In 1482, the Duke of Milan commissioned Leonardo Da Vinci to create for him what would have been, at the time, the largest bronze horse statue in the world - standing at a massive 26 feet tall. In preparation for his creation, Leonardo did an extensive amount of research on horses, and even wrote two separate treatises dedicated to the project - one on horse anatomy and the other included detailed project plans for this commission. Leonardo's Horse, also known as Gran Cavallo, was unfortunately never created and the original clay model was ultimately destroyed.
