availability and Special Run Reservation tickets will be printed for these models in your ticket books.

• **All-Access ticket holders** who purchase their tickets after the reservation deadline, do not submit preference forms, or your preferred models were not available when your spot in the virtual line is reached will still have the opportunity to purchase Special Run models at BreyerFest, but they will not have models reserved for them and may not have all model options available to them. These buyers will receive Wild Card Special Run tickets in their ticket books.



Special Run FAQ

Who can buy Special Run Models?

Special Run Models are only available to VIP or All-Access ticket holders on-site at BreyerFest. Online Traditional Access ticket holders will have access to a selection of this year's Special Run models, as well. More information on this can be found in the [Guide to Virtual BreyerFest](#).

How do I select my models?

VIP ticket holders will be able to select and pay for their Special Run models and a selection of Limited Edition models at the time of their ticket purchase. This selection is guaranteed.

All-Access ticket holders who purchase their tickets prior to the reservation deadline will complete an online preference form, in advance of BreyerFest. Models will be assigned to these All-Access ticket holders based on preference forms and model availability. Once models have been assigned, these All-Access ticket holders will receive model Reservation tickets in their ticket books and models can be picked up and paid for on site at BreyerFest. There will be no time slots so you can pick up your models anytime during BreyerFest weekend. These models are reserved for you.

All-Access ticket holders who purchase their tickets after the reservation deadline, do not submit preference forms, or their preferred models were not available when their spot in the virtual line is reached will still have the opportunity to purchase Special Run models, but will not have their models reserved for them. These ticket holders will receive Wild Card Special Run tickets that allow them to purchase Special Run models at the Special Run Line tent from the remaining available options. This may not include all model options, as some models may sell completely through to satisfy reservations.

How many models can I buy?

Each VIP or All-Access ticket allows the ticket holder to purchase up to two (2) Special Run models per ticket.

VIP ticket holders will have the first opportunity to select and purchase their two (2) different Special Run models. This selection is guaranteed. From the remaining models, each All-Access ticket holder will be able to purchase up to two (2) different Special Run models from either the models that have been assigned to them based on their submitted preference forms or what is available following the reservation deadline in the spring.

What if I don't like the models selected for me?

With so many beautiful models each year, there is something for everyone to get excited about. However, we understand that the models selected for an All-Access ticket holder might not be their top picks. Not to worry! Trades at BreyerFest are common, so we recommend you trade your reservation ticket with another guest on site.

Can I buy more than one ticket to have access to more Special Run Models?

Guests are welcome to purchase multiple All-Access tickets

on an account to increase their chances of collecting the complete line of Special Run Models. However, Breyer reserves the right to limit ticket purchases at our discretion and issue refunds if necessary.

How does model redemption work?

VIP ticketholders can stop by the VIP Line at the Special Run Line Tent at any time during BreyerFest weekend to redeem their tickets for their pre-selected and pre-paid Special Run models.

All-Access ticket holders will receive model Reservation tickets in their ticket books, but **these models must be paid for on site at BreyerFest**. There will be no time slots so simply head to the All-Access Lines at the Special Run Line Tent anytime during the weekend and present the reservation tickets found in your ticket book to a BreyerFest staff member to receive your models.

If you're an **All-Access** ticket holder with **Wild Card** Special Run tickets, head over to the Wild Card line at the Special Run Line Tent to select and pay for your models from the remaining selection.

International All-Access ticket holders can pick up their tickets at the Clarion Hotel before BreyerFest or during BreyerFest at the Will-Call booth. 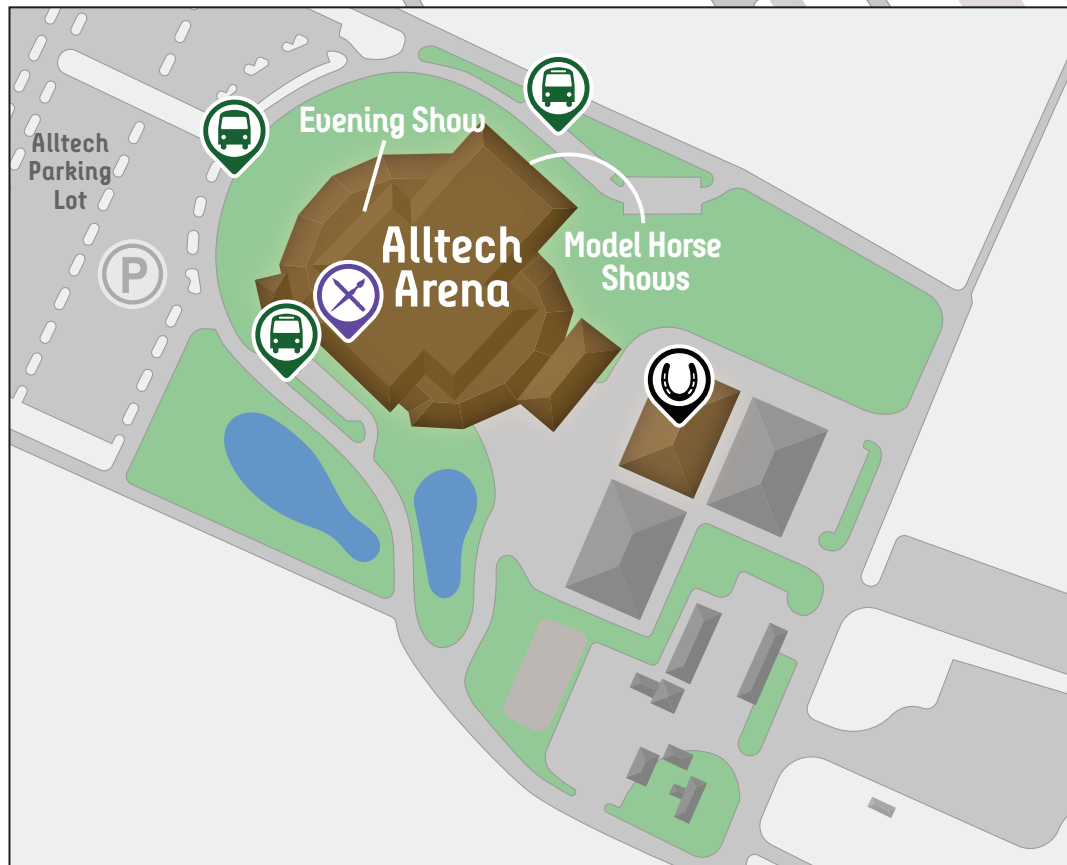

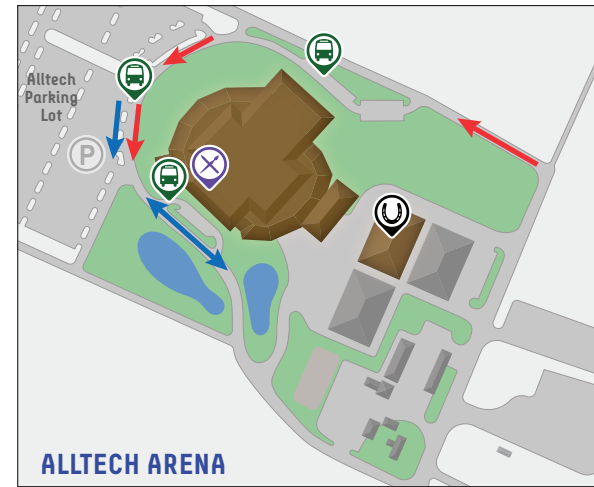

Get Ready For Your FIRST MODEL HORSE SHOW

“Original Finish” means a Breyer horse straight out of the box, with no alterations. Models can’t be repainted or changed in any way.



What will the judge look for? If it’s an Arabian class, the judge will look for the ideal conformation and characteristics of the breed, as well as colors allowed. For similar models in the class, the judge will look for great condition relative to its age or rarity, and since each Breyer model is hand-painted, nice shading and highlights. The best models in the class win the top ribbons and awards!



Once you’ve got a show and date, it’s time to prepare. Bring what you love, but also bring the nicest horses in your collection. “Nice” does not mean “most expensive,” but rather, your horses with the least flaws (like rubs in the paint – check eartips and hooves! – or warped legs), and nice shading.

Check out the Event Calendar on BreyerHorses.com for a show in your area! Always make sure to read the show packet, but don’t hesitate to contact the show holder with questions and let them know that you are new to showing.

When you’ve selected your horses, it’s time to clean! Take a damp soft rag or towel and run it over each horse. Make sure to get between the ears and through manes and tails!



Next, you need to give your horses a breed and a name. Most model horse shows require hang tags attached to the back hoof of your horse. On one side of the tag, you’ll put your horse’s name, and your initials or identifying credentials. Name your horse whatever you’d like! It does not have to be the Breyer manufactured name. On the other side, you’ll write down the breed. Be sure to look up the breed characteristics to make sure it’s a good match for your horse.



With your horses cleaned and tagged, it’s time to pack! Sewn cushioned pouches, such as Breyer’s Pony Pouches offer protection and less bulk and time needing to wrap and unwrap. Alternatively, you can use bubble wrap or old t-shirts. Carefully place your models in a sturdy tote for transport.

When you get to the show, you will want to lay down a blanket on your table and line up your horses. Follow along with the show announcer and listen for your class to be called. Place the model in the show ring and get ready to have some FUN!
