


There are 11 pages of Rules Poster Cards with 3 rules cards per page. Bright Borders and Plain Backgrounds arranged on 11 x 8 1/2 inch pages (landscape). Cutting lines make it easy to cut the posters apart. There are plenty of cards to choose from. Use some of all of the cards.

## WHY ARE THE CARDS NUMBERED?

Each rule has a unique number. Each poster card includes its rule number in the bottom left corner. Compliment Cards match the rule cards and also include the rule number in the bottom left corner. A 'Student' Self-Check' form has a list of all the numbered rules. The numbers make it easy for students and teachers to locate the rules and the matching materials.


# STUDENT SELF-CHECK FORMS

Student Self-Check forms allow students the ability to choose a rule-goal to work on for the week/month. In the speech bubble they use words or pictures to SHOW the rule. In the box they write or draw things they can do to help accomplish their goal. Students evaluate and rate their own achievement using a positive Rating Scale:

- 0 = keep working on it
- 3 = good but I want to do better
- 5 = accomplished my goal.

Students rate the previous accomplishment and identify a new goal.





#### **BULLETIN BOARD**

Start the year with a CLASSROOM RULES bulletin board. A clip art header is included in this set so you can enlarge it to fit your bulletin board space. There are lots of ways to build community within a classroom using these cards.

One fun activity when introducing your class rules is for students to work alone or in small groups to develop a skit or poster that will give a visual example of the rule. This activity helps to build a collaborative and fun classroom environment.

Use your Classroom Rules Binder to store template and extra Poster Cards, Compliment Cards and guidelines.


#### Binder covers:

#### **COMPLIMENT CARDS**

Did the kids do an especially great job listening? participating? turning in assignments? Compliment them with a COMPLIMENT CARD. 33 Compliment Cards help reinforce individual students for specific behaviors or the entire class for accomplishing the Rule/Behavior of the day/week/month. Kids love collecting them. Attach them with a ring-clamp. The images and colors on the Compliment Cards match the images and numbers on the posters.

# CLASSROOM RULES RULES POSTER CARDS

### **Rules Poster Cards**

There are 33 Rules Poster Cards, 3 cards per 8 1/2 x 11 inch page. Laminate the cards (if possible) before cutting them out.

# **Formats**

Two sets are included, bright border cards and cards without borders so you can use a set that matches your classroom colors and themes.


# **Organizing the Poster Cards**

If you are not using all 33 cards at one time you can store templates and extras in the Organizing BINDER. They will be ready as you need them.

# **Numbers**

The small numbers in the bottom left corner match the numbers on the corresponding Compliment Cards. Reinforce positive behaviors with a compliment card for individuals or the entire class.

# CLASSROOM RULES COMPLIMENT CARDS

Reinforce positive behaviors with a compliment card!

#### **DESCRIPTION**

There are 37 pages of Compliment Cards that match each rule.

**4 variety-pages** include all the cards (1 - 33). Print this set if you are using all or most of the Rules Cards.

33 pages, each with one set of the same rules per page. If you are not using all of the rules cards you will be able to print just the pages containing the compliments matching the rules you will be using.

#### **PRINTING**

Print the cards out ahead of time. Card stock is the best choice especially if students are collecting them. There is room to punch a hole so cards can be collected by students and stored on a metal ring.

# ORGANIZING CARDS

Print one copy of each of the 4 variety pages as a reference and store them in your BINDER ORGANIZER

# NUMBERS

The small numbers in the bottom left corner of the Compliment Cards match the numbers on the Rules Cards. The Self-Check Student Form has a list of each of the numbered rules as well.

#### **COLLECTING CARDS**

Punch holes in the corners so students can store their cards on a ring. Messages can be written on the back.



# CLASSROOM RULES STUDENT SELF-CHECK

#### **SELF-CHECK FORM**

Student Self-Check forms allow students the ability to monitor themselves and be responsible for a specific rule-goal. On the left side of the form there is a list of all of the classroom rule titles with their corresponding numbers.

#### **RULE OF THE WEEK**

In the bubble shape on the right students write a rule number. They use words and/or pictures to describe the rule they will be working on for the week.

#### HOW WILL I ACCOMPLISH THE GO

In the rectangle shape students write and/or draw examples of how the goal might be accomplished.

#### **RATING SCALE**

Students evaluate and rate their own achievement using a positive Rating Scale 0=keep working on it

3=good but I want to do better


5=accomplished my goal.

# SHARING

When it is time to select a new goal it is helpful for students to share their definitions and examples with each other.

# **RULES LIST**

A Rules List Chart can be posted, sent to parents letting them know the classroom behavior goals, and/or given to students as a reference and stored in their personal CLASSROOM GOALS BINDER.



# CLASSROOM RULES BULLETIN BOARD

#### **BULLETIN BOARD**

Build community within a classroom with a Classroom Rules bulletin board.

Choose the rules that fit your classroom from the 33 Rules Poster Cards in this set.

The individual cards make it easy to fit within different sized spaces on a wall.

### **BULLETIN BOARD HEADER**

Use the PDF or the clip art bulletin board header. You can enlarge the clip art image to fit your space. The font used in this set is called MARVIN. Print on card stock and laminate for years of use.

# FOCUS ARROWS

Use the PDF or the clipart arrows to point to behaviors you want to focus on. There are 7 arrows that match the 7 colors used in the posters. Pull the clip art arrows into your typing program to add text and then enlarge them to match your space. (Or handwrite your text.)



# **FUN ACTIVITY**

One fun activity when introducing your class rules is for students to work alone or in small groups to develop a skit or poster that will give a visual example of the rule and how to accomplish it. This activity helps kids get to know each other and helps to build a collaborative and fun classroom environment.

### **Binder Covers**


Choose a cover and slip it into your binder front. There is space on the cover for you to add notes.
