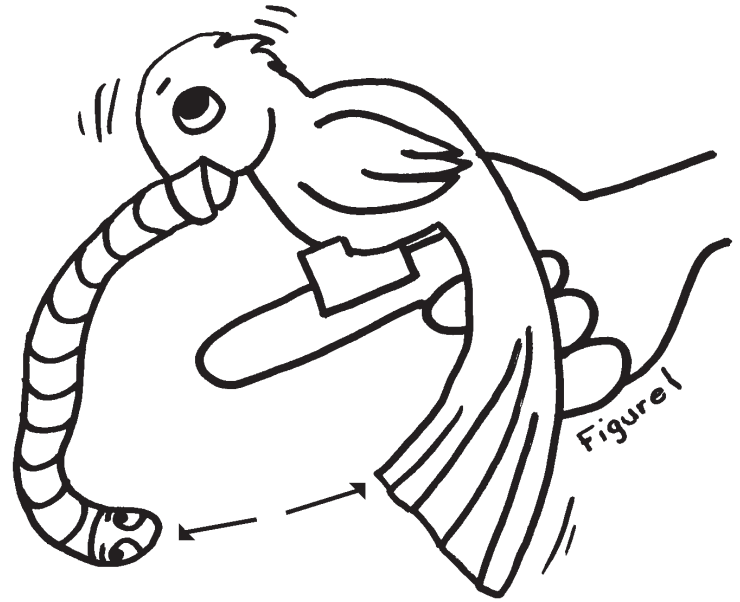


Balancing Birdie

1. Duplicate birdie and worm on tag board.
2. Color and cut out.
3. Cut slot A on Birdie
4. Cut slot B and push slot B into slot A.
3. Place Birdie on your finger. When you touch Birdie's head or tail he will tip back and forth.



Q. How can Birdie balance without falling off?

A. The Birdie's tail and worm make more weight below your finger.

Leave approximately 2 3/4 inches between worms head and birdies tail to balance.

Glue

Glue birds beak over glue area on worm. See Figure 1.

Try adding a little weight to the tail using clay. How does that affect the balance?
