The BreyerWest 2024 Open Show is for Breyer & Breyer-produced CollectA models only!

NEW for 2024: BreyerWest will be a NAMHSA member show. Any first or second place received in a NAN-eligible class will qualify the entry for North American Nationals (NAN) for 2024-2028. For more information check out the [NAMHSA website](#).

General Information

The show will be held during the [Rocky Mountain Horse Expo](#) at the **National Western Complex** in Denver, Colorado – March 15-17, 2024. To enter the venue for the show as well as the rest of BreyerWest daily, tickets must be purchased for entry to the Expo – there are no additional entry tickets for BreyerWest other than your registrations for specific BreyerWest activities, like the Open Show. BreyerWest entrants will be able to load-in via the South entrance of the Expo, near their Will Call window. As you are facing the building from the outside, these are the doors on your left. **Showers may enter the show hall at 8am, and the show will begin promptly at 9am. Please do not arrive at the BreyerWest area prior to 8 am. We are expected to vacate the hall promptly at 6pm.** Much of the area around the Complex is under construction and traffic can be an issue so please plan accordingly. The show will end on time at 5pm, and entrants are expected to be able to pack up within one hour of the end of the show.

BreyerWest is open to the public and the public will be encouraged to watch, ask questions, and learn about the hobby. At this show, attendees are ambassadors of the hobby and participation in educating the public and sharing great hobby experiences will be appreciated. The BreyerWest show area will be 'open' on 3 sides with a 3' tall curtain barrier. The show will provide some "please don't touch" signs but it is recommended that you provide your own.

Lunch: The show lunch break is 30 minutes. There are several food vendors at the Expo and bringing personal food/lunch is permitted. Please note that the food vendors do get very busy right at noon!

Table space and assignments: Half table space is ½ of one 30" x 8' table with two chairs, or if a full space entry will have one full 30" x 8' table with two chairs. Please bring a personal table cover as they are not provided. All empty tubs/boxes must be placed under the table to keep the isles clear. With SIX Open Show rings and multiple divisions at such a competitive show, entrants are encouraged to bring their best and not bite off more than they can chew with their show string. Things will move fast and frenetically. While there are no limits on halter class entries, please consider how much can be comfortably handled at one time.

General Show Information, Rules, Code of Conduct:

- The show entry fee does not include admission to the Expo and Expo admission is required to gain access to the show.
- Please **LISTEN** for all announcements! There will be six rings going at the same time so be attentive!
- On the show entry page entrants will have an opportunity to request who or to sit with in the show hall. The show holder will do their best to accommodate these requests.



- Behavior that is unsportsmanlike or discourteous will not be tolerated. This includes, but is not limited to, arguing with the Judges, Show Manager, or any show official; bad conduct; or the use of inappropriate language.
- No person or entity involved in the presentation of the show is responsible for any property loss, damage, personal injury, or any other criminal or tortuous conduct, and by entering the show, each entrant, vendor, or member of the public accepts sole and exclusive liability for any property loss, damage, or personal injury, or any other criminal or tortuous conduct that individual may cause.
- Please refrain from talking to a judge while they are judging. Judges will be happy to explain placings after a class, but their decisions are final. Please be polite and courteous and remember that entrants are paying for their opinion (even if an entrant doesn't agree with it). Please don't crowd rings that are being judged or loom over a judge's shoulder during judging.
- Children must be supervised at all times. Parents of unruly or disruptive children will be asked to remove them from the show area/event.
- Sales are not permitted at the show. Anyone found to be selling from a show table or within the perimeter of the show area will be asked to leave the show with no refund.
- Proxy showing is not allowed at this show. Entrants must be present at the show and place their own models in the show rings. Entrants found to be proxy showing will be asked to leave the show without a refund.
- Family-owned models are permitted to be shown by a member of that family.
- No smoking, alcohol, or pets are allowed.
- Each entrant is limited to 50 models TOTAL.
- Models in halter divisions may not cross-enter divisions.
- Models in halter divisions may show in one class only (CM is double judged).
- Models in the performance division may cross-enter halter but classes will not be held for them.
- Performance horses are limited to two classes only outside of a model's main focus division – please see Performance Division Rules for details.
- No per-class limit! If an entrant is under 50 total models, they may enter as many horses per class as they see fit.
- Please refrain from touching or picking up a model without the owner's explicit permission. Be aware of the surroundings. If an entrant breaks or damages an item of someone else's, they should be prepared to make restitution for it.
- Any model that was awarded any Overall Champion or Overall Reserve Champion in Halter or Performance at ANY past BreyerWest Live Show MUST BE retired and cannot show again at a BreyerWest show, even if ownership has



changed. This applies to Overalls only, not sectional champions. Winners from Breyer Boot Camp, Breyer Online Open Photo Show, or BreyerFest Open Show are not subject to this retirement rule.

Awards

Satin flats will be awarded up to 6th place in each class; rosettes and special Breyer awards will be awarded in each division to all Champions and Reserve Champions. Special Breyer awards will also be given for all Overall Grand and Reserve Grand Champions.

Entry Tags/Horse List

Please refer to the detailed instructions on the **Open Show Tag and Horse List Instructions** section. For entrants familiar with BreyerFest's tagging instructions, these are very similar. Entrants will receive their entry number within 10 days after they purchase their entry. If an entrant has not received an entry number 10+ days after purchasing a show entry Horse lists are due to the show holder by February 28th, 2024.

General Halter Class Rules

- Classes may be split at the judge's or show manager's discretion.
- Foals must show in the Foal section in the division where they qualify. If there are no foal classes (unrealistic/fantasy, for example), foals show with adults.
- Halters are NOT required or encouraged for Halter classes, but they are allowed. Please note that halters must be of the correct style for the breed and must fit properly or they could penalize the entry. Dolls/handlers may not be used in any Halter class.
- Unpainted Breyer "blanks" or partially painted factory culls are not permitted to show in any class.
- Horses are not to be shown in or with their box, or anything else that they came with except as noted in the Collectability Division
- OF or custom bases, or a small soft surface to lay a model on for stability purposes are allowed. If a horse is laying down, it is assumed the entrant gives the judge permission to handle and inspect both sides of the entry as needed.
- Horses in halter classes are not to be shown with props (backdrops, fencing, scenery, etc.), on "footing" (pieces of felt, etc.), with leg wraps, blankets, or any other accessories (unless molded on), except halters or soft laying surfaces as noted above.
- Documentation is allowed, and encouraged especially with rare/unique breed assignments, and should be kept to a maximum size of 8-1/2" x 11".
- All horses must have a named breed and gender on their entry tag.
- Breyer-produced CollectA models may show in OF Mini or CM, depending on their finish.
- Original Finish (OF) is any Breyer that has not been altered in ANY way after leaving the factory.



- Changes that are not allowed include but are not limited to: application of a glossy finish, Vaseline, or other product intended to make the finish shiny or clear nail polish or black paint applied to eyes or hooves.
- Minor touch-ups, like those done to rubbed ear tips, are acceptable. Models that have been professionally restored to factory condition may show as Original Finish, but keep in mind that work should be **undetectable**.
- Little Bit/Breeds of The World/Paddock Pals show in the regular size classes, not in mini classes. Mini classes are intended for models roughly 1:32 scale and smaller.
- CollectA models tend to fall somewhere in the middle, please check in with the judge *before* classes start that day to determine where to show the specific CollectA molds.

Regular Run Original Finish Halter

This division is ONLY for models available for purchase from any retailer or (not exclusively) via the Breyer website. Models that qualify for the Special Run or Collectability division are NOT allowed in this division. Models considered to be “variations” of a regular run model, including random glossies, will show in this division, as well as Collector’s Edition/Collector’s Choice models, Limited Editions, Ethereal Series, and purchased Treasure Hunt models. If there is a question about where the model should go, please ask the show manager.

- A note on random glossies – if the run number was released by Breyer in an official way (on the blog or other social media), that run number will determine where the model shows. If no quantity of glossies is known, those models will show in RR. Other exceptions to this rule include the glossy models given with year-end purchase on the Breyer horses website, those will show in SR because they are only available from the Breyer website at a certain time, with a certain coupon code.

Unusual or uncommon breeds should be accompanied by a description and/or photo that may not be larger than 8 ½ x 11 inches.

OF RR Judging Criteria

Entries will be judged on anatomy, biomechanics, color accuracy, conformation, and adherence to breed standards; and on quality of finish (including body paint/shading and markings), condition of the model, and the judge’s overall impression.

Special Run Original Finish Halter

This division is strictly for models that are limited in number and availability. This division includes, but is not limited to, the following: any model labeled "Special Run", Show Specials, Tent/Store Specials/Limited Editions, BreyerFest Celebration Horses, Breyer “Fun Day” models, Breyer Collector Club Event Models (Lonestar event, Passage To The Pacific, etc.) any model available only through JAH/Breyer Collector’s Club, Premier and Vintage Club models, and models available only from: QVC, JC Penney, StateLine Tack, Tractor Supply,



PetsMart, Toys R Us, Midwest distributors, USET, Montgomery Ward's, Sears, Wal-Mart or Target exclusives, UK Exclusives, WEG exclusives/re-issues, "Brick & Mortar" store specials, mid-state SRs, and Treasure Hunt bonus models received from Breyer upon submission of UPC labels are considered Special Run.

Glossed RRs purchased from the Breyer website with the year-end coupon code ("Collector's Club Appreciation Models") will show in SR, as we do not usually officially know the run number for those. Special Run models produced in a quantity of 160 or less must show in the Collectability/Limited Run section.

Unusual or uncommon breeds should be accompanied by a description and/or photo that may not be larger than 8 ½ x 11 inches. In this division, it is advisable to include a reference card that explains the run information for this model.

OF SR Judging Criteria

Entries will be judged on anatomy, biomechanics, color accuracy, conformation, and adherence to breed standards; and on quality of finish (including body paint/shading and markings), condition of the model, collectability/rarity/desirability of model, and the judge's overall impression.

Mini Original Finish Halter

This division is for OF models sized as Stablemates, CollectAs, and Mini Whinnies. Regular Run, Special Run, and Limited Run minis will show in this division. Unrealistic/Fantasy minis will show in collectability. Unusual or uncommon breeds should be accompanied by a description and/or photo that may not be larger than 8 ½ x 11 inches. Minis preferred to be judged for their rarity/collectability, it should be shown in the Collectability Division.

OF Mini Judging Criteria

Entries will be judged on anatomy, biomechanics, color accuracy, conformation, and adherence to breed standards; and on quality of finish (including body paint/shading and markings), condition of the model, and the judge's overall impression.

Collectability/OOAK/Limited Edition Rules

All models must be factory original finish. Any model that qualifies to show in this division may not show in any other halter division.

The One-of-a-Kind (OOAK) class includes test colors, BreyerFest Auction models, factory/artist proofs/prototypes, and goofs.

"Limited Run" is defined as models that were produced in runs of 160 or less. If showing a model that was produced in a quantity of 160 or less, it *must* show in the Limited Run division. Possible exceptions may include vintage SRs where quantities are not necessarily concrete but suspected to be low – many of those likely would show in the appropriate collectability class, and not in limited run.



Please ask the show manager or judge if there are questions about where a model fits best.

Entrants may show models with their official Breyer Certificate of Authenticity or other documentation that provides information on the model's origin to the judge. This is not required (though strongly encouraged) and should be kept to a maximum size of 8-1/2" x 11".

Collectability/OOAK/Limited Edition Judging Criteria

Entries will be judged on the Collectability/rarity of the model, the condition of model and the quality of finish, and the judge's overall impression. The collectability section will be judged heavily on rarity/age/desirability, while the Limited Run section will be judged more heavily on ABCs and finish.

Custom Rules

A custom (CM) model is a Breyer model that has been altered, such as adding hair mane/tail, repainting, sculpting, repositioning, or remade in any way. All horses shown **MUST BE** Breyer models, even if the customizing is extensive, the model must have a Breyer body as its foundation. **NO** full artist resin casts are allowed at this show, even if the original model that was cast was made from a Breyer. Resin, cast, or 3D printed parts are permitted as part of customized pieces, provided they comprise less than 25% of the total model. Customized CollectA models may show here, in the applicable mini classes.

Custom Judging Criteria

Entries will be judged on anatomy, biomechanics, color accuracy, conformation, and adherence to breed standards; and on workmanship (quality and execution of finish work, quality prep job, realism/accuracy/correctness of remaking if applicable), and the judge's overall impression.

Performance Rules

Performance is an OPEN division, meaning OF and CM models will compete together. Performance horses may show in their halter class as well, but please note that classes will not be held for a performance horse in another ring.

- **IMPORTANT:** Cross-entry within the performance section is limited to two classes outside of a horse's main focus section.

EXAMPLES: 1) a horse may show in the Western division (all classes) plus Native Regalia and Showmanship. 2) a horse may show in the Huntseat division (all classes), plus the Harness class and a Western Trail class. 3) a horse may show in several Other division classes, plus both Huntseat and Western Pleasure.

There will be a timed 10-minute set-up for each class. Space permitting, as soon as one class is closed, the next class may be called in a different ring. Entrants can set up props for the next class, but it will not be closed until entrants have had a chance to move horses over from the previous class. Poker chips will be



provided to indicate when an entry is ready (red – progress, green – ready) The timer will not begin until the immediately previous class has been announced as judged.

Please plan carefully and do not try to show more entries than can be reasonably handled. Practice set-ups at home, have props well-organized, and have horses tacked up before getting to the show.

Performance entries are limited to an 18"x30" space, although most set-ups should be smaller. Table space will be at a premium and this rule will be enforced. The only exception is a multiple horse (more than 2) hitch harness or a draft harness entry with a large wagon/cart.

Information cards on performance entries are encouraged but not required, Explanations, photos, diagrams, and patterns should be no more than 8 ½" x 11" total space per entry.

Performance Judging Criteria

Performance entries will be judged on how accurately they represent the event being shown. Entries should be correct, realistic, and presented with attention to detail. Please do the research so that entries are correct with reference to tack, props, the horse's position, gait, etc.

Dolls are allowed, but not required in any class except Showmanship.

Specific Performance Class Considerations:

Pleasure or Fine Harness: Vehicles are not required but are strongly recommended. This class is open to all breeds of horses or ponies showing in pleasure driving, fine harness, etc.

Pleasure Classes: Fences, backdrops, footing, props, & scenery are allowed in Pleasure classes. Remember the space and time limitations, please.

Other Performance Events include other types of costumes/regalia as well as any event that does not fit into Other English or Other Western.

Dressage entries must have a proper Dressage test and show where the horse is in that test.

Jumper, Cross Country, and Hunter Over Fences entries must have a jump/obstacle.

English Trail includes Natural and Arena type entries.

Cutting, Roping, Stock Work entries must have some type of livestock.

Reining, Western Riding and Western Horsemanship entries must have a proper pattern and show where the horse is in that pattern.

NEW for 2024: Because BreyerWest 2024 is a NAMHSA Member Show and a North American Nationals (NAN) qualifier, the **NAMHSA Breed Cross-Reference List will now inform model placement.** [The downloadable/printable PDF can be found here.](#)

NEW for 2024: There have been minor tweaks to the class list, **except for Customized.** Due to time constraints and workload for the CM judge, mini and color classes have been eliminated. However, the class list has been expanded and a workmanship judge has been added along with the breed judge. Splits are always an option if a class size becomes too large.

Limited Run china/resin models can show in their LR breed classes with the plastics, *or* in C414 if it's a model that technically has a realistic paintjob but would show better in a yellow card class.

Limited Run models that are technically realistic but would show better in a yellow card class may show in C412 if the owner prefers. Examples here would be Lionesse, Zuni, western horse/pony, etc.

All mixed breed horses should show in the Mixed Breed class in the section where the breeds of their cross are shown, or where the breed that dominates their type is shown.

"Grade" refers to a horse whose breeding is unknown or is a mix of several different breeds. You can put "Grade" on the horse's tag; there is no need to list numerous breeds. Grade horses show with "Other Mixed" by type.

In divisions that do not have a Mustang class, **Mustangs can show in Stock or in Spanish at the entrant's discretion** based on what body type their entry more closely resembles.

Breeds that are noted for a 'rare breed' class show in Other Pure, as **BreyerWest does not have rare breed classes.**



BreyerWest Tag & Horse List Instructions

All entrant IDs will be assigned by the show holder as entries come in. Entrant IDs will be sent via email to the email address associated with breyerhorses.com show entry order, with reminders posted in all places BreyerWest news is shared.

Please complete the following form (save it to your computer and type in the info) and email it as a .doc, google doc, or PDF attachment to heathermalone@mac.com. The window to register horses is January 3rd to February 28th, 2024.

Every entrant will be assigned a three-digit number. The first three numbers for each of the horses' ID number will be the entrant's number; the last three numbers should be the horse's number on your list, starting with 001, 002, 003, etc. For example, if your number is 182, then the 14th horse on your list would be #182-014. If your number is 008, then the 5th horse on your list would be #008-005.

All tags must follow the #123-123 format: Three digits-three digits. If your personal or regional numbering convention varies from this, please make new tags for this show. Do not put your horses name or your initials on the tag. No index cards please for show tags.

Each tag should have the horse's ID number, breed, and gender – see the example below. Tags will not be turned over in the ring, so you can use the back for the horse's name and/or classes entered if you'd like. Please print tags neatly and use only white tags, approximately 1 ¾ x 1 ⅛ inches in size. Appropriate tags are available at Amazon, Office Depot, Staples, Walmart, etc.

Division indicates "OF RR" or "OF SR", you do not need to specify which class each model is in.

Gender Abbreviations: Stallion = S, Mare = M, Gelding = G, colt = C, Filly = F

Common Breed Abbreviations: Quarter Horse = QH, Thoroughbred = TB, Warmblood = WB, American Saddlebred = ASB, Tennessee Walking Horse = TWH, Rocky Mountain Horse = RMH, Missouri Fox Trotter = MFT, Pony of the Americas = POA, Standardbred = STB, National Show Horse = NSH. All other breeds should be written out.

Minor changes & additions can be made on the day of the show. Original horse lists must be already submitted by February 28, 2024. Please do not submit brand-new lists! Add/Drop forms will be available at the show for small, last-minute changes.
