Updated March, 2024

The following list will tell you where to show your horse according to its breed; please check this list before asking which halter class to put your horse in. Horses must be shown in their appropriate class, according to this list. If you can't find a breed here or have a question, contact Show Manager Michelle Masters at breyerfestopenshow@gmail.com.

HOW TO USE THIS DOCUMENT: It should open as a searchable document (you may need to enable editing). Open the Search feature on your computer to find the breed you're looking for. You can also save it as a pdf, which will be searchable as well.

Class numbers follow each section title: RR = Regular Run, SR = Special Run, LR = Limited Run (in Collectibility), OOAK = One-of-a-Kind (in Collectibility), CM = Customized, FO = Foals, MI = Minis **In the Special Run Division**, you will need to cross-reference the Run Classification List to determine which subdivision to enter for each model.

NOTE: All mixed breed horses should show in the Mixed Breed class in the section where the breeds of their cross are shown, or where the breed that dominates their type is shown. The "All Other Mixed Breeds" class should include any horse that is a cross of breeds from different sections and does not exhibit obvious characteristic of either type. For example, a TB/QH cross that looks as much Quarter Horse as Thoroughbred could be shown here. "Grade" refers to a horse whose breeding is unknown or is a mix of several different breeds; these horses show with "All Other Mixed Breeds". You can put "Grade" on the horse's tag; there is no need to list numerous breeds.

Cimarron Horse - refers to a once-domesticated feral horse (Argentina)

French Chaser – refers to any French-bred racing horse that can't be registered as a TB – an English term for AQPS horses

Half-Saddlebred – a registry only

International Striped Horse - a registry for brindle pattered horses

Palouse – not a breed; was a name settlers used when referring to spotted horses; became the Appaloosa

Perkehner Horse - a registry for "misfit" animals with "outstanding personality peculiarities"

Sportaloosa – this is a registry, not a breed – show horse in proper breed class
